THE SCA PROHIBITS HARASSMENT AND BULYING OF ALL INDIVIDUALS AND GROUPS.

The SCA prohibits bullying and harassment of all individuals and groups. Bullying is systematic and unwelcome behavior which involves the use of influence, threat, intimidation, or coercion to cause hurt or harm to another person or group of people. When the bullying behavior is based on a protected class (1), that behavior is defined as harassment.

(1) race, sex, religion, national origin, gender, sexual orientation, age, or disability.

Bullying and Harassment may be **overt**, as in the following non-inclusive list of examples:

- Verbal abuse, including using racial, homophobic, transphobic, ableist epithets, etc.
- Non-consensual physical contact, violence, or threatening gestures.
- Displaying material that is offensive, degrading, or threatening to a protected class.
- Consistent demeaning remarks or malicious teasing - Stalking or predatory behavior

Covert:

- Spreading rumors or innuendo with malicious intent
- Deliberate exclusion, isolation, or alienation of an individual without just cause
- Using rank, title, or office to intimidate others

Provided that the behavior does not rise to the criteria listed above, bullying and harassment is not:

- Single episodes of social rejection, dislike, tactlessness, or forgetfulness.
- Mutual arguments, disagreements, or fights.
- The termination, mutual or not, of a romantic relationship or friendship.
- Reasonable constructive feedback or critique.

The test for bullying is the reasonableness of the behavior and the impact of that behavior on the recipient. Participants engaging in bullying/harassment are subject to appropriate sanctions. If an individual believes they have been subjected to or have witnessed harassment, bullying, or retaliation, that person should contact a senechal, the President of the SCA, or that kingdom's Board Ombudsman.

From the Kingdom Webminister

Unto the Kingdom of Æthelmearc, does your Kingdom Webminister send warm greetings!

Æthelmearc my current term as your Kingdom Webminister is going to end this April, and I will be stepping down and not seeking another term, keeping with what I submitted on my last Letter of Intent.

So, as it is needed, I am putting out a call for Letters of Intent for anyone interested in the Office of Kingdom Webminister. This is for a two-year term, starting at Spring Coronation 2025.

The Webminister's Office is responsible for maintaining the Kingdom Website/domain, the Kingdom's Google for Non-Profits Account (email, documents, and so on), the form server (MachForm), Google Groups, the Kingdom Docs server, the Helpdesk and the support structures in place in the Kingdom. They also help support the Kingdom Zoom account. Additionally, the Webminister assists webministers of local groups, Kingdom Guilds and Polling Orders, and Kingdom offices with any web-related issues as well as collect reports every quarter and submit quarterly reports to the Society Webminister. The Webminister oversees the Event Coordinator on matters pertaining to the website and works very closely with this position to keep the Kingdom Calendar up to date. The Webminister also works very closely with the Kingdom Chronicler. Finally, the Webminister collects Kingdom quarterly reports, sends reports to the Society Webminister, checks for compliance issues throughout Kingdom websites and makes recommendations to Society level for the William Blackfox Web Awards. You also need to be attentive to detail and proactive to stay ahead of issues, when able. The average time spent working on Kingdom Webminister duties is roughly 2-10 hours per week, depending on the time of month and issues that arise. Skills required for this position are a working knowledge of websites and web servers, Google, email, cPanel, WordPress, HTML, and Spreadsheets. (It's a plus if you

know Google Looker (Data) Studio but isn't a requirement.) Blackstone Raids

27 April, Anno Societatis LVIII

Documented from the Rolls and Files of the Coram Regibus of Murdoch I Rex and Ríoghnách I Regina, King and Queen of Æthelmearc: Being a True Record of the Business of Their Royal Court at Blackstone Raids, 27 April, Anno Societatis LVIII, in the Barony of Blackstone Mountain. As recorded by Gwendolyn the Graceful, Brehyres, Meistr-y-gân, Jewel of Æthelmearc Herald, with the assistance of Lady Elinor Walden.

Upon the field: Their Majesties thanked Kumagaya-roku-i Kentarou Masamoto for his service as Kingdom Thrown Weapons champion and for the range he devised to select Their new champion. His Lordship Kuma announced that The Honorable Lord Meinolfr Grímsson took third place, Baroness Rois O'Faye scored for second place, and that the winner was Don Mathias al Tabai. Don Mathias was then installed as Thrown Weapons Champion and invested with a new baldric, commissioned by His Lordship Kuma to replace the previous baldric, which His Lordship promised would be restored and returned to the Kingdom Historian for safekeeping. Their Majesties also desired to be attended by Lady Astridhr Thorolfsdottir at this time. Noting her wide travel to help set up and tear down ranges, as well as her other service to the thrown weapons community, They were minded to name her a Companion of the Order of the Keystone. Scroll by "The Honorable Fool" Dagonell the Juggler.

Court was suspended.

In the evening, Their Majesties received the fealty of Baron Cunedda Kell and Baroness Alana Horsecroft, Baronage of Blackstone Mountain, and invited them to join Their Court.

Their Majesties praised the day's activities and weather, noting that it was Their first Blackstone Raids, but judging by the enjoyable time They had, promised it would likely not be Their last.

Their Majesties then invited the young persons in attendance to come forward and directed them to find Baron Salvadore de la Torres for a toy from the treasure chest.

Next, Their Majesties greeted many newcomers and invited them to take drinking vessels in welcome.

Their Majesties gave leave to Their Excellencies to conduct Baronial Court.

Upon the conclusion of Baronial Court, Their Majesties called before Them Jocelyn de Brienne. Having just heard during Their Excellencies' Court's additional testimony of this young gentle's talents, and her service, They were well pleased in Their desire to Award her Arms. Scroll by Lady Kolfina Jodisdottir upon words by "some guy in a hat" (Master Po Silvertop), with pawprint decoration by the feline, Grey.

Next, Their Majesties invited Lady Elinor Walden to provide the results of the Kingdom Clothiers' Guild's inaugural Project Promenade. Lady Elinor and her fellow judges, Mistress Fede di Fiori and Duchess Juliana Delamare, announced that the winning team was "Stranger Danger," comprised of: The Honorable Lady Agnella locapi, Magdalena Txoperena, Dvorianka Zoya Drogomirovna, Baroness Anastasie de Lamoure, Lord Arne Burdenson, and Baron Salvadore de la Torres, who also served as model. Scroll by Lady Marsalli MacLachlainn upon wording by The Honorable Lord Casimir Zelený z Strášná Skála.

Following this, Their Majesties wished for Helena the Blushing to attend Them. Speaking of her assistance to her Barony, retaining, and helping at courts and children's activities, They decreed it right and proper to Award her Arms. Scroll calligraphy by Armiger urraca beatriz botelho, illumination by Lady Nicole du Marais, and words by "some guy in a hat" (Master Po Silvertop).

Next, Their Majesties desired to speak with Lady Fina the Huntress. Noting her longstanding service as a mistress of lists both for the Barony and at Pennsic, for her efforts to help newcomers acquire garb, and coordinating social activities, They were pleased to name her a Companion of the Keystone. Scroll by Baroness Katherine Kiersey.

Their Majesties desired also that Lord Samuel of Great Oaks

attend Them. They spoke again of the many ways in which Lord Samuel has served over the years, including setup, teardown, transporting equipment and supplies, and more. Mindful of this tireless and selfless support, They were well pleased to induct him as a Companion of the Keystone. Scroll by Lady MeiLan Hua upon words by Lord Julius Gautieri.

Next, Their Majesties sought Lady Edonea Kimball. Their Majesties noted that They had observed her upon the Thrown Weapons range that day and marked her enthusiasm and joy. Before that, however, word had reached Them of her many contributions to Silva Vulcani, including as a marshall in many different specialties. To recognize this dedicated service, They were pleased to name her a Companion of the Keystone. Scroll by Lady Cas-sia Carataca.

Their Majesties then invited Count Andrew MacFarlane of Wigan to join Them. They remarked that His Excellency is a staple of service to the Kingdom—loading and unloading, setting up and tearing down, assisting and teaching new fighters, and more—so much so that They were surprised when, on examining His Excellency's record, They learned that he was not already a Companion of the Order of the Keystone. Thus, They were well pleased to induct him and name him such. Scroll by Lady Umbriana Campana upon words by Lord Julius Gautieri.

Following this, Their Majesties requested the presence of The Honorable Lady Máirin Ó Nialláin. They remarked upon Her Ladyship's dedicated service in many respects, including as Exchequer, Event Steward, deputy officer, and working to bring the Shire of Port Oasis out of dormancy. So ubiquitous is Her Ladyship's service that it resounded through Their Noble Order of the Millrind, and concurring with that Order, They requested to be joined by its members, and inducted her as a Companion of that number. Scroll by The Honorable Lady Gesa von Wellenstein, and words by "some guy in a hat" (Master Po Silvertop).

Before releasing the Noble Order of the Millrind, Their Majesties summoned Lady Rose inghean uí Dubhshlaine. Making good note of "Mama Rose's" longstanding support to the Barony of Blackstone Mountain, her service as Exchequer, and that she is regarded as a pillar of the community, They were well pleased to Grant her Arms and name her also Companion of the Millrind. Scroll by Meisterin Amaalie Reinhardt.

Afterward, Their Majesties once again invited Their Excellencies Cunedda and Alana to join Them, and allowed Their Excellencies to explain that they had wished to provide a singular mark of excellence for one of their Baronial subjects: Mistress Maria Christina de Cordoba. For forty years, Mistress Maria has been a steadfast bedrock of support to the Barony. In recognition of her particular achievements and to celebrate the esteem in which she is held by both the Barony and the Kingdom, Their Majesties along with Their Excellencies were pleased to present Mistress Maria with the right to bear a unique Augmentation of Arms, combining symbols of Æthelmearc as well as Blackstone Mountain. Scroll by Lady Christina Mary Lowe (Jinx) upon words by Meisterin Amalie Reinhardt.

Their Majesties declined to release Baroness Alana Horsecroft at this time, instead speaking of the inspiration and exceptional servant Her Excellency has been to her Barony, serving on the Baronial throne twice, raising a family in the Society, running events and kitchens, and more, and all done with courtesy, grace, kindness, and love. Remarking that such service had also come to the attention of an august body, Their Majesties called for those members of the Most Noble Order of the Pelican there present to attend Them. They then directed Her Excellency by means of Writ of Summons to determine a time and place in which to sit vigil to contemplate elevation into that Order. Scroll by Meisterin Amalie Reinhardt.

Their Majesties requested Their Order of the Pelican and Her Excellency to remain while They required that Hersir Marek Viacheldrago also come forward. They spoke with Hersir Marek of the many years—and many miles—he has logged in service to the kingdom, the fighting community, and his local group, among others. As seneschal, marshall, Dean of the War College, Kingdom Camp steward at Gulf Wars, and in countless other ways, he has gone beyond the role of a member of the Chivalry to serve. Thus, Their Majesties directed him to choose a mutually agreeable day on which to contemplate induction into the Most Noble Order of the Pelican. Her Majesty then called Skyrin to attend Her.
