However, the honour and skill displayed in all six tournaments exemplified what makes Ealdormere great. Congratulations to all those who participated and showed their prowess for all to see. Every one of you should be proud! Congratulation to Duchess Kaylah for winning the Fencing finale and Duke Roak for winning the Heavy Weapons finale.

With events starting to return to a more regular schedule, We are excited to see all of you at Masque by Moonlight. Her Majesty will also be making a journey south to attend War of the Phoenix.

Unfortunately, both Her Majesty and I will not be able to attend Winter War. However, we invite all of you to attend a rare occasion for Ealdormere, a regency court. Their Highness' have agreed to host a regency court on our behalf. We invite everyone to come out and support them in our absence. Hopefully, We do not return to a civil uprising.

At this time, We would like to propose another small set of law changes, as it would make more sense to have the Kingdom Calendar office moved to be a deputy of the Chronicler (and ease the burden on the Kingdom Seneschal!):

VII-104 The Seneschal shall be responsible for soliciting bids for Kingdom events as defined in Article IV **and ensuring they appear** on the Kingdom Calendar of Events.

VII-106 (remove Calendar Secretary - responsible for maintaining the Kingdom calendar of events,)

From Their Highnesses

Wassail Ealdormere!

The time has come once again to vie for the Honor of our Kingdom! Come and Honor us with your participation in a Tournament to determine the next Heirs to the Thrones of Ealdormere!



Our Tourney shall be of two formats, depending upon the number of participants.

Format A:

If there are 7 or less combatants, it will be a round robin with each Bout best 2 of three fights with weapons of choice. Once all combatants have completed the round robin the top two shall be our Finalists. If there are ties to decide the final two, those tied combatants will fight a deciding Bout the winners moving on to the Final. The Final will be best 2 out of 3 Bouts, with each Bout consisting of best 2 of 3 fights. The first two Bouts will be with matched weapons. The initial weapon choice goes to the fighter with higher precedence, the second Bout will be fought with the weapon of choice from the fighter with lower precedence. The third Bout, if needed, will be individual choice.

Format B:

If there are 8 or more combatants, it will be a standard double elimination tree. With each Bout being a best 2 of 3 fights with weapon of choice. This will continue until there are two fighters on the winner's side (side A) of the tree and two fighters on the side with a single loss (Side B). A cross over will then be done with every effort to ensure fighters who have not already faced each other are paired. If this is not possible pairings shall be randomly carried out by Her Majesty. Each of these Bouts will be best 2 out of 3 using weapons of choice. The fighter from side A will need to win one Bout best 2 out of 3 fights. The fighter from Side B will need to win two Bouts best 2 out of 3 fights. The Final will be best 2 out of 3 Bouts, with each Bout consisting of best 2 of 3 fights. The first two Bouts will be with matched weapons. The initial weapon choice goes to the fighter with higher precedence, the second Bout will be fought with the weapon of choice from the fighter with lower precedence. The third Bout, if needed, will be individual choice.

As per Kingdom Law, all Combatants and Consorts shall submit their intent to participate in Our Crown Tourney in writing to both The Crown and The Kingdom Senechal. Doing so through E-mail is perfectly acceptable. Please use the Crown Tournament Declaration form PDF found on the Ealdormere website in the Library section(it makes it very easy). Found here:

We await your Letters with great excitement and anticipation, we are very much looking forward to the day!



My Official duties are:


- Being responsible for the good conduct and safety of all martial activities in the kingdom.

From the Kingdom Senschal

Hello Sunshines!

Late winter, early spring is a time of a lot of dreary weather in Ealdormere, but also a lot of amazing time with friends and family as we ignore the weather outside and focus on all of the good things happening within the Kingdom.

I would like to warmly welcome Lady Sara Barrington as my new Social Media deputy. I am grateful to her for stepping up to help out in that area. There's a whole team of us who try and keep track of the social media for the kingdom, it's a big job but made easier by you folks generally playing nice. Keep up that great work!

In the same vein of people stepping up to new offices, I am delighted to welcome Her Grace Marioun Golightly in taking on the role of Chancellor of Youth. Master Martin (and Mistress Emma) have worked long and hard in that position and I thank them for that service.

Their Highnesses have published their requirements for entry into their Crown Tournament in this month's newsletter. Please review those requirements carefully, as well as the relevant laws included below. Crown Tournament documentation must be submitted electronically (pdf preferred) to both the Kingdom Seneschal as well as their Highnesses. You will need to include a copy of your authorization card, the membership cards of both the entrant and the consort, a completed Crown Declaration form (as found in the library on the kingdom website), proof of residency for both the combatant and the consort, as well as all requirements set out by their Highnesses. Those documents are required to be submitted complete and on time.

Crown Tournament submissions will be accepted until 11:59 PM EDT on May 13, 2025. That deadline is firm, 12:01 AM is too late. Save yourself the stress and get your submissions in early.

Please review the current laws of Ealdormere as they apply to Crown Tournaments and ensure you follow them in your applications.

III-400 All prospective combatants and consorts must be paid members of the SCA and must maintain that membership through to the end of Their reign. Proof of membership must accompany the request to participate in the Crown Tournament.

III-500 All prospective combatants and consorts in the Crown Tournament must meet the following requirements:

III-501 They must be subjects of Ealdormere as defined by Corpora and must remain subjects of the Kingdom through to the end of Their reign.

From the Kingdom Senschal con't

III-502 They must be at least 18 years old.

III-503 They must have been subjects of Ealdormere and have demonstrated a clear level of involvement in the Kingdom over the year prior to the Crown Tournament.

—

III-504 They must be armigerous.

III-505 All prospective combatants must be authorized to fight as an armored combatant in the Kingdom of Ealdormere and must present proof of authorization when submitting their letter of intent.

III-600 Any person who does not meet the requirements of Section III-503 or 504 may make an application to the Heirs under the "Rule of 12" as outlined below:

The Prospective combatant and consort shall submit a request to participate in the Crown Tournament pursuant to Section III-200. Their request must be accompanied by a letter addressing why they seek dispensation from Section III-503 or III-504. This letter must bear the signatures of 12 subjects of Ealdormere, all of whom are armigerous. By signing the dispensation request, the signatories vouch for the worthiness of the candidates. Due weight will be given to this request.

Note: This dispensation request must accompany the request to participate in the Crown Tournament and is not a method of recourse after a combatant or consort has been disallowed from the Crown Tournament.

III-700 Neither the Sovereign or the Consort of Ealdormere, nor any person who has served as Sovereign or Consort of Ealdormere within three months prior to the Crown Tournament, may participate as a combatant or consort in that Crown Tournament.

III-800 No prospective combatant may have more than one declared consort. No prospective consort may be fought for by more than one combatant.


