You may have heard also FOOL introduced our new Ramshaven Baron and Baroness Henry Foster and Bridget Larkin eighth Baron and Baroness.


And our lovely Mary, the future of these lands along with all the young voices and happy dancing and playing children at this lovely event.

Unto the populace of Ealdormere do Prince Baldric and Princess Breyla send Greetings,




We would like to start by thanking Their Majesties for accepting us and some of the best combatants and consorts into their crown tourney. It was a pleasure to watch everyone in the list that day.

From the Trillium Principal Herald

Greetings, Ealdormere!



All kinds of announcements for this month!

1. The annual meeting of the College at Trillium War will take place on Saturday at 11 am. As is traditional, Trillium will bring tasty snacks. We'll be doing a meet-and-greet as well as talking about some pretty amazing new projects...
2. Which brings me to #2. Master Cormac Mor (former Wreath Sovereign-at-Arms) has succeeded in plastering the heralds of AnTir with gorgeous field tabards, and now he's shared his secret with any kingdom that wants it (hint: it's a design we can print on Spoonflower!) These tabards will be fully washable. I am seeking groups that would like to sponsor a Kingdom tabard. Ideally, I'd like at least 5 of them - one for Trillium (all our usable tabards right now would make a sofa jealous), one to go with Royal regalia for use for reign heralds, one for Pentland (specifically for use at Crown Tourneys) and a couple to have handy for times where we might have more than one herald participate in Court. Anyone who watched the Coronation of King Charles III will know that a pack of heralds in tabards is the coolest thing ever, but we also don't want us keeling over from the heat at Pennsic because of the bulk of our tabards. I am expecting that each tabard, including lining fabric, will cost about \$100 CAD, although we may be able to lower that price a bit if we can find donations of suitable lining fabric. Sponsorships are first come, first served--baronies, shires, households, or even individuals can do it, and I'll put your name on the inside and also give you an Ealdormere populace pennant (that will be printed at the same time) as a thank-you for your donation. Any leftover funds will be donated to the Kingdom for use to help pay for heraldic submissions.
3. Speaking of cool heraldry: I am pleased to announce that a badge has now been registered for use by those placed on the Scroll of Honour. Originally proposed by Trumbrand and Kaylah during their first reign, the badge was designed to honour the memory of Count Sarnac and consists of an eight-pointed gold star charged with a Gothic capital "E." (Yes, SoH recipients get a gold star!)
4. Speaking of cool heralds, I am also pleased to make public a number of promotions announced at FOOL: To the rank of Pursuivant--Rhys of Anglesey and Jotun-Bjorn. To the rank of Herald: Matthäus Lindenhayn von Schaffhausen and Albrecht Stampfer. To the rank of Herald Extraordinary: Rylyn Buchanan. As thanks for her years of service, Her Grace will now be able to register a permanent heraldic title for her own personal use.
5. And change is coming! Matthäus Lindenhayn von Schaffhausen has been appointed as Inland Seas Herald, which means that in a few months, at Wassail, he will take over as Trillium Herald. I would also like to announce that THL Dietrich von Sachsen has been appointed as Acting Green Mantle Herald, and I will be looking for a permanent Green Mantle effective immediately. I thank Lady Daya Speyerin for her willingness to serve in this office.

DRAFT PROPOSAL FOR COMMENTARY

CORPORATE POLICY XIX. DELEGATION OF INVESTMENT AUTHORITY POLICY



The Board of Directors is currently considering the following addition to the SCA's Corporate Policy:

XIX. Delegation of Investment Authority Policy

The Board shall ensure that fiduciary responsibilities concerning the proper management of SCA, Inc.'s institutional funds are fulfilled through appropriate investment structure, internal and external management, and portfolio performance consistent with all policies and procedures. Based on the advice and recommendations of the Treasurer and its external fund manager(s), the Board shall approve investment policies and objectives that reflect the long-term investment-risk orientation appropriate to the organization. The Board may, at its sole discretion, create or eliminate committee(s) to advise the Board in furthering its duties and may select, appoint, and remove members thereto.

The Board hereby delegates supervisory responsibility for the management of its invested funds to the Corporate Treasurer, subject to the financial limitations specified in Corpora, as noted below:

- determine that institutional funds are prudently and effectively managed with the assistance of management and any necessary investment consultants and/or other outside professionals, if any.
- recommend the retention and/or dismissal of investment consultants and/or other outside professionals.
- receive and review reports from management, investment consultants and/or other outside professionals, if any.
- periodically meet with management, investment consultants and/or other outside professionals management, investment consultants and/or other outside professionals.
- report to the Board (as needed) whether this policy, investment activities, risk management controls and processes continue to be consistent with meeting the goals and objectives set for the management of institutional funds.
- execute such investment transactions as are necessary to ensure that SCA, Inc.'s investment portfolio reflects the asset allocation, investment-risk orientation, or other direction regarding the investment portfolio as has been established by the Board.

A few things we're required to say...
