## COMMENTARY REQUEST - SCA

### Commentary Request - Proposed Changes - Chatelaine and DEIB

The Board of Directors is currently considering changes to Corpora. It invites commentary from the membership and participants.

These changes aim to enhance recruitment and member retention in the SCA. They also aim to further support these goals. They elevate the Society Chatelaine to a greater Society Officer. They align local and regional chatelaines to this same structure. It is a strategic move. It aims to support the implementation of comprehensive recruitment and retention strategies. It also aims to align the office to a clear vision.

The Board also approved proposed wording. It supports the creation of a Society Diversity, Equity, Inclusion, and Belonging (DEIB) Officer. They also approved aligning local and regional DEIB officers into one structure. Like the proposed Chatelaine changes, it aims to support an aligned Society vision. It also aims to support the implementation of strategy in this space.

Finally, the Board approved changing the name and scope of the Corporate Diversity Equity Inclusion and Belonging Office. It is now the Office of Inclusive Programs. This office will handle the implementation of large scale, heavy-lift projects. This work will move inclusivity in the SCA forward. It will also transition leadership and management of game-facing DEIB work to the newly created Society DEIB Officer. This office will support all corporate and society officers. It will also serve as a primary DEIB advisor to the Board.

Note: Changes to corporate offices don't require changes in Corpora or public commentary. Understanding the changes to the Corporate DEIB Office will add context for the proposed changes to Corpora. It will also provide clarity for the realignment of responsibilities among these offices.

This restructuring aligns with better practice for organizations that aim to improve recruiting and retention by creating welcoming and inclusive environments.

#### Continued From Last Issue

Avacal financial policy states that the SCA cannot purchase or own alcohol except in small quantities for cooking purposes. Alcohol can be served at events provided all modern laws and regulations are adhered to. Events may cover the cost of the liquor license, and alcohol may be served by individuals as arranged by the event. Alcohol service cannot be designated an official duty of an office or officer.

#### L. Emergencies

Any time that an Event Steward feels that they need the support of the Seneschal to handle a difficult situation they should feel free to do so. Preventing emergencies is the goal.

- A) Immediately notify the Branch and Kingdom Seneschal about any occurrences that made it necessary to call the modern authorities (law enforcement, fire department, emergency medical) to the site of an event. Such emergencies include injuries in which the victim is transported by EMS or ambulance.
- B) Immediately notify the Branch and Kingdom Seneschal and Crown of any suspected thefts, embezzlements, or other financial irregularities.

#### IV. Kingdom Calendar

#### A. Calendar Dates

Avacal's Calendar dates are fixed and set as below (Fig 1). Local activities such as practices, meetings and taverns, etc., are not placed on the kingdom calendar.

In accordance with the Laws of the Kingdom of Avacal:

- Kingdom Events and Kingdom Sanctioned Events will not conflict with each other.
- The Crown shall retain the right to revise dates on the calendar when deemed necessary.
- The Crown shall retain the right to revise calendar policy as they see fit for Their Reign.

All events placed on the calendar are considered Kingdom sanctioned events and will not conflict with each other. For conflict to occur a group must have the written permission of the Crown, and the Seneschal of the group they wish to conflict with. Unsanctioned events on the calendar may conflict with other events.

#### B. Changes to the Calendar

If a group wishes to move one of their Kingdom sanctioned events to an open weekend, or if groups wish to change weekends with another group, then the applicable group Seneschal(s) shall contact the Crown in writing and ask permission. If the Crown is in agreement, they will direct the updating of this event policy.

#### C. Minimum and Maximum Number of Events

#### 1. Group Minimums

As per Kingdom law, all branches are required to host at least one Kingdom Sanctioned Event per calendar year on the Kingdom Calendar with complete event

copy appearing in The Avantgarde.

Any Kingdom Event MAY count toward a branch's minimum if the branch chooses.

#### 2. Group Maximums

- Baronies may not exceed a maximum of three Kingdom Sanctioned Events per Calendar year.
- Shires and Cantons may not exceed a maximum of two Kingdom Sanctioned Events per Calendar year.
- Kingdom Events do NOT count toward the maximum number of events a branch may hold.
- Branches that do not use their maximum may donate their remaining event(s) to another group.
- Incipient Shires may have one event set on the Calendar by the sponsoring branch.
   This event does NOT count as part of the maximum number of events for the sponsoring branch.

#### D. Notification, Advertising, and Deadlines

For all events that are Kingdom Sanctioned, the Event Copy and AEF must be sent to the Kingdom Calendar Officer three months prior to the event.

For example, the event copy must be received by the calendar officer on or before October 1st for an event taking place in January. This gives the Kingdom calendar officer and Kingdom Chronicler time to review the information and meet The Avantgarde deadlines. A branch that submits event paperwork early may receive additional months of advertising in the Avantgarde provided there is space.

Bids for Kingdom events are due 12 months in advance. If no acceptable bid has been submitted by the bid deadline, the branch that has gone the longest without hosting a Kingdom Event may have the event assigned to them. If that branch is unable to accept the assignment, the branch that has gone the second longest will be assigned, and so on until there is a willing host branch found. This responsibility lies with the Crown who is informed by the Event's Deputy.

All Social Media and Avacal Website events must be published by the Kingdom Calendar Officer (or authorized deputy) through official Avacal pages. (e.g. Facebook event pages for any event within Avacal must be created through the official Kingdom of Avacal Facebook page).

### AVACAL ADVOCACY COUNCIL

Avacal is seeking 2-6 people for the position of Advocate Council. The Avacal Advocacy Council will address situations when a member of the populace needs help understanding their options should they feel they are being mistreated. The role of the Advocacy Council is to support the populace member in addressing their concerns respectfully to support a healthy culture within Avacal. This support can help members to navigate kingdom laws and policies, listen to concerns, offer advice such as SCA policy and procedure options, and assist with conflict resolution.

One member of the Advocacy Council shall be the Avacal DEI officer.

Responsibilities of the Advocacy role:

· Be willing to be approached during events, meetings or outside SCA formal events to assist with managing interpersonal conflict between populace members in an advisory role.

- · Actively listen to the concern of the populace member and validate facts by asking clarifying questions.
- · Offer feedback, where appropriate, and, if needed, support the design of scripting to address conflict by focusing on facts and the situation's impact.

They may be present with the populace member when they approach the other party in the efforts to resolve the conflict.

Considerations for this position:

- · Be considered by others to be approachable, open and willing to engage in dialogue.
- · Feels confident to partner with the DEI office, as required.
- · Comfortable with conflict, the ability to be objective, listen for facts and assumptions, and offer coaching to address the issue at hand.
- · Enhanced interpersonal skills and the ability to manage conflict without creating barriers

- · Be non-judgemental and keep the confidence of the people involved
- · Receive direction from the Kingdom Seneschal as per the grievance procedure/bullying and harassment policy requirement, etc.
- · Dependable access to email and phone.
- · Strong ability to build and maintain relationships across all peerages.
- · We are skilled at working collaboratively with all leadership across Avacal, including the Crown, Kingdom Seneschal, Baron and Baronesses, all group-level seneschals, etc.
- Attend training to become skilled in Advocacy Training which includes: active listening, effective feedback, and managing conflict.

All officer positions must be paid by members of the SCA.




