Continue for 16 miles, then turn left onto ID 51 / ID 78. Go 7 miles, then shift right to stay on ID 78. Go 9 more iles, then turn right onto River Rd. Go 0.75 miles and turn right onto Black Sands Rd. Go 0.5 miles and turn left onto Strike Dam Cutoff Rd. After getting to CJ Strike area:






