

Greetings!



The dog days of summer are upon us and Great Western War is only two months away! It's never too early to start packing for war.

From the North: take CA-99 towards Kingsburg. Follow CA-99 S to Ave 394. Take exit 111 from

CA-99 S, continue onto Ave 394 (signs for Mendocino Ave/Avenue 394), Turn right onto Rd 12, Turn right onto Avenue 384/Boston Ave, Turn left onto N 5 1/2 Ave, Turn right onto Benecia Ave, Continue onto N 6th Ave, Turn right onto Clinton Ave.

Use the left lane to take the ramp onto CA-198 E/Hwy 198 E. Turn left onto 6th Ave (signs for Burris Park/Kingsburg). Turn left onto Clinton Ave.

- **Fyvie Ohe.** Badge. (Fieldless) A raven contourny maintaining in its beak an annulet sable.
- **Kseniia Aleksandrova.** Name change from Batu Sechen Tsagaajin.
- **Leo Phelan.** Name change and device. Per chevron argent and sable, a chevron purpure and in base a sea-wolf argent.
- **Liam Mór MacGregor.** Name change from Uilliam Mór MacGregor.
- **Mirandus Palmerius.** Name.
- **Paul fitz Denis.** Heraldic title - Mash Rake Herald.
- **Paul fitz Denis.** Badge. (Fieldless) A wooden mash rake proper. Nice badge!
- **Paul fitz Denis.** Badge. (Fieldless) In pall three mash rakes conjoined at the handles argent.
- **Steffan Marden.** Name and device. Azure, on a bend between a seahorse and a nautilus shell argent three trilliums palewise purpure.

- **Veðr Hafsson.** Name change.
