Random Carp

A look at modern practices and their medieval sources

Huff paste is a cooking technique where a coarse and dense dough made of flour, suet, and boiling water is molded into a stiff pie shell or other container shape. Preferred ingredients were then put inside and it was filled and baked. The outer dough, called a coffyn, was not really edible, but it sealed the baked food inside. Looking a lot like a Cornish pasty, these coffyns or coffers would preserve food for several months for transport. This allowed one to send food gifts some distance, or just put up leftovers from a fine meal. You could also premake an empty coffyn for future use, then just filling, capping, and baking as needed. So as you think of putting up food at home remember that before tupperware or canning there were coffyns in which you could save your random carp.

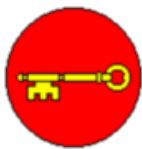
