# A Brief History of the Foresters Guild in Caid, and Beyond

Let me start by saying that I did not create the Foresters Guild, but I did establish it within Caid.

The Foresters Guild was created in the East Kingdom more than a decade ago, as an Arts and Sciences guild focused on outdoor skills and activities. Several individuals who enjoyed backpacking, bushcraft, and primitive skills headed into the woods, in garb, and emerged as a Guild of Foresters. The guild was originally intended to portray late period English Royal Foresters, who were responsible for patrolling and securing Royal lands and apprehending poachers, bandits, and highwaymen. Today, the guild is open to any period and persona, with the emphasis being on portraying a forest user or dweller in some way, and the guild has spread beyond the borders of East Kingdom. There are Foresters Guilds in six Kingdoms, with Caid being the most recent addition.

The origin of the Foresters Guild of Caid is closely tied with my own origins in the SCA. I attended my first event about a year ago, and I was hooked. I knew the SCA would be a good fit for me, and I was ready to take a deep dive. I began to explore what activities were available, and none of the things I was seeing people do particularly resonated with me at the time. So, as most of us do, I began to research. I also began to ask myself, what do I bring to the SCA, and what would I enjoy doing if I can find people to with whom to do it?

I realized that what I brought to the SCA was knowledge- my father was an anthropologist, and my head was full of information about primitive tools and survival skills. I also realized that what I would like to do put that knowledge into practice.

I had found my first rabbit hole. I began to research and look for people with similar interests. I also began to create things. My first SCA A&S project was a pack frame loosely based on Ötzi the Iceman's pack. Today, this pack frame carries the entirety of my camp, with the exception of my cooler, my portable fire pit, and my firewood.

As I began to share the things I was researching, the things I was making, and the ideas that were bouncing around in my head (garbed hikes? Period camping and backpacking? Campfire cooking?), the response was a consistent and enthusiastic, "that's so cool! I wish I could

learn to do that!"

In October of last year, my research and rabbit holing led me to the East Kingdom Foresters Guild. I reached out to Vindiorix Ordovix, their High Warden and, asked if he had any suggestions on how to get something similar started here. He was thrilled to hear there was interest in the Foresters Guild on the West Coast, and he agreed to help me get something going here. That process basically consisted of 3 parts. First, do stuff. Hike, camp, have classes, practice outdoor skills. Second, share the stuff being done on social media so people are aware of what they can be a part of. And third, he offered all of East Kingdom Royal Foresters documents to be copied and/or adopted for use here in Caid. They have assisted fledgling guilds in a few other kingdoms, and they encourage the adoption of East Kingdom's structure, traditions, and ranks, so that there is uniformity and transferability within the Foresters Guild throughout the Known World.

I spent the winter months practicing my skills and assembling and testing gear, and sharing it on Facebook. A group of interested individuals quickly became a message group, and then a Facebook group. I also began teaching flint and steel fire starting at Dun Or's monthly Fun Or gathering/tournament.

The people in the message group had ideas... what about foraging? Natural dyes? Herbalism? Culinary arts? Are these things that could be incorporated into guild activities? My answer was yes. Any activities that involve the forest, the wilderness, or the outdoors can potentially be Foresters Guild activities.

Let me repeat that...

Any activities that involve the forest, the wilderness, or the outdoors can potentially be Foresters Guild activities.

In March, the guild had its first official event. We went for a garbed hike, and we discussed local plants and their traditional uses as we went. I believe we identified around 20 plants and their uses, which included everything from food, to medicine, to basket weaving, to bow making, to firewood. We had a total of 7 people attend this first outing.

From that first event, the guild has grown

exponentially. At Dun Or Anniversary in April, we received a baronial charter, and I taught a fire starting class. At Potrero War, I taught fire starting again, and we had a guild meeting where several people submitted applications, and two people who have been involved from the earliest days of the guild became sworn members- Novices in the guild. Later that evening, we also had someone not only become a sworn member, but also demonstrate that he meets the requirements for promotion to the rank of Underforester.

At Spring Coronation, Their Magesties King Wilhelm and Queen Lorissa recognized the Foresters Guild as an official Kingdom Guild, and an official charter document is in the works.

### - Guild Activities

The Foresters Guild is more than just hiking and camping. We, as a guild, are researching local plants that can be used for food, medicine, and dye, with the intent of planning a foraging trip at some point, once we know what to look for and how to use it safely. I have been learning to make cordage and baskets with collected/foraged fiber, and I'm looking into the feasibility of offering a class at some point. Some of our members have also discussed getting together to cook over open fires, make soap using traditional materials and methods, and even the possibility of boating trips-using modern safety equipment, of course... drowning might be period, but it's not fun. Two of our members are planning to hike Hadrian's Wall from end to end next year, in garb, using mostly period equipment. This is a trip they were planning before their involvement with the guild, but they are excited that the guild provides a place to learn and hone the necessary skills, and to test and refine their gear before the trip.

Again, Any activities that involve the forest, the wilderness, or the outdoors can potentially be Foresters Guild activities.

Something I am emphasizing in the guild is persona development. How does your persona utilize or interact with the wilderness and its resources? Are you an herbalist or dyer who forages for plant materials? A hunter? A traveler? Are you an outlaw who dwells in the forest to avoid capture? Maybe you are an English Royal Forester who has sworn to patrol and protect the royal lands from poachers and bandits... the emphasis in the guild is on figuring out your persona's connection to the land, and learning and developing skills appropriate for your persona, location, and time period.

Another thing I want to emphasize is inclusion. Not everyone can do long distance hikes or sleep on the ground. Fortunately, Foresters tend to be generalists, not specialists, and as we as a guild learn more diverse skills, this will allow us to hold a wider variety of activities, which will provide opportunities for people with different interests and abilities to get involved. One of our members suggested making a raised fire platform to make fire starting easier for people who may have difficulty stooping or squatting down. I love the idea, and I'm hoping that it is the first of many ideas for accommodations that will make guild activities and skills more accessible and inclusive. Some of us are also experimenting with non-European and Stone Age technologies, so that when someone portraying a non-European persona joins the guild, we can integrate them into the group as quickly and seamlessly as possible. I would love to see a wide variety of cultures represented within the guild, and rather than waiting to cross that bridge when we come to it, I want to start laying the foundations for that bridge NOW.

### - Membership, Ranks, and Houses of Merit

As of today, we have a total of 7 sworn members. Of those 7, 4 are women, and 3 are men. In addition to our sworn members, we have 8 members who have submitted applications, but have not yet taken the oath.

The application is just a formality. Once an individual submits an application, they are a guild member. No one will ever be denied membership or removed from the guild unless they have shown that they are consistently unsafe in the field or in camp, and they are unwilling to receive guidance and improve their unsafe behavior.

The purpose of the application is to give the guild leadership some basic information on members, including their SCA background, and what skills or activities interest them. This information can be used to help plan future events or guide guild discussions and research, to connect individuals with similar interests, or to connect individuals who reside within the same region or territory so they can plan local outings and potentially organize at the local level.

After members have submitted applications, there is a 90 day waiting period before they can swear the Forester's Oath. Again, this is a formality. It's a trial period, a time of contemplation. It's an opportunity for individuals to see if the guild is a good fit for them, and if they are a good fit for the guild. Again, our goal is to be as inclusive as possible,

and never to exclude anyone or discourage anyone from participating.

The Foresters Oath is only required for those who wish to advance in rank or hold office within the guild, and if there is a reason that someone is not able to swear the oath, due to personal religious beliefs, or other oaths that may be seen as exclusive or conflicting, or any other circumstances, we can do an affirmation instead of an oath.

After a member has taken the oath or given their affirmation, they are ranked as a Novice and can begin working toward rank advancement. The ranks within the guild are Novice, Underforester, Forester, and Master Forester. The requirements of each rank are progressively more challenging and more involved, encouraging members to increase their knowledge, improve their skills, develop their persona, and improve both the efficacy and historical accuracy of their garb and gear. The ranks of Forester and Master Forester also require service or teaching, ensuring that the Foresters Guild is not only helping its members to grow, but also giving back to the SCA community as a whole.

In addition to our ranks, the Foresters Guild has three houses of merit. The three houses are equal in status within the guild, and none should be perceived as more prestigious than the others. No guild member may belong to more than one house of merit, so members must choose wisely which group they wish to be affiliated with.

The Order of St. Hubert, known as the Rangers, emphasizes self-sufficiency, survival skills, travel over land or by inland waterways. The Rangers will appeal to seasoned outdoor enthusiasts, bushcrafters, and survivalists. The ranger trial consists of a multi-day, self-supported journey over land, water, or both, where candidates will face challenges involving flood, fire, and foe.

The Order of St. Eustace, known as the Regarders, emphasizes martial skill and prowess. This house of merit will appeal to those who are actively involved in any of the martial activities in the SCA. The Regarder trial consists of a sustained combat challenge where applicants will face adversity, inclemency, and vicissitude.

The final house of merit is the Order of St. John Gaulbert, known as the Woodwards, is focused on Arts, Sciences, and Service. This house of merit will appeal to those who enjoy creating, teaching, leading, and serving. The Woodward trial is more individual and less highly

structured than those of the other houses, and generally consists of a masterwork project and/or long-term service to the Guild or to the greater SCA. These masterwork projects are quite involved, from the research behind them, to the planning and execution of the project, and often take several years to complete.

- Looking Forward

We have two groups organizing at the baronial level, in Angels and Starkhafn. There has been interest expressed in other baronies as well. I am always willing to work with people at the local level to help get things up and running.

We are looking forward to Great Western War. It's going to be a busy war for the Foresters Guild. We're doing a Constable shift on Friday, focusing on fire safety as we make our rounds. We hope to have another fire starting class. We are going to have a Forest Court(details TBA). We have several members eligible for the oath or affirmation, as well as a couple of rank promotions- possibly more than a couple, if people take advantage of the war as an opportunity to demonstrate skills and get things signed off on their rank checklists. Throughout the war, I have asked that members of our guild who are knowledgeable and comfortable make themselves available to answer questions about fire safety and fire starting.

This is just the beginning. I'm looking forward to seeing the guild continue to grow and take on a life of its own. I'm looking forward to seeing the ideas that are getting tossed around grow into outings and classes, if we can just find free weekends to make that happen. Another thing I'd like to see happen at some point is a Foresters Weekend, filled with garbed hikes and classes focused on outdoor skills and meals cooked over open fires. Again, if we can just find an open weekend to make that happen.

There will also be Arts and Science make-and-take classes as well as the usual Arts and Sciences.


