

We will be accepting applications until Jul 31, 2024. Please send your letter of application to the Kingdom Herald, Countess Sadb Jofreysdottir (herald@avacal.org); to Kingdom Exchequer, Lady Ruqayyah bint Abbas Al-Ifriqi (exchequer@avacal.org).

Ongoing training will be provided. Although knowledge of heraldry would be preferred, this is primarily an administrative position. This position takes approximately 15 hours each month and has several key deadlines. The position specifically needs someone who:

- Can be warranted as an exchequer so they can handle the submission fees that are received both in person at the submissions table or through the mail
- Has a stable mailing address, reliable internet access, a computer, and a scanner capable of 300dpi.
- Has an excellent knowledge of computer programs like graphics program like MS paint, or Inkscape to create electronic submissions and MS Office. Has a working knowledge of Online System for Commentary and Response (OSCAR) and although this is preferred, however, equivalent programs like SAP or other data inputting systems are very similar.
- Knows how to create Kingdom Letters of Intent for Kingdom commentary and attend and run the monthly decision meeting. Produces decision letter to be posted on the Avacal Heraldic website and notifies submitters via OSCAR and/or email. Alternatively, would be willing to learn.
- Knows how to create Letters of Intent for society commentary and monitors for the publication of the Letters of Acceptance and Responses. Produces a monthly summary for the Avantagarde and notifies submitters via OSCAR and/ or email. Alternatively, would be willing to learn.
- Knows general heraldry or is willing to learn.

AVACAL SANGUINARIAS HERALD

We are seeking applications for the Office of Principal Herald of Avacal. My term as Sanguinarias Herald ends in July 2025. I would like to have time to train the next Principal Herald so the change over is smooth.

The Officer is both challenging and rewarding. You will coordinate and work with a great team of Heralds inside and outside our Kingdom.

The responsibilities of this office include:

- Kingdom officers are required to have active membership status with the Society.
- File quarterly reports from your officers and report them to Avacal Curia and the Society Herald, known as Laurel.
- Give good counsel to their Majesties and court regarding heraldic matters. This includes Kingdom awards, devices, precedence, ceremonies, information about the cultural aspects of the Society, and heraldic advice.
- Attend monthly decision meetings to determine the status of heraldic submissions.
- Recruiting and training new heralds is a way to grow the college and build a more significant knowledge base.
- Maintain a welcoming environment and abide by Society and Kingdom, laws and customs.

You are only expected to know and answer some questions but understand what resources are available and how to seek them out.

AVACAL KINGDOM EARL MARSHAL - SR. OFFICER POSITION

The Kingdom Earl Marshal (KEM) is a greater officer position within the kingdom who reports directly to the crown and their society counterpart. This is the person who is responsible for all combat across all disciplines in the kingdom (that's right! I am personally responsible, that's why I am such a PITA at times!).

The KEM receives and files reports to society, is responsible for filling any deputy positions in their office if they are unfilled, supporting combat related activities, and warranting of fighters and marshals. KEM bears responsibility for all combat in the kingdom happening within the rules of Avacal and most importantly safely. That's a big job, do you do it all yourself? Ha! God no, combat (all disciplines combined) is easily the largest activity in the SCA. I have a lot of talented people working behind the scenes to make sure that everyone can continue to have fun safely. I will try to showcase the deputies in the future.

What if I want to be a KEM? Well, you would have to apply like any other officer position. There are no rules stating that you need to be a Sr marshal or a fighter but any crown considering the applicants would consider that an asset. Do you have to settle disputes? Yes, unfortunately not everyone agrees on everything all the time. Right now, the SCA is working on a new chain of command which I will update people on when it comes out. But essentially, I am the end of the command chain in Avacal before it goes to the BoD, it's super rare that it gets to me though. My deputies are amazing, so they handle most things.

There were some issues in other kingdoms about the KEM overriding marshals, is that something you can do? Well, sort of, if someone disputes something they can appeal to my office and I can override the decision, uphold it, or pick a third option depending on the laws of Avacal and the SCA. I have never had an issue with anyone taking it personally though. Like most jobs when dealing with people just don't be a di.... *cough* jerk... and usually everyone is happy.

Can the KEM just decide who is authorized? Well yes and no, there was an issue a couple of years ago at an international war regarding this that I won't go into. The KEM can verify the authorization of a member of their kingdom and the lists take their verbal word as proof of authorization (there are consequences to lying so the KEM must have verified it in some way). The KEM or their deputy must sign off on all Sr marshals and may make Sr marshals in any discipline. However, the KEM is not able to authorize a fighter if they are not a Sr marshal.

SOOO, why can they make anyone a Sr marshal but not authorize them? This power is given to the office so we can start new disciplines like Cut and Thrust where we have no Sr marshals, but someone needs to sign for them. Who is better than the person responsible for all marshals anyways?

On June 5, 2024, the Board of Directors of the Society for Creative Anachronism (SCA) Inc. held a conference call to discuss the possibility of creating a new peerage for various martial activities within the organization. The Board acknowledged the passionate opinions expressed by members and remained committed to finding a solution that would satisfy as many people as possible. After a lengthy discussion, a motion was passed to approve the addition of a "pre-17th century ranged martial pursuits" peerage to the organization's governing document, Corpora. The Board will now work with the Laurel Sovereign of Arms to develop a name and heraldry for the new Order. The Board expressed gratitude to those who have worked towards this decision and will provide further information on the process and timeline for the proposal.

THE PENNSIC WAR

PENNSIC 101

Pennsic War is the annual dispute between the Middle Kingdom (who wears red duct tape to identify them) and the East Kingdom (who wears blue duct tape). Occasionally, we have a "purple war - the blend between red and blue" where the dispute is East and Middle Kingdom versus the Known World. Pennsic has been at <u>Coopers Lake</u> <u>Campground</u> since Pennsic 6 and this year will be Pennsic 51!

So, several Avacalians go to Pennsic every year and often it's a different group each time. Mostly new attendees with now more and more people returning to continue to enjoy the Known World's largest event. One devotee is HL Li Xia who is even part of Pennsic University planning for the fire/glass track. Ask around in your local area and you will probably have someone who has been. So, what is it? Pennsic is a twoweek long camping event. Some people only come for peace week, some only for war week, some for just the weekends. Peace Week goes from the first Friday to Thursday before the middle weekend where most merchants open limited hours and classes at the University have started. War Week goes from the Friday of the middle weekend until the end where the battles start on Sunday of the middle weekend and go until closing ceremonies on Friday. Any or part of Pennsic can be enjoyed!

What can I do? The list is endless! From the over 1500 classes at the University, to the performances at three stages, battles and shoots for war points along with so many specialized tournaments, period games tent (where you can play and learn new ones), middle eastern dance tent, European dance tent, heralds point where you can submit your items, Arts and Science Displays and of course the parties make up Pennsic. To help spend your pennies, we have over 175 merchants (including food restaurants) which is why some years shopping is a war point.

Lots of YouTube videos can help give you a <u>glimpse</u> of what Pennsic is like. Dream about one day you can come and party with the Known World!

HISTORICAL GAMES



Hnefatafl, also known as The Viking Game, is an ancient strategic board game that originated in Scandinavia. The game is played on a square board divided into equal-sized squares. Here are the basic rules for Hnefatafl:

- I. Objective:
 - a. The defending side, consisting of the King and his defenders, aims to help the King escape to any edge of the board.
 - b. The attacking side, consisting of the enemy pieces, aims to capture the King.
- II. Setup:
 - a. The game is played on a board with a 9x9 or 11x11 grid.
 - b. The King piece starts in the center square (the throne) and is surrounded by his defenders.
 - c. The attackers are placed in a symmetrical pattern on the outer squares of the board.
- III. Movement:
 - a. All pieces move orthogonally (horizontally or vertically), but not diagonally.
 - b. The King and defenders can move any number of squares in a straight line.
 - c. The attackers can only move one square at a time.
- IV. Capturing:
 - a. A piece is captured if it is surrounded on two opposite sides by enemy pieces or the edge of the board.
 - b. The King can also be captured like any other piece, except at his throne.


V. Special Rules:

- a. The King can capture enemy pieces by trapping them between two of his defenders.
- b. The attackers cannot occupy the throne square.
- c. The King cannot leave the board he can only escape through the edges.

VI. End of the Game:

- a. If the attackers capture the King, they win.
- b. If the King reaches any edge of the board, the defenders win.

These are the basic rules of Hnefatafl, but variations of the game exist with slight rule differences. The game requires strategic planning and tactical maneuvers to succeed.


