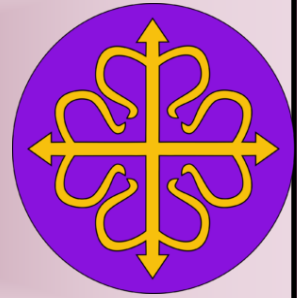

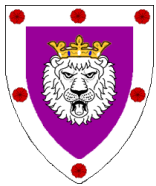

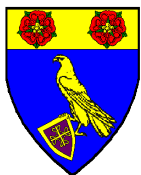

VIII.403 - The Kingdom Seneschal shall be responsible for the appointment, direction, and removal of the Kingdom Advocates, Reeve, Minister of Youth, Media Relations Representative, Waiver Secretary, Park Liaison, and Minister of Social Media.

New

VIII.1100 - THE CHATELAINE shall be responsible for the dispersion of information to new members of the Kingdom and Local Branches.

VIII.1101 - The Chatelaine shall be responsible for the fostering of new member recruitment and development of new member activities at the local branch level.

VIII.1102 - The Chatelaine shall report to the Society Chatelaine.

The following sections were renumbered for continuity.

VIII.404 - THE REEVE of the Kingdom of Calontir shall be responsible for the scheduling of official events within the Kingdom and shall be a deputy of the Kingdom Seneschal.

VIII.405 - THE MINISTER OF YOUTH of the Kingdom of Calontir shall be responsible for the organization of the Kingdom's Ministry of Youth as an entertaining, educational forum for children ages three to seventeen.

VIII.406 - The Minister of Youth shall be responsible for the scheduling of Ministry of Youth activities at all Crown Tournaments and Coronations as well as the War of the Lilies and shall be a deputy of the Kingdom Seneschal.

VIII.407 - The Minister of Youth shall be responsible for the fostering and development of Ministry of Youth activities within the local branches and local branch events.

VIII.408 - THE MEDIA RELATIONS REPRESENTATIVE shall be responsible for distributing information to Local Branches, those duties specified in the appropriate Society policies, Media Relations for War of the Lilies, and shall be a deputy of the Kingdom Seneschal.

VIII.409 - The Media Relations Representative shall be responsible for the image of the Society and the Kingdom to the outside world and should be able to reflect our goals, purpose for existence and the finer aspects of achievement.

VIII.410 - THE KINGDOM PARK LIAISON shall be the main point of contact between the Clay County, MO Department of Parks, Recreation and Historic Sites and the Kingdom of Calontir for the use of Kelsey Short Youth Camp.

VIII.411 - The Kingdom Park Liaison shall be warranted for three years. The third year of the warrant shall be used to train the incoming Park Liaison.

VIII.412 - THE KINGDOM MINISTER OF SOCIAL MEDIA shall be responsible for the official Calontir social media page and other official forms of electronic communication, such as but not limited to email groups, Twitter, etc.

VIII.413 - THE ADVOCATE OFFICE shall consist of three individuals chosen to reflect the diverse Populace of the Kingdom and be responsible for representing the interests of those members of the Populace who have questions or complaints. The Advocates shall be a source of information and provide options and resources for dealing with such complaints or general questions. The Advocates will work with Populace members, Royalty, and Kingdom Officers to work toward resolution of conflict as needed. The Advocates shall be appointed by the Kingdom Seneschal, with a three year expected term of office, replacing one member each year. A member of the Advocate Office may be removed or replaced as the Kingdom Seneschal deems necessary, or as circumstances require.

RUSH is the Royal University of Scir Hafoc, Welsh for Bright Falcon. The University is dedicated to promoting education in Calontir and the SCA.

To recognize your dedication to learning, RUSH offers “degrees” based on classes taken. We have completed migrating the first section of student records to a new database. This has allowed us to identify several people who have earned degrees. We expect this to be a frequent occurrence as we get more records entered. Scrolls are being made and recognitions will happen as we confirm requirements have been met.

Greetings Calontir!

The date of publication of this letter is just before the summer solstice, so it seems a great time to talk about all sorts of out of this world things. Before we get to things in the skies, I'll get the business out of the way.

This letter is also just before CalonCon. We'll be doing a herald's discussion from 2pm to no later than 5pm Central on Zoom. All are welcome to join us, whether you're currently a heraldic officer or curious about heraldry in general.

We'll be discussing various details pertaining to the organization of the college of heralds, some upcoming job openings, and other topics of interest. I'd like everyone's input, so I will be posting an agenda a week or so before

CalonCon on the Herald's email list and on Facebook. In the meantime, I'd like to hear what you all would like to talk about. Email me at goldfalcon@calontir.org if you have suggestions.

Heading hence to heraldry of the heavens!

Starting with stars is a stellar stylistic choice, eh? Memorable mullet merriment!

Okay, enough with the alliteration. Mullet is the term for a star with straight lines in heraldry, not simply a delightful 1980s hairstyle. The estoile is a star with wavy lines. In both cases, you can specify how many points—a mullet of six or an estoile of seven would have six and seven points respectively. Though French communes aren't period, it's fun to note the device of Lagarde-Paréol has a mullet of sixteen points. Sixteen!

You can have bearded stars too, that being a term for comets in period. There are a bunch of examples of this in the SCA's registry.

There are even more example of the moon in both period and medieval heraldry. It can be full face, the Moorish crescent, or a more Western crescent design.

You can have planets too. One example registered in the SCA uses a planetary symbol, and these planetary symbols show up again below. Another example from a French commune has Saturn with its rings, though as far as I know no one's tried that in the SCA.

There's more fun out there if you want to use astrological symbols. Gemini, Leo, and Aries are on SCA registered devices so select Sagittarius, call for Capricorn, or pick your Pisces! Oops, sorry, more alliteration.

Do you want the heavens as a whole? Well, you have choices there too! You can have spheres of three types. First, there's the celestial sphere, which includes planetary symbols and constellations. Then there's the terrestrial sphere, which is an image of Earth. Finally, you can have an armillary sphere or spherical astrolabe. All of these have been registered in the SCA.

So you can see, you can select all sorts of special spatial signs to celebrate! I'll show myself out. Have a great month!

Flyers **MUST** contain these **SIX** ITEMS:

- ◆ Day month and year of the event
- ◆ Site open & close times for populace
- ◆ Name of the sponsoring group or groups
- ◆ Location of the event. The name of the event site, and full address.
- ◆ Name, both SCA and Modern, of the Event

Steward, including contact phone and email. (Needed if there an emergency / or issues arise)

- ◆ Details of Registration : Do NOT use “FEE” as a describer for registration cost.

Discount Registration: \$20 / Youth (6-17) \$5 /
Children 5 & Under: FREE**

Event Copies: An Editable version of your flyer MUST be sent. PDFs ARE NOT ACCEPTED AND RETURNED FOR EDIT.

Deadline: The Chronicler must receive event copies no later than the **1st of the month TWO MONTHS PRIOR to your event.** (e.g. if the event is in November, the flyer must be received by September 1st.) If there is an issue with meeting the deadline, please contact the Chronicler ASAP. There is no grace period the deadline is final and non-negotiable. The earlier a flyer is received the better!
