We will be holding our annual Sun, Sand and Swords Event on March 1st, 2025 with a theme: When in Rome! Join us and do as Romans do at the new Pacific Avenue Athletic Complex Archery Range! That's right, Burning Sands will be holding an Archery competition at this event for probably the first time in the shire's history! Archers can expect Rome themed targets and a modest prize for the archer who dominates! Carpe diem! In addition, we will hold a heavy fighting tournament and a rapier tournament! While forced Gladiatorial combat has long since been outlawed many Emperors ago, fighters seeking to recapture the glory and honor of the golden age of the coliseum are encouraged to volunteer as tribute for the pleasure of the populace! So bring your armory of weapons and be ready to ENTERTAIN!

Don't do fighting or shooting? Don't worry, YOU TOO SHALL BE ENTERTAINED! We have other activities planned for you! We will have a small project area set up for designing your very own roman-style mosaic! We will have limited supplies, so it is first come, first serve! Roman bakers were very competitive, particularly with their breads. So what better way to do as Romans do but to hold a bread making contest?! We invite anyone wanting to test their baking skills to bring their best artisan breads, including dips, dressings, or sauces to give them that extra edge! The single most important duty of any Crown is to ensure the succession of their royal line. To that end, their most magnanimous and benevolent Majesties Morgan Æthelwulf, and Elizabeth Æthelwulf, King and Queen of Atenveldt, do invite all who find these words to attend the Crown tournament of glorious Atenveldt. This will be a weekend event full of fun, fighting, and pageantry located in the Barony of Tir Ysgithr. Join us as we welcome the new heirs while enjoying companionship and revelry in the beautiful lands of southern Atenveldt in the Barony of Tir Ysgithr.

On Saturday you will witness the most Glorious Tournament of our Kingdom where the heirs of Their Royal Majesties of Atenveldt will rise in victory. There will also be a Largesse Derby for those who wish to display and donate their art to show how gracious and generous Atenveldt artisans are. We are asking that anyone interested in donating Largesse to our kingdom, bring THREE items to the Largesse Derby Competition. The Derby winner will be allowed to choose one item to keep from the offerings. Have each item labeled with a description and your name, be durable and unaffected by heat, be suitable to present to Crowns and Coronets of the known world, and be small enough to fit on a plane. Note: scented items must include an ingredients list and be packaged in sealed bags to allow a screen for allergies and prevent cross contamination of items.

On Sunday the Warlord tournament will be held to reveal the kingdom's most worthy mass weapons fighter that will help lead our armies in war. We will also hold the Queen's Rapier Champion tournament to identify the greatest rapier fighter our kingdom has. This tournament signifies the Atenveldt fighter with the greatest prowess in steel swordsmanship. We look forward to your attendance!

Site Information:

- Showers are available as well as stone privies! There is potable water onsite and dumpsters for trash. The site is a Wet site, glass is allowed, but as always, clean up after yourself. Pets are welcome on a leash, and fires are in designated spots as well as any propane fires elevated from the ground. Quiet Hours are from 10 PM to 7 AM. Please be respectful of the other sites.
- RV Campers – Reserve your spot online through AZ State Parks Website. There are limited RV sites available with electric, sewage, and water hookups. You will have to book your campsite separate from the event. Sites are \$35 per night. If you are camping at the park in an RV, please preregister for the event specifying you onsite and in an RV and your event fee will be compensated.
- Equestrian – There is camping at the Equestrian Center for an additional \$25 per night, though you do not have to camp with your horse if you choose to stay at the registered group sites. There are 16 corrals for horses at the park available as a first come, first served basis. There will not be any formally organized equestrian activities at the event; however, the park boasts many horse friendly trails, and horses are welcome to attend the event, but cannot stay in the group campgrounds overnight. Please refer any additional questions about equestrian facilities and reservations to the park (520) 628-5798.
- Parking: When you arrive at the gate, you do not have to pay for parking, simply explain that you are here for the SCA event, and you will be given a parking pass. If you have a state park pass, we ask that you use that instead to help with event costs. Parking for this event is limited. We ask everyone to please carpool whenever possible. Just across the street, there is an In and Out Burger with a huge parking lot. We strongly recommend that you park there and carpool on the way into the park.

Updated Award Charters--BTM

l'Ordre de la Lune Bleue

1. There shall exist in the Barony of Twin Moons an Award known as the Order de la Lune Bleue, which shall be given by the Baron and/or Baroness to those persons who render great service to their Barony.
2. The holder of this award shall be styled "Companion" and shall be entitled to place the initials CLB after their names
3. The insignia of this order shall be Azure, on a pall inverted breasted between two moons in their Plentitude argent, a moon in its complement azure
4. The Crown of Atenveldt shall be the Protector of this order.
5. The Baronial Coronet of Twin Moons shall be the Principal of this order.
6. The first person to receive this award is confirmed as Premier of the order and is entitled to place the initials PCLB after their name.
7. Companions of this order shall be listed in the Kingdom Order of Precedence after the Kingdom and Principality Awards and after the Award of Arms.
8. Amendments to this Constitution shall be made by the Baron and/or Baroness of the Barony of Twin Moons, after due consultation with the Crown of Atenveldt.
9. Membership in the Order of all previous recipients is hereby confirmed

Commandeur de l'ordre de la Lune Bleue

1. There shall exist in the Barony of Twin Moons an award known as the Commandeur de l'Ordre de la Lune Bleue, which shall be given by the Baron and/or Baroness to those persons who have through the years rendered great service to their Barony.
2. The holders of this award shall be styled "Commandeur" and shall be entitled to place the initials "CoLB" after their names.
3. The insignia of this order shall be, Azure, a pall inverted breasted between two moons in their plentitude argent, a moon in its complement azure. This medallion shall be displayed upon a ribbon of Red.
4. Only individuals who have previously been made Companions of l'ordre de la Lune Bleue shall be eligible for this award.
5. Only two individuals shall be given this award per calendar year.
6. The Crown of Atenveldt shall be the Protector of this order.
7. The Baronial Coronet of Twin Moons shall be the Principal of this order.
8. The first person to receive this award is confirmed as Premier of the Order and is entitled to place the initials "PCoLB" after their name.
9. Companions of this order shall be listed in the Kingdom Order of Precedence after the Kingdom and Principality Awards and the Award of Arms and before Companions of Baronial Orders.
10. Amendments to this charter shall be made by the Baron and/or Baroness of the Barony of Twin Moons, after due consultation with the Crown of Atenveldt.
11. Membership in the Order of all previous recipients is hereby confirmed.

Order of the Silver Cap

1. There shall exist in the Barony of Twin Moons an award known as the Order of the Silver Cap, which shall be given by the Baron and/or Baroness to those persons who demonstrate excellence in the Medieval Arts and Sciences of the Current Middle Ages.
2. The holders of the Award shall be styled "Companion" and shall be entitled to place the initials CSC after their names.
3. The insignias of this order shall be
 - a. Ancient Arms: Azure, a pall inverted breasted between two moons in their plentitude and a flat cap argent.
 - b. Azure, a pall inverted breasted between two moons in their plentitude and a cap of maintenance argent
 - c. Azure, a pall inverted breasted between two moons in their plentitude and a bycocket argent
4. The Crown of Atenveldt shall be the Protector of this order.
5. The Baronial Coronet of Twin Moons shall be the Principal of this order.
6. The first person to receive this award is confirmed as Premier of the order and is entitled to place the initials PCSC after their name.
7. Companions of this order shall be listed in the Kingdom Order of Precedence after the Kingdom and Principality Awards and after the Award of Arms.
8. Amendments to this constitution shall be made by the Baron and/or Baroness of the barony of Twin Moons, after due consultation with the Crown of Atenveldt.
9. Membership in the Order of all previous recipients is hereby confirmed.

Commander of the Silver Cap

1. There shall exist in the Barony of Twin Moons an award known as the Commanders of the Silver Cap, which shall be given by the Baron and/or Baroness to those persons who have through the years made major and continuing contributions of excellence in the performance, promotion and teaching of the Medieval Arts and Sciences of these Current Middle Ages.
2. The holders of this award shall be styled "Commander" and shall be entitled to place the initials "CoSC" after their names.
3. The insignia of this order, displayed upon a ribbon of Red to signify that it is of the Commander level, shall be:
 - a. Ancient Arms: Azure, a pall breasted inverted between two moons in their plentitude argent, a cap argent
 - b. Azure, a pall inverted breasted between two moons in their plentitude and a cap of maintenance argent
 - c. Azure, a pall inverted breasted between two moons in their plentitude and a bycocket argent
4. Only individuals who have previously been awarded the Silver Cap shall be eligible for this award.
5. Only two individuals shall be given this award per calendar year.
6. The Crown of Atenveldt shall be the Protector of this order and the Baronial Coronet of Twin Moons shall be the Principal of this order.
7. The first person to receive this award is confirmed as Premier of the Order and is entitled to place the initials "PCoSC" after their name.
8. Companions of this order shall be listed in the Kingdom Order of Precedence after the Kingdom and Principality Awards and the Award of Arms and before Companions of Baronial Orders.
9. Amendments to this charter shall be made by the Baron and/or Baroness of the Barony of Twin Moons, after due consultation with the Crown of Atenveldt.
10. Membership in the Order of all previous recipients is hereby confirmed.

Order of the Crimson Mace



5. Companions of this order shall be listed in the Kingdom Order of Precedence after the Kingdom and Principality Awards and after the Award of Arms.
6. Amendments to this charter shall be made by the Baronial Coronets of Twin Moons, after consultation with the Crown of Atenveldt.
7. The Crown of Atenveldt shall be the Protector of the order and the Baronial Coronet of Twin Moons shall be the Principal of this order.

Maintain Kingdom Law and administer changes to Kingdom Law.

- Advise the Crown on Kingdom Law and Corpora.
- Call such meetings, require such reports, and oversee such events as are necessary for the proper functioning of the Kingdom.
- Monitor official branches within the Kingdom to determine if they are maintaining the standards required for an official group and notify the Crown and the Board of Directors when groups fail to uphold the standards.
- Be ultimately responsible for all official Kingdom and inter-kingdom events held within Atenveldt.
- Distribute a copy of Kingdom Law to Royal Heirs at the time of Crown Tourney.
- Be responsible for the dissemination of information via Southwind any changes to law made by, or considered for change by, the Board of Directors.
- Be responsible for ensuring that Territorial Nobility review law changes proclaimed on any day other than the day of Coronation.
- Participate as a member of the Kingdom Financial Committee including authority as a second signer for a variety of Kingdom Checking Accounts.


