Calontir!!

Pennsic is nigh upon us! And we have a new Crown to lead us to battle. As usual, once we roll over into July, I get excited.

However, there's work to be done. The Heralds meeting at CalonCon had a great turnout and we covered a lot of useful topics, so from my perspective, it was really productive.

I went into the meeting reiterating my two basic principles. First, heraldry is cool. Heralds do their work because they love it. In these letters, I've tried to show just how much fun I have geeking out about heraldry and where that leads me. If any of this has struck a chord with you, let me know and I'll find a way to get you opportunities to muddle around and see how cool it can be for you too.

But the truth is heraldry may seem cool from the outside, but also intimidating. Where do we start? Why so many books? Am I going to have to buy them all? There's just so much, how could I ever learn enough to contribute? These are valid questions. Fortunately, helping out with heraldry isn't as complicated or tough as it seems from the outside. First, it's the responsibility of the College of Heralds to teach you, show you where cheaper resources are available, and give you a leg up. We spent much of the meeting at CalonCon focused on how we can better help educate people new to heraldry so they have all the tools they need to contribute, if that's their desire. We already have a position dedicated to teach heralds, the Habicht Herald. The current Habicht is Lady Shoshanah and she had some great ideas. Also, Calontir pays for Google Classroom, something Mistress Brigida, a former Gold Falcon, knows well. So, you can expect us to offer a variety of classes on heraldic topics going forward. If you prefer to learn by doing stuff instead of in the classroom, I encourage you to approach our heralds. Mistress Dorcas Whitecap routinely hosts consulting tables at events. As part of this, she encourages people interested in the process to join her, no matter their experience, and help. It's quite enjoyable, as I personally can attest.

If you like ceremonies, look for Master Ma'az (he has a longer, cooler name, but most of you know him as Ma'az). If voice heraldry is something you like, hit up

Brynjolfr, our current Battleur (tournament herald) or Johan, who did the job for many years. Or if court heraldry appeals to you, reach out to the current White Hawk, which changes reign to reign, or to a previous one such as myself or Yngvarr.

Moving on, Lady Dryfinna clarified some aspects of e-pay. If you have questions on that, please ask her, because she's a wizard at that.

She also emphasized the SCA College of Heralds will currently only accept paper submissions on Version 4 of the forms. Please don't bring earlier versions to events. There were a number of other details and it was a great meeting. Again, I thank all who joined in.

I may have glossed over tinctures here and there, so I'm going to touch base on them this month. There are two main types (colors and metals), plus a subsidiary one (furs). I'm just going to talk about the first two today. I'll get into furs as we get closer to winter. It's far too right now to even contemplate wearing something furry, even if it's just on your device.

There are five colors: Azure (Blue), Gules (Red), Purpure (Purple—Yayyy Calontir!), Sable (Black), and Vert (Green) and two metals: Argent (White), and Or (Gold).

Some of the names derived from Old French make sense in English. We still use azure as a word for blue. Purpure has to be purple right? Sable is again sometimes used for something black, though it's a bit more obscure.

Gules is a bit more tough, though fun. It derives from an Old French word meaning "a neckpiece made of red fur." Before that, it comes from a word "guele," which means throat. Compare that to English, "gullet." I find that derivation fascinating and I wonder how common such neckpieces were.

Vert you've seen before, though you may not have realized it. Verdigris is a green pigment made from copper salts. Then there's verdant. It's in a variety of other places and it is literally the French word for "green." Argent is not just a one-hit wonder band from the 70s, it's the Latin word for silver (well, argentum, -a, -us, if you want to be pedantic, and I approve of pedantic). If you want to get scientific, this is where the Ag comes from for silver on the periodic table and it means silver or white in heraldry. Hold your head up, we're almost to the end.

Or is our last one, and it comes from Latin as well. This is one of those where the spelling might confuse you, because "Or" is different than the conjunction "or" and Gold is Au on the periodic table, referring to the Latin word "aurum." But, of course, if you pronounce "Or" and "Aur," they're almost the same, and you can see how it shifted in Old French.

So there are the seven main tinctures, and I'll leave you with one other cool thing. We talk about not putting a color on a color or a metal on a metal in heraldry. This is to say, that we put Argent and Or on the colors and vice versa, but never the same on the same. The reason for this rule is that Gules on Purpure, Or on Argent, or other similar combinations don't show up well in across the battlefield.

However, there are periodic examples where they ignored this rule, and chances are you've seen one instance in action. The Kingdom of Jerusalem had Or crosses on an Argent background, and they display this really well in the movie *Kingdom of Heaven*.

And with that, it's time to go. I have to prep for Pennsic while popping in a certain DVD. Director's Cut, duh! In any case, have a great month and see some of you at Cooper's Lake!

Hello Calontir!

Lately there's been some confusion about how to properly submit an event to ensure it gets put on the kingdom calendar, and your group can host. There are processes in place for ALL kingdom level events. A kingdom level event can be a Royal Event, as defined by kingdom law, which has one process. Or just an event that you want to hold for the Kingdom of Calontir, which has a second process. The first thing that any seneschal or autocrat should do is read the Event Submission Guide found here: https://docs.google.com/document/d/1Q3dQ7dZ7Xy4mFfFhs0D5LLUF5NmCxqi5jx63bAVemQI/edit?usp=sharing

Arguably the most important section in that document is the Adding to the Official Kingdom Calendar on page 2 and 3. There are 4 steps that are absolutely necessary, in order to have your event be an official event. If these steps are not completed before the required deadline, you run the risk of not being able to have an official kingdom event.

Royal event process is as follows.

Read the Event Submission Guide and follow the instructions. Go to the Reeve's page on the kingdom website: https://www.calontir.org/seneschal/reeve/. Read through the documentation for the type of royal event you're holding if Crown, Coronation, Kingdom A&S, Kings' Companie of Archers, Masters of the Du-

el, CalonCon, Queen's Prize or wish to autocrat Lilies War.

All Royal Events MUST fill out the Kingdom Level Event Bid Form, currently in PDF form found here: https://drive.google.com/file/d/1PrgQot2u3P1mDswh VvOxIq8DV5LoBNc/view Submit the completed form to the required officers as per the requirements in the instructions. If there are no written instructions (Masters of the Duel, Kings Companie of Archers) Please send the completed form to the Reeve and they will ensure that your bid gets to the correct individuals for the required approval process.

Normal Event Process —

Read the Event Submission Guide and follow the instructions Go to the Reeve's page on the kingdom website: https://www.calontir.org/seneschal/reeve/

Check the Traditional/Reserved Events to ensure you're not conflicting with something: https://docs.google.com/document/d/1kkk2xg8igKkjR3e4lRp5vBVbnv-PW2lvysiKlASEvf8/edit

Fill out and submit your event via Calontir Event Submission Form: https://docs.google.com/forms/d/e/1FAIpQLSc9M5N6 alMMyqeR-Sw8DijZyaI44uTXKogHcIIvd5ezoUjGA/viewform

Once these steps are completed, you must submit your flyer to the MEWS by the 1st of the Month, 2 months prior to the event. For example, if the event is in November, the flyer would be due by September 1st to the Kingdom Chronicler and Kingdom Deputy Chronicler. If you're unsure, please refer to the Chronicler's kingdom webpage: https://www.calontir.org/chronicler/ There are explicit instructions of how to submit a flyer, and those rules must also be followed.



FLYER GUIDELINES

For Their Majesties to hold Court, & for official business to happen, a complete flyer must be published in *The Mews*. Failure to do so means that the Crown can not hold Court at that event. Flyers MUST contain these SIX ITEMS:

- Day month and year of the event
- Site open & close times for populace
- Name of the sponsoring group or groups
- Location of the event. The name of the event site, and full address.
- Name, both SCA and Modern, of the Event

- Steward, including contact phone and email. (Needed if there an emergency / or issues arise)
- Details of Registration : Do NOT use "FEE" as a describer for registration cost.

Adult Event Registration: \$25 / Adult Member Discount Registration: \$20 / Youth (6-17) \$5 / Children 5 & Under: FREE

Event Copies: An Editable version of your flyer MUST be sent. PDFs ARE NOT ACCEPTED AND RETURNED FOR EDIT.

Deadline: The Chronicler must receive event copies no later than the 1st of the month TWO MONTHS PRIOR to your event. (e.g. if the event is in November, the flyer must be received by September 1st.) If there is an issue with meeting the deadline, please contact the Chronicler ASAP. There is no grace period the deadline is final and non-negotiable. The earlier a flyer is received the better!
