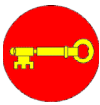

Northshield, harken!

Fall Crown Tournament is fast approaching. Here are the details:

This is a bring-your-best tournament. All Northshield-legal weapons and weapon forms for armored rattan combat are allowed, under the SCA, Inc. Rules of the Lists. We strongly suggest reviewing *The Kingdom of Northshield Armored Combatants Handbook*, all published revisions, as well as the SCA Rules of the Lists.

For the entrants:

Either the fighter or the consort must have held, or be holding, a group office. This includes deputy and 'at-large' positions. Any level of group, any kingdom, at any time. This will need to be stated in the letters of intent.

Either the fighter or consort must have a current rapier or C&T authorization.

Per SCA rules, this tournament will be double elimination. Each fight will consist of a best 2 out of 3 set of exchanges. Double kills during the exchanges will be re fought.

All fighters will be in a single pool, regardless of number of wins or losses. Each round of the tournament, a random pairing will be drawn to determine fight pairings. If there is an odd number of fighters in the round, there will be a nondestructive by-fight with a fighter designated by the Crown. The Lists table will record all pairings by round. After the first round, if the random draw produces a re pairing of fighters from the immediately previous round, all pairings will be redrawn

randomly. If a re pairing occurs on the second draw, all pairings will be redrawn randomly a third and final time for the round. The round will then be fought.

Fighters losing their best 2 of 3 fight will be recorded as having a loss. On their second loss, they are removed from the pool. Rounds continue until only one fighter remains. It is entirely possible that the finals may consist of a fighter with no losses fighting one with one loss. The fighter with one loss will need to win twice.

Per Northshield tradition, all fighters are expected to communicate with each other during their exchanges. All issues shall be resolved before leaving the field. Once a fighter leaves the field after a fight, they are signaling upon their honor that they accept the results of the fight. We expect all fighters and consorts to place honor before victory before, during, and after their fights.

Due to the nature of the single pool, and how fight wins and losses may result, this tournament format can run several more rounds than the normal winner's bracket of a standard double elimination ladder. We encourage everyone to train accordingly.

Finally, please get award recommendations in!

A missive from the Rapier Marshal:
Greetings,

First, we are updating the Northshield Rules for Rapier Combat to include the use of Rapier Spears in both Rapier and Cut-and-Thrust per their regulations in the Society Fencing Marshal's Handbook.

Secondly, what is happening in Rapier? As mentioned above, we are adding spears to the rules, which means people should have seen demos hosted by their respective regional marshal to help people learn about spears, or they will be available to attend soon. There will also be demos at WW where we will discuss and go through authorizations for spear.

In addition, Meister Baldwin and team are working to introduce a youth rapier program. If interested, look at the WW schedule for the time reserved for questions on youth rapier if you are interested.

At Society level, there is a current effort to rewrite the current edition of the Fencing Marshal's Handbook this year. Once

that is complete, we will look to update Northshield's Rules for Rapier Combat to align with society as feasible. At that time we will be looking at the reduced armor and other changes and/or active experiments.

A missive from the Youth Combat Marshal:

Greetings!

For the last six years (and a few months) I've been the Kingdom Youth Armored Combat Marshal for the Kingdom of Northshield. During my tenure we've increased the number of youth fighters and marshals, released a new handbook, introduced new tournament and melee ideas to the youth fighters, and incorporated Youth Sparring into our activities. I've travelled with a car full of loaner equipment to a number of practices and events around the Kingdom to spread the joy of chivalric combat to children far and wide, and I've put many, many miles on my vehicles in the process. For many people I'm the only Kingdom Youth Armored Combat Marshal they've known.

And now it's time for me to step down from this role. At Warriors and Warlords I officially handed over the reins of the Youth Combat program to my successor: The Honorable Lord Aodhan Mhic Gallchobhar. Aodhan is a teacher in real life, and comes from a background of armored combat. He has been an armored combat marshal for years and a youth marshal for a little more than a year. I can coach our young fighters to victory in tournaments both in and out of Kingdom. And I'd still like to bring youth combat to some of the areas of the Kingdom which don't have it yet, including distributing armor and weapons to places where it's harder to get hold of. Kittens and Lava (and stuffed animals by the bucket load) should be spread far and wide.

I could not have held this office for so long without the support of the other youth marshals and marshals-in-training, and, of course, the support of the parents. So thank you to everyone who has helped out, who has donated time and equipment and duct tape, and who has driven their kids and grandkids to events and practices. And to the fighters who have earned their Youth

Sparring authorizations, who help to teach the kids when there are too many of them for the marshals to give them one-on-one instruction ourselves.

So, for the marshals! For the parents! For the fighters! For the new Kingdom Youth Armored Combat Marshal! And for the children of Northshield, *vivant!*

NEW PEERAGE APPROVED PENDING NAME AND HERALDRY

On June 5, 2024, the Board of Directors of Society for Creative Anachronism (SCA) Inc. held an extraordinary conference call to discuss the progress of a path to a prowess related peerage for target archery, combat archery, siege weapons, thrown weapons, and equestrian martial activities. This item was moved from the scheduled conference call of May 30, 2024, to allow for appropriate robust discussion on the matter.

During the call, a range of opinions and options were discussed. The Board was highly appreciative of the feedback they had received from around the Knowne World and wished to acknowledge the passionate opinions expressed which shows a membership who cares deeply about the direction of the SCA.

The Board remained committed to finding that next step, noting again that compromises would be necessary, and no solution will satisfy universally. There was robust discussion of the existing paths that were seen for equestrian activities reflecting that there was potential for inclusion with the Chivalry and the Order of Defense given weapon form choices as well as mounted archery falling within a ranged martial pursuits definition.

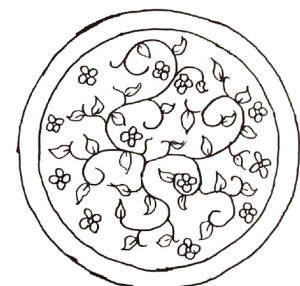
Following discussion of more than hour, an initial motion was raised by Director Krochmal for the Board to approve in principle the addition to Corpora of ‘pre-17th century ranged and mounted martial pursuits’ peerage. Directors Sheppard, Bainter and O’Shea voted in favor, Directors Faulcon, Fisher, Krochmal and Capps voted in the negative. The motion did not pass.

Director Krochmal then raised a second motion for the Board to approve in principle the addition to Corpora of ‘pre-17th century ranged martial pursuits’ peerage. Directors Faulcon, Krochmal, Bainter, O’Shea and Capps voted in favor. Directors Sheppard and Fisher voted in the negative. A two thirds majority having been reached – the motion passed.

With the substance of the language to approve the new peerage in Corpora approved, the Board will now direct the Laurel Sovereign of Arms to develop and submit an appropriate name and heraldry for the new Order to the heraldic comment process to allow for the language to be added to Corpora and a date established for the opening of the new Order.

The Board would like to thank the vast number of people around the Knowne World who have worked tirelessly for many years to ensure that this decision could be made on a compelling evidence base – they appreciate the time, emotional, mental, and physical labor involved. You have the gratitude of the Society.

Further information will be made available as to the process and timeline for the proposal of the potential naming and heraldry of the incipient Order.

Here follows the Court Report of Their Majesties Hans and Genevieve presided over in Regency by Their Excellencies Hamish de Nisbet and Marketta Barfussin from Kingdom Arts and Sciences held on June 1, 2024, at Barony of Windhaven.

IMMEDIATE REMOVAL OF THE KINGDOM OF THE OUTLANDS CROWN AND SPECIFIC RECOGNITIONS

On July 1, 2024, at a Special Meeting of the SCA Board of Directors, the Board has unanimously taken decisive actions regarding the Crown and specific recognitions within the Kingdom of the Outlands.

Effective immediately, Tyler Rowe (Fjolverker the Red) and Melissa Van Hook (Melissa of Monster Hall) have been removed from their positions as Crown of the Kingdom of the Outlands.

After thorough consideration, the Board has determined that their reigns have been unsuccessful, and as a result, no royal titles may be conferred upon them from this reign. Additionally, Tyler Rowe and Melissa Van Hook are prohibited from participation in Royal Lists for the next five years.

In another significant decision, the Board has invalidated the elevation of Guy Kirk (Guy of Castle Kirk) to the Order of the Laurel. This elevation was found to have been improperly granted by the Crown of the Outlands and as such, the decision to invalidate it is effective immediately.

No other awards given during the unsuccessful reign have been invalidated.

The Board of Directors remains committed to upholding the integrity and laws of the Society. These actions have been taken to ensure that

the Kingdom of the Outlands continues to thrive and that its integrity is maintained.

These decisions were reached after significant deliberation and with the advice of our Officers.

Society Officers are working with the Outlands Kingdom Seneschal to support them in the next steps for the Kingdom. It is anticipated that the Heirs will ascend the Throne shortly. More information will be provided to the populace of the Outlands as soon as possible.

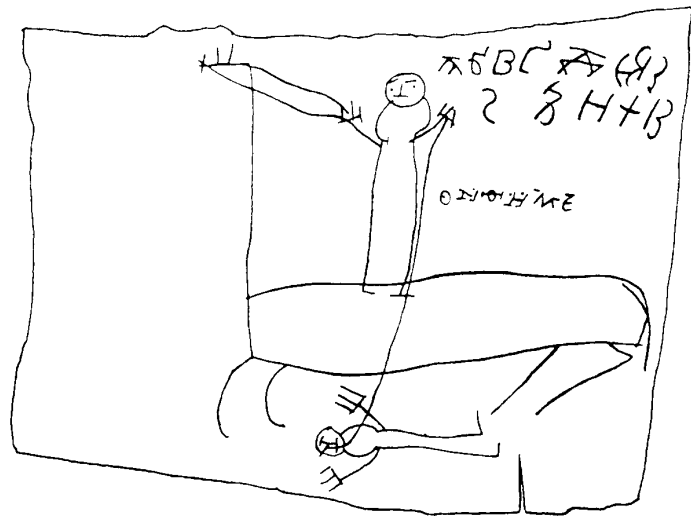
