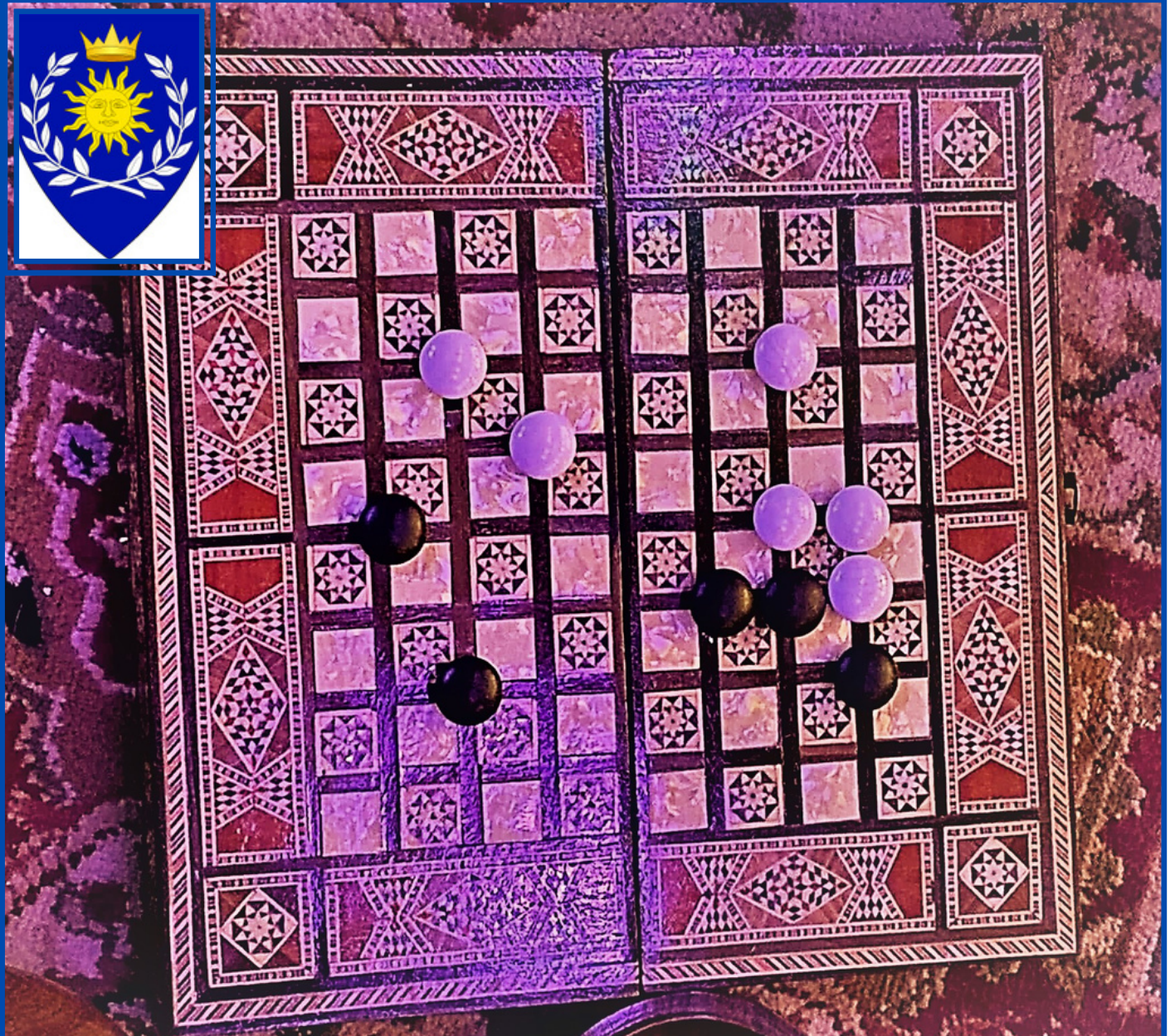

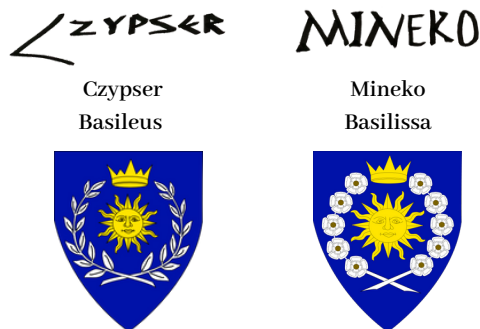
Words From the Crown

DRAFT PROPOSAL FOR COMMENTARY
CORPORATE POLICY XIX. DELEGATION OF INVESTMENT AUTHORITY POLICY



The Board of Directors is currently considering the following addition to the SCA's Corporate Policy:

XIX. Delegation of Investment Authority Policy

The Board shall ensure that fiduciary responsibilities concerning the proper management of SCA, Inc.'s institutional funds are fulfilled through appropriate investment structure, internal and external management, and portfolio performance consistent with all policies and procedures. Based on the advice and recommendations of the Treasurer and its external fund manager(s), the Board shall approve investment policies and objectives that reflect the long-term investment-risk orientation appropriate to the organization. The Board may, at its sole discretion, create or eliminate committee(s) to advise the Board in furthering its duties and may select, appoint, and remove members thereto.

The Board hereby delegates supervisory responsibility for the management of its invested funds to the Corporate Treasurer, subject to the financial limitations specified in Corpora, as noted below:

- determine that institutional funds are prudently and effectively managed with the assistance of management and any necessary investment consultants and/or other outside professionals, if any.
- recommend the retention and/or dismissal of investment consultants and/or other outside professionals.
- receive and review reports from management, investment consultants and/or other outside professionals, if any.
- periodically meet with management, investment consultants and/or other outside professionals management, investment consultants and/or other outside professionals.
- report to the Board (as needed) whether this policy, investment activities, risk management controls and processes continue to be consistent with meeting the goals and objectives set for the management of institutional funds.
- execute such investment transactions as are necessary to ensure that SCA, Inc.'s investment portfolio reflects the asset allocation, investment-risk orientation, or other direction regarding the investment portfolio as has been established by the Board.

Make sure you send your letter to the Crown (Crown@atenveldt.org) and Kingdom Seneschal (Seneschal@atenveldt.org) with all required information, see below. Have a great day!



This letter must include all of the following:

1. Membership numbers and expiration dates, that can be confirmed by the SCA Registry Membership.
2. Statement of Residency and active participation within the Kingdom of Atenveldt for twelve months immediately prior to the Crown Tournament.
3. The status of the name and device of the fighter and consort, either in submission or passed by the College of Heraldry.
4. Contact Information, including Society and Modern names.
5. A copy of the current Atenveldt Fighter Authorization card or other documentation that can be confirmed on the marshallate rolls

For those competing in Crown Tournament the Crown asks that your helms clean of stickers, your weapons be well prepared, and that you have cleanly edged shields.

Letter from the Kingdom Chancellor of the Exchequer

Greetings from the Chancellor of the Office of the Exchequer. It has been my pleasure to serve this kingdom in my role for the past 3 years. As I now relinquish the office, I will continue to support and serve the next chancellor, as her emergency deputy, for a few months as she learns the role of this office.



The following are the mid-year financials for the kingdom. These represent the budget, income, and expenses outside of war (which has its own budget). As you can see, the projected budget that was approved by the kingdom financial committee for 2023 was expected to be a loss of approximately \$10,200. We projected an annual income of approximately \$11,200 and our total-to-date is right at \$4,500 with only 3 events remaining in the current year.

In the last 3 years we have seen a dramatic increase in expenses associated with events such as rental fees and privies. It is common for kingdom event bids to include site rentals fees up to \$2000 for a 2-day event. With a decline in membership and attendance and a profit-split with the hosting baronies, these higher expenses have cut projected kingdom income by more than half.

Many of our local groups are seeing similar declines in income and increase in expenses and are showing a negative trend month-over-month in their own financials. This is also common outside our kingdom and across the known world.

Answers to the most common questions about kingdom finances:

- The facility site fees are 2-3 times more than what they were three years ago.
- The cost for privies is 4-5 times more than what they were three years ago.
- We are being charged for day 2 onsite whether people choose to attend or not.
- Youth under 18 are free, which is why there is no need for a family cap.
- We lose approximately 4% of the credit card income for events to transaction fees.
- There is no revenue from feasts because they are priced to break even.
- We are trying, against much resistance, to sell surplus, unused inventory/regalia so we don't have to pay the storage fees to keep it.
