Unto the Populace of the Outlands:

On July 23rd, 2023, Mordygan and Ymanie of the Outlands issued the sanctions of Exile from the Kingdom of the Outlands against Dextin Wilson, also known in the Society as Don Argyle MacGrigour, and Michel Handlon, known in the Society as Michael Ragnar. These sanctions preclude attendance or participation in any manner at any Kingdom of the Outlands activity, event, practice, or official gathering for any reason, at any time for the duration of Their Royal Majesties' reign. This includes bans on participation in officially recognized Kingdom of the Outlands social media sites, officially recognized electronic email lists, and officially recognized webpages.

While the finishing touches need to be added, as well as a short testing period to ensure the smoothest rollout possible for the Kingdom, we wanted to update those of you that have been patiently awaiting the next step. While we are still a few weeks away from it being ready to replace the current system, hopefully the following will answer some of your questions:

The digital portal will be available to any device with internet connectivity, regardless of the device you choose to use, including web browsers.

The new digital portal will be able to cache data in your (or the MOL's) mobile devices so that even if you leave internet service, the last loaded record of the data will be available.

Increased individualization will allow for even more accurate record keeping, allowing us to keep in good standing with Society.

Martial participants active in multiple disciplines will be able to view all of their authorizations in one record.

All of this is exciting news for the Kingdom, and I cannot thank the volunteers, who have given their time freely, enough for all that they have done. From the North: (Coming from HWY 550/Durango)

Make your best way to Aztec, NM. From Hwy 550/516 Turn South (left) at the first traffic light onto Main Ave (signs will say US-550 S/NE Aztec Blvd). In 0.8 miles you will turn right onto Rio Grande Ave, there is an Aztec Urgent Care at the turn (you will see a Welcome to Aztec sign as you make the turn). The road will become Road 3000. Continue on Rio Grand/Road 3000 for 1.78 miles and then turn left onto Road 3025, and follow the SCA signs.

From the North: (coming from La Plata):

Take the La Plata Hwy (170) south until you reach Main Street in Farmington. Turn left and then stay on Main Street as you come into and drive through the City of Farmington. As you are leaving Farmington, the road will become 516.

As you are leaving Farmington, travel roughly 5 miles and then take a right onto County Road 350 (you will see a Farmer's Market Grocery Store on the left and a Circle K gas station on the right just before the intersection). Travel on County Road 350 for 1.3 miles (you will cross the Animas River) and then turn left onto Road 3000. Stay on County Road 3000 for 3.4 miles and then turn right on Road 3025 and follow the SCA signs.

From the South:

From the South: (Coming from HWY 550/Bernalillo/Albuquerque)

Make your best way to Aztec, NM. Just as you enter the city limit on the south edge of town, turn left onto Rio Grande Ave. Look for the turn just after the speed limit drops to 25 mph, you will see a "Welcome to Aztec" sign. The road will become Road 3000. Continue on Rio Grand/Road 3000 for 1.78 miles and then turn left onto Road 3025, and follow the SCA signs.

Driving from the north: Take I-25 South to I-270 East or take I-70 east. Continue on I-70 and take exit 305 towards Kiowa. Stay on the N Kiowa-Bennet road and once in Kiowa turn left onto CO-86/E Comanche St. Continue to and turn left onto Comanche Creek Road and go to CO Road 150. Turn right onto CO Road 150 and go 2 miles and the site will be on the right.

Driving from the south using I-25: Take I-25 north and take exit 153 for Interquest Parkway to CO-83 and go north. Drive to Hodgen Road and turn right. Turn left onto Eastonville Road. Drive and turn right onto Evans Road and then turn left onto Elbert Road. Drive to and turn right onto CO-86 East. Continue to Comanche Creek Road and turn left. Drive to CO Road 150 and turn right. Continue on CO Road 150 for 2 miles and the site will be on the right.

From the Denver South metro area: Take I-25 South to exit 184 for US 85, North Meadows Parkway toward CO-86 East, Founders Parkway and turn left onto Meadows Parkway towards Franktown. Keep left to continue on Founders Parkway/Meadows Parkway to CO-86. Turn left Drive to and turn right onto CO-86 East. Continue to Comanche Creek Road and turn left. Drive to CO Road 150 and turn right. Continue on CO Road 150 for 2 miles and the site will be on the right.

The site will open at 4:00 pm on Friday, October 20, 2023, and will close at 12 noon on Sunday, October 22, 2023. Electric RV sites must be reserved by you on the Park's website (see below). The Shire of Nahrún Kabirún has reserved the group site "Orion" for the festivities along with camping sites 6 -9 for tent camping use during the event. All camping areas in these sites will be available on a first come first serve basis for those who attend the event. All other sites are available to reserve through Reserve America.
