

•<u>Activities</u>• Brief synopsis of event—fighting, arts & sciences, merchants, et cetera.

•<u>Site Restrictions</u>—wet or dry, no animals, no smoking, et cetera, •<u>Accessibility</u>—handicap parking & entrance/exit ramps, uneven terrain, et cetera

• Duration• Start and stop time of the event.


