THE SCA PROHIBITS HARASSMANT AND BULYING OF ALL INDIVIDUALS AND GROUPS.

The SCA prohibits bullying and harassment of all individuals and groups. Bullying is systematic and unwelcome behavior which involves the use of influence, threat, intimidation, or coercion to cause hurt or harm to another person or group of people. When the bullying behavior is based on a protected class (1), that behavior is defined as harassment.

(1) race, sex, religion, national origin, gender, sexual orientation, age, or disability.

Bullying and Harassment may be **overt**, as in the following non-inclusive list of examples:

- Verbal abuse, including using racial, homophobic, transphobic, ableist epithets, etc.
- Non-consensual physical contact, violence, or threatening gestures.
- Displaying material that is offensive, degrading, or threatening to a protected class.
- Consistent demeaning remarks or malicious teasing -Stalking or predatory behavior

Covert:

- Spreading rumors or innuendo with malicious intent
- Deliberate exclusion, isolation, or alienation of an individual without just cause
- Using rank, title, or office to intimidate others

Provided that the behavior does not rise to the criteria listed above, bullying and harassment is not:

- Single episodes of social rejection, dislike, tactlessness, or forgetfulness.
- Mutual arguments, disagreements, or fights.
- The termination, mutual or not, of a romantic relationship or friendship.
- Reasonable constructive feedback or critique.

The test for bullying is the reasonableness of the behavior and the impact of that behavior on the recipient. Participants engaging in bullying/harassment are subject to appropriate sanctions. If an individual believes they have been subjected to or have witnessed harassment, bullying, or retaliation, that person should contact a seneschal, the President of the SCA, or that kingdom's Board Ombudsman.



Hello! It's your friendly neighborhood Arts and Sciences Minister here with an Æstel update.

Æthelmearc War Practice is hosting The Scarlet Apron Cooking Contest at War Practice 2025: Made to Last

This competition is open to all who have a penchant for medieval culinary arts. Whether you are new to period cooking or a full-fledged laurel, all are welcome at the table!

This year's theme is Made to Last, any kind of food item that is designed to stand the test of time, smoked meats, jerky, pickles, cheese, anything you can find that was made to preserve foods in a pre-refrigerator period. Anyone wishing to participate should create an example of such food from anywhere in the SCA-period. This could be an interpretation of a subtlety that has been described in a coking text, or an original creation that can be considered "period plausible" based on its design, construction and the materials used to create it.

All contestants should follow these guidelines:

- 1. The entry should be made and assembled prior to judging. This is not a competition at which contestants must cook their final product on site.
- 2. The use of period techniques is preferred and encouraged.
- 3. Contestants should provide a recipe and overview of technique. The winning recipe will be added to the Scarlet Apron Cookbook and preserved for prosperity. A complete list of materials used and any references to historical records

that are relevant.

Entries have three potential categories to win: Youth (ages 5-12), Populace Choice, and Overall Winner. Cooks of all skill levels are encouraged to enter! Youth and Scarlet Apron Overall winners will be announced at court. The Overall winner will receive the Scarlet Apron (to be returned the following year), the ability to choose next year's theme and be a judge for 2026, and a scroll of recognition. All entrants will receive a one-of-a-kind pewter token specific to this year.

lowmoonmal@gmail.com, Willow Malbrough on Facebook. We are so excited to renew this competition and are looking forward to tasting all the wonderful entries.

In addition, alongside the Scarlet Apron there will be an Apothecary Guild-hosted drink competition for non-brewed alcohol and non-alcoholic beverages. This is mostly unofficial, but there will be prizes for the top three competitors in nonfermented alcoholic beverages and nonalcoholic brews and beverages.

There are several monthly crafting socials throughout our kingdom, so check out the local groups like Endless Hills, Blackstone Mountains, BMDL, Myrkfaelinn, and Thescorre to see who is hosting gatherings—join in on the fun. Court Reports


