

I hope you are all settled in with your winter A&S projects. I have two looms warped and about 3 items cut awaiting needle and thread. I look forward to seeing all the entries at Queens Prize in April.

Happy New Year!

My time as Gold Falcon will soon end and I would leave you all with a challenge. I ask all to do something heraldic in 2025. This can be registering your device for the first time, heralding a tournament, embroidering a tunic with your device, or anything

else you can think of. I'll be making a new six-board chest and painting it with my colors.

Today, however, I want to talk about a particular legal case. Argued in 1389, Scrope v. Grosvenor is not only fun, it actually shapes how we do heraldry in the SCA today.

I should mention, before I go too far, Scrope is actually pronounced "scroop" and may be derived from the Anglo-Norman word for "crab." Their motto, "forward if I can," might have the double meaning of a crab only going sideways.

Anyway, one aspect of registering a device in the SCA is the conflict checking process. It's where heralds determine whether a submitted device is too close to another one already registered in the SCA or another relevant list. Heralds do this because heraldry is a personal thing. If someone recognizes your registered device, they know it means you and nobody else.

This personal identification is at the heart of heraldry. The Bayeux Tapestry shows a number of shields with symbols, but as there's no evidence these symbols referred to Harold, William, or anyone else, they're not heraldry.

While this may seem like boring minutiae primarily useful only to leaders in the Middle Ages who needed to know who was in that field over there, it remains important today. The classic example, of course, comes from *Coming to America*.

John Amos plays Cleo McDowell who says, "See, they're McDonald's. I'm McDowell's. They got the Golden Arches, mine is the Golden Arcs." The Golden Arches reflect McDonald's and no one else. McDowell tries to be sly for his own advantage, and using a heraldic image improperly is a part of copyright law.

Anyway, Scrope v. Grosvenor involved this precise question. Both families bore the device Azure, a bend Or, which is a diagonal yellow stripe on a blue background.

But wait, I have to digress, but this time to another case involving the Scropes and a Cornish family who also bore Azure, a bend Or. The Carminows claimed they'd used it since the days of King Arthur and the Scropes said they'd had theirs since fighting with William in 1066. However, the judge deemed Cornwall a different country and decided that both could keep the same arms.

However, this wasn't true of the Scropes and Grosvenors. In 1385, as they both followed Richard II into Scotland, they realized they shared arms. Scrope then brought the case to court, where both Scrope and Grosvenor claimed usage since Hastings.

So in 1389, the His Majesty's High Court of Chivalry adjudicated the case. The presiding judge was Thomas of Woodstock, 1st Duke of Gloucester, at the time the Constable of England.

This court had some interesting witnesses, including John of Gaunt, Duke of Lancaster, son of Edward III, father of Henry IV, and grandfather of Henry V. You all surely remember that we spite Henry IV Bolingbroke in *Hotspur*.

Another witness was a then little-known Welshman; Owain Glyndwr. We sing of Glyndwr in *Hotspur* as well, but while Henry Percy hoped he'd help fight Bolingbroke at Shrewsbury, Owain was busy fighting in South Wales and couldn't make it.

Anyway, Scrope won and got to keep the device, but it added that Grosvenor could keep the device if he added a border of white. That's a point of distinction, my friends, just like heralds in the SCA talk about today.

Perhaps influencing the decision was the person who spoke for him, one Geoffrey Chaucer. I find that fun and meaningful when I watch *A Knight's Tale*.

Anyway, today's heralds require *two* points of distinction, which interestingly enough, something it seems like King Richard II agreed with.

That initial decision pleased neither party, so they brought it before Richard. He ruled that the white border did not differentiate the device enough for two unrelated families in the same country. He judged again for Scrope.

This meant Grosvenor had to make another device, and he chose Azure, a Garb Or, which became the ancient arms of the Earls of Chester and is still used by the Dukes of Westminster. The current holder of the title? One Hugh Grosvenor.

However, don't think the Dukes of Westminster have forgotten this case. Their first duke, Hugh Grosvenor (there's been a few of them, owned a thoroughbred racehorse in 1877 named Bend Or. It won the Derby in 1880, so take that, you dastardly Scropes!

So, the SCA's system may irritate people as they register devices, but we can perhaps take some consolation in the fact that this system has irritated people for over six hundred years.





Event Flyer Guidelines

For Their Majesties to hold Court, & for official business to happen, a complete flyer must be published in The Mews. Failure to do so means that the Crown can not hold Court at that event. Prior to emailing a flyer confirm your event with the Reeve. The Mews WILL NOT publish an announcement if your event has not been approved or confirmed. Check the Kingdom Calendar at: https://www.calontir.org/events/

Editable: An Editable version of your flyer MUST be sent. Work with the Social Media Officer for flyers that may be posted on social media.

Deadline: The Chronicler must receive event copies no later than the 1st of the month THREE MONTHS PRIOR to your event. *For Example:* If the event is in November, the flyer must be received by August 1st for the September Mews. Refer to the Calendar at the front of the Mews.

If there is an issue with meeting the deadline, please contact the Chronicler ASAP. There is no grace period. The deadline is final and nonnegotiable. The earlier a flyer is received the better!

Flyers MUST contain these SIX ITEMS:

- 1. Name of the sponsoring group or groups
- 2. Day, month, and year of the event
- 3. Site open & close times for populace
- 4. Location of the event—the name of the event site, and full address.
- 5. Name, both SCA and Modern, of the Event Steward, including contact phone and email (Needed for emergencies or issues arise)
- 6. Details of Registration—Do NOT use "FEE" as a describer for registration cost.

For Example:

Adult Event Registration: \$25 Adult Member Discount Registration: \$20 Youth (6-17) \$5 Children 5 & Under: FREE
