From the Pikestaff Editor

There has been a rash of late event announcements in the past six months.

As a reminder to all Seneschals and event stewards:

Your event announcement MUST be receveived by the Pikestaff no later than the first of the month PRIOR to the month of your event. For example, a May event must be received no later than April 1st.

Several important factors to remember:

- 1. Your announcement must be complete to get published. This means that you have to put something into every section on the EK event page, even if that is 'To be determined' or 'To be announced'.
- 2. Seneschals are required to approve event announcements within their geographic area. Please actually read those announcements before approving them we had one that was approved where a minor's phone number was included.
- 3. In order for an event to be considered 'official', it must be published in the Kingdom Newsletter (Pikestaff for the East Kingdom). If your event is not published, then no official business can take place. This includes, but is not limited to:

Royal Courts Baronial Courts where items affecting OP occur EK or Baronial Championships Royal Round scores
