Dragon's Fount of Knowledge is meant to be, in my intended image, the essence of what a "Newcomers" event should be. # Hamlets: To Be or Not to Be a Branch

### What Is an SCA Hamlet?

At the April 12<sup>th</sup> 2025 Board of Directors' meeting • a variance requested by the Society Seneschal was granted to extend and expand the hamlet experiment to include • interested kingdoms on a case-by-case basis following the current guidance and requirements set forth by the Society Seneschal. This experiment would conclude July 31, 2027. At that time the Society Seneschal will deliver a report and recommendation as to whether to adopt hamlets • as a new branch designation.

A Hamlet is a new type of branch in the Society for Creative Anachronism (SCA), designed for small or far -flung groups that need time and space to rest, rebuild, and remain connected to the SCA without the full administrative demands of a traditional branch.

This designation helps keep the SCA alive in rural areas or groups that have experienced burnout, offering a path to regroup and grow again at a sustainable pace.

#### How a Hamlet Is Formed

A Hamlet can be created from the remains of a dissolved group. Here's how the process works:

- The original group must be officially dissolved by the SCA Board of Directors.
- Remaining members in that territory may petition the Kingdom to form a Hamlet.
- The territory is then assigned to a neighboring Shire or Barony, who will act as the sponsoring branch.
- The **sponsoring branch must agree** to take on this responsibility and include the Hamlet in its oversight.
- Any funds or property from the old group must be turned over to the Kingdom or another recognized branch. Hamlets cannot hold their own funds or property.

## Name and Heraldry

- The Hamlet may refer to itself as "The Hamlet of \[Former Group Name]".
- It may continue using the old group's registered arms, even those containing a laurel wreath. No new heral-dic submissions can be made until the group regains full branch status.

### What a Hamlet Can Do

- Host meetings, A&S gatherings, and fighter or archery practices (if a warranted marshal is present).
- Hold public demos, as long as at least one paid SCA member is present and designated as "person in charge." Demos should be approved by the sponsoring branch and placed on the Kingdom Calendar.
- Participate in the sponsoring group's activities.
- Maintain visibility and connection with the broader SCA.
- Example: "The Barony of Stillaround will be holding a fighter practice in the Hamlet of Goneaway."

#### What a Hamlet Needs

- At least one paid member to act as a liaison between the Hamlet, the sponsoring group, and the Kingdom. This person is not a formal officer but helps keep the lines of communication open.
- A commitment to SCA values and policies.
- No formal officers, reports, or bank accounts required.

#### Why Choose Hamlet Status?


- Hamlet designation is perfect for:
- Former groups with declining membership or high officer burnout.
- Rural communities that are too small to maintain full branch status.
- Groups who want to \*\*rest, regroup, and rebuild\*\* while staying connected.
- Maintaining SCA \*\* presence and identity\*\* in outlying areas.
- Over time, and with renewed energy, a Hamlet can work toward full status again by following the incipient branch process.

#### Is This an Experiment?

Yes—but a thoughtful one! The SCA is tracking the following data to evaluate Hamlets as a long-term branch type:

- Number of members at time of dissolution and petition
- Presence of warranted marshals and frequency of practices
- Classes and local activities
- Participation with the sponsoring branch
- Growth in membership and engagement
- Frequency of informal "check-ins" or updates

The Hamlet experiment will run until 31 July 2027.
