

Congratulations to Elias and Adalyde on stepping up to the Falcon Thrones. I may be biased, but I love having bards on the throne.

Speaking of bards, Johann Steinarsson is handling the Crown Tournament that will have just happened when this issue of the Mews gets published. He'll be stepping down after a long term as Battleur Herald, the herald in charge of field heraldry in Calontir. You've probably heard me say this before, but he's done a fantastic job in that role. He added a number of innovations and he'll leave a proud legacy there.

At Crown Tournament, I hope to have a decision made on his successor. They'll have big shoes to fill.

As for the other current job opening, Red Hawk Herald, I'm extending the time for letters to the 1st of May. This is perfect for someone without much experience in book heraldry but wants to get good at it. Many thanks to Ava Alixandre de Bourges for all her work in this position.

And that's all I have for you this month!

Right. I might be writing this at or near the first of April, the month for fools. The word "fool," by the way, comes to us from Latin as a derivation of meaning from "bellows." Fools, after all might be windbags or have puffed cheeks. Bellows, if you're interested is an old word, going back at least to Proto-Indo-European.

The jester comes from "gesta," the Latin word for deeds. You French speakers may recognize the term *chanson de geste*, which is a poem of heroic deeds. The *Song of Roland* is an example. Didn't think I could tie Roland to jesters, did you!

Better yet, I can tie April Fool's Day to heraldry... and one of the medieval classics... and soccer... and back to heraldry used in the modern world!

In the Nun's Priest tale in the Canterbury Tales by Geoffrey Chaucer in a vain cock Chauntecleer is tricked by a fox "Sin March bigan, thritty dayes and two," or April 1st. Now, to be fair, it's possible that this isn't what

Chaucer meant as some scholars think there's a copying error in that line, but I'm going to run with it. Almost certainly, April Fool's Day goes back to at least about that time, as it's definitely mentioned in a French poem in 1508.

In any case, let's talk about heraldry, specifically, the heraldry of Geoffrey Chaucer. He bore the arms: Per pale argent and gules, a bend counterchanged. If you're reading this, you probably already know that means it's split down the middle with white to the left and red on the right, with a diagonal bar of red changing to white.

But Chaucer's connection to heraldry is a bit more than just that. His father-in-law, Paon de Roet, was a herald and a knight. His device was Gules, three wheels Or.

Froissart says he was one of a group of young squires who were part of Philippa of Hainault's retinue. Philippa, you surely remember, was the wife of King Edward III. Another of Paon's daughter was the mistress and later wife of John of Gaunt, who founded the House of Lancaster, making Chaucer the sort of step-grand-uncle of English kings.

The first Lancastrian king, by the way, was Henry IV. You might recognize him by his last name, "Bolingbroke." If not, ask me and I'll happily sing *Hotspur* for you.

Oops, got distracted by all the interconnections. Anyway, Paon got named by Edward III as the King of Arms for Aquitaine, which made him sort of like Gold Falcon of Calontir, but with sadly much less purple.

You've all seen Aquitaine's heraldry, by the way, even if you didn't know it, because it's still used in things you might regularly see. It's Gules, a leopard Or. Actually, the term "leopard" in medieval heraldry was simply a code for "lion passant guardant," or a lion walking past looking at the viewer.

Richard I, the Lion Heart, was Duke of Aquitaine at one point and took that lion, added a couple more, and boom, you have his arms: Gules, three lions passant guardant Or. These would become the Royal Arms of

England.

But wait, there's more! These lions, though changed to blue, adorn the shirts of the English national soccer team. That gave them the nicknamed of the Three Lions, so every time they take the field, you get to see a connection to Richard I. And Aquitaine. And Chaucer.

It really does take a fool like me to delve into these rabbit holes, eh?



FLYER GUIDELINES

For Their Majesties to hold Court, & for official business to happen, a complete flyer must be published in *The Mews*. Failure to do so means that the Crown can not hold Court at that event. Prior to emailing a flyer confirm your event with the Reeve. *The Mews* **WILL NOT** publish an announcement if your event has not been approved or confirmed. Flyers MUST contain these SIX ITEMS:

- ◆ Day month and year of the event
- ◆ Site open & close times for populace
- ◆ Name of the sponsoring group or groups
- ◆ Location of the event. The name of the event site, and full address.
- ◆ Name, both SCA and Modern, of the Event

Steward, including contact phone and email. (Needed if there an emergency / or issues arise)

- ◆ Details of Registration : Do NOT use “FEE” as a describer for registration cost.

**Adult Event Registration: \$25 / Adult Member
Discount Registration: \$20 / Youth (6-17) \$5 /
Children 5 & Under: FREE**

Event Copies: An Editable version of your flyer MUST be sent. PDFs ARE NOT ACCEPTED AND RETURNED FOR EDIT.

Deadline: The Chronicler must receive event copies no later than the **1st of the month TWO MONTHS PRIOR to your event.** (e.g. if the event is in November, the flyer must be received by September 1st.) If there is an issue with meeting the deadline, please contact the Chronicler ASAP. There is no grace period the deadline is final and non-negotiable. The earlier a flyer is received the better!
