- Site Fee(s) including any applicable surcharges
- An attached copy of the SIGNED event form
- Consider including details such as directions to the site, merchant information, event activities, site restrictions, and ADA accessibility options.

Events which have not published all of the above information in the Kingdom newsletter are not eligible to have awards, law changes, or other Official Kingdom business conducted at them.

- All submissions must be received by midnight on the 1st of the PREVIOUS month (see the Calendar). The deadline does not change for Sundays or holidays. Late submissions may not make it into that month's issue.
- Articles may be reformatted for publication. Please use a single font; do not use tabs or create columns.
- Event Articles should be provided as an attached MS Word, .txt, or Open Office file.

<u>Call for Applicants for Tournaments Illuminated Editor</u>

The Society for Creative Anachronism, Inc. is seeking candidates for the position of Editor for Tournaments Illuminated. This is a part-time stipend position with a three-year warranted term of service.

The successful candidate will be primarily responsible for the publication of the quarterly SCA magazine, Tournaments Illuminated.

Duties and Responsibilities of the Editor include, but are not limited to the following:

- Working with the TI Art Director, staff and authors to produce the quarterly magazine on schedule;
- Answering queries in a timely, courteous, and professional manner;
- · Developing and maintaining relationships with authors and other content providers;
- Developing manuscripts with authors based on the audience of Tournaments Illuminated, general readability and (where appropriate) historical accuracy;
- Developing and working with a volunteer staff of reviewers (TI Review Panel);
- Recruiting (as needed), overseeing, working and communicating with column contributors;
- Developing new coverage areas and varieties of content that reflect the interests and priorities of TI readers and the wider SCA community;
- Developing a program for close communication with Kingdom representatives to help determine interest areas and contributors;
- Establishing and managing a team to support TI ventures, such as gathering and disseminating information, promoting the publication, and SCA community outreach for reader involvement;
- Reaching out to potential subscribers and authors and generally raising awareness of TI and SCA publications via virtual events, podcasts, social media, and other online opportunities;
- Manage the Tournaments Illuminated Team of volunteers and deputies;
- · Assess and meet the diverse needs of the readership, as TI is meant for all members and participants, at all skill and experience levels;
- Quarterly Reports to the Board of Directors through the Publications Manager.

This position requires approximately 10+ hours per week, except during the two to four weeks prior to publication, when more time is spent putting an issue together. Qualifications for the position include excellent written and oral communication skills, the ability to work independently to prioritize tasks and meet deadlines, strong computer skills, ability to organize a staff, and familiarity with SCA publications and social media programs and platforms. Professional experience in a modern editing environment and prior experience in an SCA Chronicler position are desirable, but not required. Successful candidates for this position must have easy access to phone, mail, internet, and reliable e-mail service. An applicant must be a paid member of the Society and must be able to meet publication and reporting deadlines in a timely manner.

The Society Marshal is pleased to announce that she has appointed Caitrin McCullough (Magistra Lilias de Cheryngton, OD) to the role of Deputy Society Marshal for Rapier. The Deputy Society Marshal for Rapier reports to the Society Marshal in matters concerning Rapier and Cut & Thrust, including related experimental programs. The position oversees these activities and works to promote and improve safety. The deputy also supports and advises Kingdom Marshals of Rapier and C&T, oversees proposed kingdom rules changes to ensure compliance with Society Handbooks, and helps resolve disputes among Rapier and C&T marshals.



Magistra Lilias de Cheryngton has been a member of the rapier marshallate for approximately 25 years, primarily serving the East Kingdom's Central Region in the Barony of Carolingia and Shire of Quintavia. Since joining the SCA in 1998, she has dabbled in all manner of activities including cooking, dance, calligraphy, pottery, equestrian, thrown weapons, and archery. She also served as chronicler and exchequer for her local branches in the past. Most recently, she was East Kingdom Marshal of Fence 2018-2022 and served as Rapier One at Pennsic 47. Her priorities as a leader within the rapier community have been to increase accessibility and inclusivity, support geographically isolated areas, and encourage experiments that increase the historical accuracy of the activity. She is a member of the Order of Defense.

Caitrin McCullough is a Supervisory Logistics Management Specialist for the Soldier Division of the Tank-automotive and Armaments Command Integrated Logistics Support Center with over 15 years of service to the country as an Army Civilian. She is a Section Leader for a team that manages logistics support for smartphones, batteries, body armor, physical fitness testing, and other gear used by Army Soldiers. Her educational background is in writing, with a dual English and Philosophy bachelor's degree from Wellesley College and a Master of Arts in Writing, Literature, and Publishing from Emerson College. She also holds a Master of Science in Management from Emmanuel College. She lives in Massachusetts with her partner Timothy, 2 kids, and a dog.

We stay with a one day format, when archers as well as fighters battle it out for supremacy!

Gates open at 8 am for court at 9 with closing court where all the titles will be awarded. The gates must be closed by 7 pm. So it's going to be a jam packed day!

An arts activity will be available for people not consumed by the fighting, led by our Baronial Arts Champion! The event will be at Naranja Park, at 810 W. Naranja Drive, Oro Valley (which is in the Tucson valley). From the interstate (I10), exit at Tangerine Drive. Drive east to La Canada Drive and turn south (right) onto it. Then east (Left) on Naranja Drive until you reach the park.

This park has limited shade structures; feel free to bring your own. Staking is not allowed. Stone privies are available. The site does not allow alcohol, and dogs, while welcome, must remain leashed except in the dog park area. As is traditional, the event is low cost. In fact, so low cost it is FREE!
