# From The Kingdom Seneschal

To all members of the populace:

The Office of the Kingdom Seneschal is conducting a search for three separate positions within the KSen office.

Letters of Interest are sought for the position of Deputy Kingdom Seneschal. This is a replacement deputy; the expectation for this office is that they will step up as Kingdom Seneschal on the date of the Fall 2024 Crown Tourney. The duties of the Kingdom Seneschal are codified in [Lex Artemisia](#). Additionally, candidates must be effective communicators, provide evidence of leadership prowess, and be familiar with kingdom laws and customs as well as SCA, Inc. governing documents and policies.

Letters of Interest are sought for the position of Warrant Officer, a deputy position under the Kingdom Seneschal. The Warrant Officer will be responsible for maintaining the kingdom warrant roster, for administering an archive of all (non-roster) officer warrants, and for managing background check requests to the Society. Interested candidates must be familiar with Google Workspace and its associated applications (on which the kingdom workspace resides), have reliable access to the internet, and be prompt and effective communicators.

Letters of Interest are sought for the position of Workspace Admin, a deputy position under the Kingdom Seneschal. The Workspace Admin will be responsible for the care and feeding of the kingdom's Google Workspace, including email administration, workspace sharing concerns, and website production. Interested candidates must be familiar with Google Workspace, including its resident applications such as Google Sheets, Docs, Forms, and Sites. Experience with Apps Script programming is helpful though not required, but all applicants must have basic computer programming skills in their background. They must have reliable access to the internet and be prompt and effective communicators.

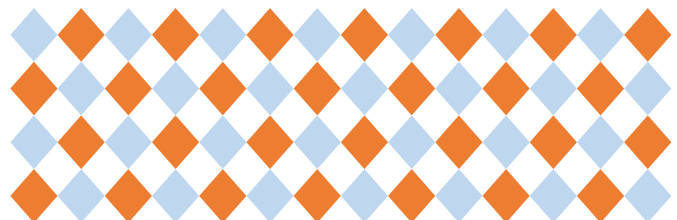

## INFORMATION ON THE WILLIAM BLACKFOX AWARDS

***If you missed Collegium last month, here is a little bit about one of the awards Chroniclers and those that submit material are nominated for. Please help out your local chronicler by submitting articles, pictures, experiences or even a recipe you tried. These items not only help fill the newsletter with interesting information, but is one of the first things a newcomer reads and helps to draw in new members.***



Master William Blackfox was the author and illustrator of the cartoon *Warthaven*. He gave generously of his time and talents, and was very supportive of the Kingdom Chroniclers until his untimely death.

To honor his memory, the Office of the Society Chronicler sponsors the annual Master William Blackfox Awards to recognize excellence in the work of Chroniclers and newsletter contributors. Newsletters provide a valuable resource and communication tool for SCA members around the world!

### **How are people nominated for the William Blackfox Awards?**

The Kingdom Chroniclers make the initial nominations from the works in their Kingdom. (Kingdom Newsletters and Corporate Publications are not eligible.) All kingdoms are encouraged to participate and send in at least two nominations for each of the seven categories. (Note to all Chroniclers – be sure to send copies of your publications to your Kingdom Chronicler. Not only is it policy for you to do so, but it is the only way you can be nominated to participate in this competition.)

Most kingdoms notify nominees of their nomination, either by mentioning their names in print or by sending them a letter congratulating them on their fine work and their nomination to the competition. It is important that all participants realize that the nomination of their work is an indication of excellence. The entries are then separated into the eight categories and the judging is completed by the Society Chronicler, with the assistance of disinterested individuals or experts, where necessary.

In each category, a winner and a Commended entry are chosen. The winners of the William Blackfox Awards, along with those entries recognized as Commended, will be announced each fall, and will appear in the Kingdom newsletters and *Tournaments Illuminated*.
