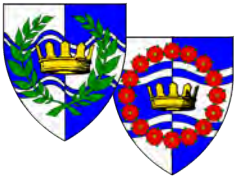

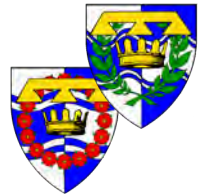

Follow Hwy. 401 straight through Society Hill (Gaily and Lord plant will be on the left as leave Society Hill). Go 7 miles, look for Hwy. 912. Turn LEFT onto Hwy. 912. Follow Hwy. 912 for 8 miles until ends at Hwy. 9. Turn LEFT onto Hwy. 9 and then turn RIGHT onto Ebenezer Rd. (you will see a church and a water tower). Follow Ebenezer Rd. for 3 1/2 miles. If you do choose to follow your GPS, for your safety please ignore any instruction to make a U-turn from US15 northbound to US15 southbound. Instead, just continue heading north for 3–5 miles. Your GPS will recalculate and direct you to Route 77, a much safer and easier choice.

From the Washington Beltway, I-495: take I-270 North to Frederick

From the Baltimore Beltway, I-695: take I-70 West to Frederick

Please follow the directions below to access our property from Frederick/Baltimore/DC:

Directions from Frederick/Baltimore/DC:

Take Route 15 North towards Gettysburg and Thurmont (from Washington, I-270, this is not truly an exit; continue straight on I-270, which blends into 15 North). Thurmont is about 15 miles northwest of Frederick.

There are three Thurmont exits; take the second exit, for Route 77. The exit ramp is a very sharp curve and the deceleration lane is short, so take care here. At the stop sign turn RIGHT onto Route 77 West, towards Hagerstown and Smithsburg. Stay on this windy, climbing road for approximately 2.9 miles, and just after Park Central Road on the right, turn LEFT onto Catoctin Hollow Road. At this point, you are entering Cunningham Falls State Park (William Houck Picnic Area) and you will see the lake on your right, through the trees.

Continue on Catoctin Hollow Road approximately 2.8 miles, pass Wigville Road, and turn RIGHT onto Mink Farm Road. 12805-A Mink Farm Road

From the North (Harrisburg/Gettysburg Areas)

(301) 271-2823 (Cell service may be patchy in the mountains.)

Please follow the directions below to access our property from Harrisburg/Gettysburg:

Take Route 15 South to Thurmont

There are three Thurmont exits; take the second exit, for Route 77. At the stop sign at the bottom of the ramp turn Left onto Route 77 West towards Hagerstown and Smithsburg.

Stay on this windy, climbing road for approximately 2.9 miles, and just after Park Central Road on the right, turn LEFT onto Catoctin Hollow Road. At this point, you are entering Cunningham Falls State Park (William Houck Area) and you will see the lake on your right through the trees.

Continue on Catoctin Hollow Road approximately 2.8 miles, pass Wigville Road, and turn RIGHT onto Mink Farm Road. 12805-A Mink Farm Road

Travel I-70 East toward Frederick and take Exit 42, turning LEFT at the end of the ramp onto MD Rte 17 North towards Myersville.

Follow 0.8 miles and turn right to continue of Rte 17; continue straight at traffic light (Alt. 40)

Stay on 17 North for the next approximately 6 miles, turning RIGHT onto Middlepoint Road.

Continue up this steep steep road (1.8 miles) to where it TEES with Tower Road, where you will turn LEFT, traveling for approximately 1/2 mile.

Tower makes a hard left BUT you leave Tower at this point by going STRAIGHT which becomes Mink Farm Road, a gravel road. 12805-A Mink Farm Road
