Proposed Law Changes

Proposed Law Changes – Summer 2024

The following changes to Kingdom Law are proposed.

1. DEI Officer to become a Kingdom Great Officer

Due to the formation of the Society DEIB Officer, the Kingdom DEI Officer will now become a Kingdom Great Officer under its Society counterpart, moving out of the Kingdom Seneschal's office.

Specifically, Section VI.B.10 (describing the Kingdom DEI Officer will become Section V.B.9 under the section "Kingdom Great Officer."

The (new) Section V.B.9.g regarding reporting requirements shall be stricken (because reporting requirements will now come directly from the Society DEIB Officer).

The name of the office shall be changed to The Kingdom Diversity, Equity, Inclusion, and Belonging (DEIB) Officer.

This change is needed to align kingdom law with Corpora and the creation of the Society DEIB Office.

2. Kingdom Event to be Held in June Coinciding with the Juneteenth National Holiday

Section X.C.4 to be changed from

There shall be a Kingdom event held on the third weekend of June, coinciding with the Juneteenth National Independence Day holiday.

to

There shall be a Kingdom event held in June, coinciding with the Juneteenth National Independence Day holiday.

This change is needed because of the shifting day of the week of the Juneteenth Holiday.

3. Spring Coronation to be moved to the fourth weekend of March

(No change to kingdom law is needed. Current law provides for the Kingdom to "reserve the right to select event dates for Kingdom events which will take precedence over all other proposed event dates.)

This change is to allow the populace of the kingdom to more easily attend Gulf Wars this change will go into effect in 2025.

4. Anyone May Wear a Simple Circlet no greater than ¼" in width

Appendix B – The Sumptuary Customs of the Kingdom of Artemisia, shall be amended to include

Section G. Circlets

1. Unadorned circlets of width no greater than ¼" may be worn by anyone who wishes to do so.

Random Carp that I have learned...

A look at modern practices and their medieval sources by K. Braden von Sobernheim

Cooking and baking are second nature to all of us (okay, MOST of us. There are a select few who burn water), with cooking being an active and involved part of civilization for... well it is one of the definitions of civilization. Nowadays we have it pretty easy. We preheat the oven, put in the food, set a timer, and bake. So what did they do for the previous 10,000+ years? Guess? As it turns out, science has the answer.

Wood starts to combust at 300°F, or 150°C. Banked coals, where your wood is just smoldering at a long-term stable combustion is just higher than that, about 350°F/180°C. Actual flames coming off of the wood start at 500°F/260°C, which was used for searing foods, with consistent flames at 550°F/290°C.

In an attempt to entice wood stove cooks to convert over and spend the money on the gas or electric ovens, especially those with the new "broil" feature, marketing decided to use those standard cooking temperatures as the starting point for oven temperature. This is why most casseroles and other classic recipes have the oven preheated to 350, and your modern digital oven defaults to 350, with the broiler defaulting/maxing out at 550. It's all about the banked coals and open flame. And now you know more random carp.


