## Submission Guidelines for *The Pale*

**ARTICLES** on period topics, history, art, puzzles, SCA life, bardic stories and the like are welcome additions to *The Pale*. A 500- to 1000-word article will usually fit in one issue; longer articles will be split into multiple parts to appear in successive issues. Submit the file in MS Word .doc format along with an SCA Creative Release form. Send the images used in the article as separate files using the format described below.

You must cite all references, quotations and sources in your article using the Chicago Manual of Style format. Sample citations are located here: [www.chicagomanualofstyle.org/tools\\_citationguide.html](http://www.chicagomanualofstyle.org/tools_citationguide.html). Citing sources is very important to avoid accusations of plagiarism and legal action for copyright violation.

**IMAGES**, such as line art, calligraphy, illumination and photographs are also welcome. Scan any artwork at 300 dpi and save it at the highest quality JPG setting. Photos should also be 300 dpi, high quality JPGs. All images will appear in print as black and white, but the online version of *The Pale* is in color. Images can also be submitted as high quality TIF or PDF files. Any artwork or photography submitted to *The Pale* must have a signed SCA Creative Release or SCA Photographer Release form from the artist sent in with the work. Any person identifiable in an image must submit a signed SCA Model Release form with the art work. This is a requirement of SCA Inc. for print publication. All release forms are available at [www.midrealm.org/chronicler](http://www.midrealm.org/chronicler).

**EVENT PREVIEWS:** A free event preview of 50 words is available to all events. The listing **MUST include the name of the event, sponsoring group, site address, date, times and event steward contact information.**

**EVENT NOTICES** (ads) must be published in *The Pale* for events at which any of the following occur: crown and coronet tournaments, coronations and investitures, appointment of kingdom or principality officers, presentation of awards and titles, proclamation of law, establishment or advancement of branches. **These activities cannot take place unless a complete event notice appears in *The Pale*, the Middle Kingdom newsletter, at least once before the date of the event.** The publication requirement may only be waived in extraordinary circumstances, such as a natural disaster.

Events must **already** be listed on the Middle Kingdom Calendar prior to advertising in *The Pale*, but an event listing on the Middle Kingdom Calendar does **NOT** constitute "official publication". Incipient groups must submit a scan of the sponsorship form to the Editor. Event submissions to the Kingdom Calendar should be

submitted through the **online form** available on the calendar page. Contact the Middle Kingdom Calendar Secretary at [calendar@midrealm.org](mailto:calendar@midrealm.org) with any issues. Middle Kingdom events receive free event ads that run in the next issue unless otherwise specified. Out-of-Kingdom events and merchants pay the listed rates.

Ad templates for the quarter and half page ads are available at <http://midrealm.org/chronicler/thepale/>. All ads must be submitted to *The Pale* via e-mail attachment in DOC, PDF, JPG, or TIF format.

**WITHOUT EXCEPTION, EVENT NOTICES MUST INCLUDE event name, sponsoring group, dates, times, site address, site registration, website URL, NAME (SCA & modern), email address and phone number of the event steward.** Simple driving directions to the event site are useful but not required. All clip art images in event notices must have a source listed and be used in accordance with the terms of use. **All artwork MUST include an SCA Creative Release form from the author(s) or artist(s).** **SCA Model Releases are required for identifiable persons in any image.** Submissions are edited for grammar, spelling, space constraints, inflammatory or explicit language and compliance with Middle Kingdom Law. Editorial decisions are final. "Letters to the Editor" are not permitted per SCA Inc. regulations.

**PLEASE NOTE THAT MIDDLE KINGDOM EVENTS NO LONGER NEED TO PAY FOR ANY EVENT ADS AS OF OCTOBER 2016.**

# Letters From the Kingdom Officers



## Earl Marshal

Greetings,

Lots of announcements this month. The biggest announcement is that it is time for me to start looking for my successor. I will be accepting applications through April 14. Afterwards I will conduct interviews and present my selection to Curia for approval. I expect to have my successor selected in time for them to shadow me at Spring Crown and at this summer's Pennsic. Some of the duties of the office include overseeing all of the martial disciplines for the Kingdom, serving on Curia, running Crown Tournaments, and being on the Pennsic marshal staff (in 2025 it will be the Midrealm's turn to be Marshal in Charge of Pennsic). If you are interested send an email along with your resume to [marshal@midrealm.org](mailto:marshal@midrealm.org).

We are now allowing folks that are not authorized to start the Marshal-In-Training process and to become warranted marshals in armored combat (including siege and combat archery), rapier combat, and equestrian. Anyone wishing to take advantage of this opportunity needs to first talk with the Earl Marshal or the Deputy Earl Marshal for the activity. We'll have a conversation about the candidate's knowledge of armored combat and its culture. We have had several people go through the process and have been pleased with the results.

We have released a minor revision to the Armored Combat Handbook for the Midrealm. Over the past several years we have had many changes to the Armored Combat handbook. As such, we are requiring all warranted armored combat marshals to attend a marshal refresher course and to take an abbreviated version of the Armored Combat Marshal Exam. The class should take about an hour and the test will be online. We are requiring this to be complete by July 21, 2024 (the Sunday before the start of Pennsic).

We have also released a minor revision to the Rapier Combat Handbook.

With last month's new edition of the handbook, along with this minor revision, we are requiring all warranted rapier marshals to read a short summary of the changes and to take a short quiz on the material (10 questions including the questions about your name and email address). All rapier marshals need to complete the short quiz to remain a warranted marshal. The due date is May 1.

It has been a busy time for my office so far this year! I have had three officers changeover, with two more coming up soon!

I would like to express my thanks to the following deputies who have served their Kingdom and the populace.

- Master Alan FairFax has served as the Buckler Herald (heraldic education) deputy. He requested to step down last December. His successor is Noble Edward the Stranger. Noble Edward brings a fresh look at heraldic education to the office.

Also, I am seeking individuals who would be interested in the office of Meadows Herald (List herald deputy - arranging heralds to help at tournament lists -- Crown or local events).

I am also seeking a person to fill the office of Thuban Herald (Services the Deaf and Hard of Hearing). This deputy will work under the Dragon Herald, but will be supporting the DEI office as well. As such, individuals interested need to contact **BOTH** Dragon and DEI offices.

I also see that South Oaken Atheon Herald (Acanthus Pursuivant) is in need of a person to take that office. If you are in the South Oaken Region and are interested in this office, please let my office know with a letter of interest. This is primarily an administrative office, but the person who fills it will need to be a warranted herald, submit reports, and may be needed to step up in an emergency to fill in as Herald-in-Charge at an event; if no one else can be found to do so.

Heralds - Keep your voices hydrated, practice name pronunciation, and practice reading and creating blazons!  
Scribes - Keep up the awesome work! May your nibs flow clearly, your colors be brilliant, and your source material be voluminous.

## Don't Forget to Advertise Your Group Event!

You have decided to host an event for your local group. There are many things to do to get ready for the big day. Have you considered the advertising? Providing information in ways that are easy for potential guests to find is one way to help ensure that you have a successful and well-attended event. Additionally, if your group is hosting Royalty there are some basic requirements necessary to hold court.

Social media has become an important way that SCA information is transmitted to the populace. Often groups will designate someone to make a Facebook event. It is a good way to reach potential event guests. However, this approach limits the pool of people with information about your event to individuals on social media. There are plenty of people of all ages who have decided not to participate in Facebook or other platforms. A social media presence probably should not be required for active in person SCA participation. Additionally, the algorithm does not provide information in a way that is easily found. Often people will not see your posts or invites until well after the event page is created. Additionally, the search function for finding information on social media can be cumbersome, making details difficult to find or locate when referencing for travel or activity times. Social media is a wonderful supplemental way of advertising events, but probably should not be the main hub for attendees seeking event information.

It is written in SCA Society law (Corpora; Section II: Events) that any Kingdom-level court that includes official business must have a full announcement (ad) published in advance in the appropriate corporate publication. For the Middle Kingdom, this is our newsletter, The Pale. Official business includes Crown Tournaments, Coronations and Baronial Investitures, appointment of Kingdom officers, presentation of Kingdom or Society awards and titles, proclamation of laws, and the establishment or advancement of branches. In the Middle Kingdom, events are expected to be posted on the Kingdom Calendar and in The Pale to be fully and officially announced.

This process is initiated by first having the event listed on the Kingdom calendar and then submitting an event notice to The Pale. In order to have your event listed on the Kingdom calendar, have a member of the event staff or the group Seneschal fill out the form found at <https://midrealm.org/event-submission/>. The group Seneschal should then contact the Calendar Secretary, Sir Hengist Hawardessune, at [calendar@midrealm.org](mailto:calendar@midrealm.org). The Kingdom Calendar Secretary will review the event and publish after the confirmation is complete. Having events posted to the Kingdom calendar should be started as soon as possible. Some events are posted to the Kingdom calendar six months or more in advance of the event.

The next step is sending your event notice to The Pale Editor for publication. The best way to do this is by email. Lady Claricia de la Mere's official email is [thepale@midrealm.org](mailto:thepale@midrealm.org). Because of Corporate publishing deadlines, Pale ads have to be sent in by the 25<sup>th</sup> of the month, two months before they will be printed. For instance, if you would like your event ad to be in the October issue of The Pale, you would send your advertisement by August 25<sup>th</sup>. Don't forget, you can always send the ad in early. The Pale Editor will run your ad multiple times if there is space in the issues. More free exposure!

When sending your event notice into the editor, there is some required information. All event notices must have the event name, sponsoring group name, the date of the event, hours which the event will occur, a site address, the cost for site registration, the event website URL, and contact information for the event steward which includes their name (SCA & modern), email address, and phone number.

Some groups try to hold out until their website is complete. It is much better to send the Event Notice well before the deadline than it is to wait until the last minute to add all the details to the website, miss the deadline, and potentially have the populace miss out on receiving their awards. I'm happy to report that Pale event notices are FREE for all groups hosting events in the Middle Kingdom. Even if you are not hosting Royalty at your event. It can be a great idea to take advantage of the free advertising offered on the kingdom calendar and The Pale. While the process for submitting to the Kingdom calendar will be exactly the same for events with and without a Royal presence, the process of local events being published can be accomplished with an Event Notice or an Event Preview. Event previews are free in The Pale and available to all events in the Middle Kingdom. This listing is a less formal notice than the event notice and can be up to 50 words describing an event. The event preview listing must include the event name, the name of the sponsoring group, the event date, the site address, event times and the steward's contact information.

Similarly, it may be worthwhile to contact the Chroniclers in your area to ask them if they would publish your event notice in their area newsletter. Local newsletters are published anywhere from monthly to quarterly, so it may take some planning to have your event notice published in time. Most Chroniclers would be happy to have your event preview included in their publication as they are often looking for new content. Local Chroniclers can be found by checking the Barony, Canton or Shire's website, or through asking the Regional Chroniclers for contact information. Your Regional Chronicler's email can be found at <https://midrealm.org/chronicler/>.

The final, and very traditional way of advertising your event is to pass out flyers or make announcements of your upcoming event at another event in your region. This technique has been used since the Middle became a Kingdom. It can be a very impactful way to reach people who are not aware of the local and Kingdom publications or may have missed the announcements online. A member of your group can print out the event information and pass it out at the next event. Similarly, the Seneschal or event steward (or another designated person) could ask for permission to address the populace just preceding court or during the proceedings. It is important to note that this is best done with pre-planning and may not be available due to timing or other constraints.

Now that you have some ideas on how to advertise your event, utilize those that work best for your circumstances, scope of the event, and audience. It is better to have as much information available for attendees as you can as far in advance of the event as your local group can manage. More information about the event allows the populace to plan ahead and be ready to participate in all the activities that your local event has to offer. These are welcome and informative communications. Best wishes for a successful event.
