Also, to reiterate here the changes to NMR, I provide this missive from Carolyn Richardson, SCA Treasurer

"The increase of the NMR from \$5 to \$10 becomes effective on April 1. ANY event being held on or after April 1 is required to collect and remit \$10 per nonmember. This is true regardless of whether the event fees have already been announced. The Board delayed this increase to April so that this change could be put into event announcements in time for the April newsletters. The NMR does not impact event budgets – it is collected by the group and sent to the corporate office in the same amount. While we realize that some events that are happening in April or later might have already published their site fees, we expect the event to collect the correct amount at the door".

Queen's Prize is coming up soon! On April 6th talented artists and scientists gather in the Shire of Crystal Mynes (Joplin, MO area) to display their projects and get feedback. If you're not familiar with Queen's Prize, it's a showcase where the artists and scientists of Calontir, whom have not received a Grant of Arms level award in the Arts or Sciences, can display their projects to a panel of 3 people to get feedback as well as share their project with the populace. It's a fantastic time to geek out with like-minded people, see some really amazing projects,

and hopefully get inspired. The only requirements are that entrants cannot have a Calon Lily, Silver Hammer, or Laurel and they must have a sponsor who does have one of those 3 awards. The Sponsor is there to provide guidance to and assist the entrant throughout the process. Her Majesty will pick an entrant for the Queen's Prize, however, there are also Judges' Choice and Populace baskets. And all entrants will receive a gift from a Sponsor as well as tokens of appreciation that attendees will provide (candy, beads, charms, etc).

For those no longer able to participate in Queen's Prize, (GoA level and up) we have Kingdom Arts & Sciences later in the year which is open to everyone regardless of award level. The Kingdom needs bids for a group to host the event sometime between mid-July and the end of January 2025. The sooner bids are received the sooner it can be added to the Kingdom calendar.

I would like to thank Master Jurgen for his time as the Martial Studies Deputy. Since he is moving to a new position, the Kingdom needs a **new Martial Studies Deputy.** Please reach out to Master Jurgen at martialstudies@calontir.org with any questions.

In servizio, Gianna The Society for Creative Anachronism, Inc. (SCA, Inc.) is announcing an increase in membership fees and non-member registration fees for events.

This decision comes after careful consideration and extensive discussion among the Board of Directors, office staff, and Corporate officers. The effects of inflation across all sectors of operation, as well as other factors impacting the organization's operational costs, including insurance premiums, legal expenses, and general business expenses, necessitated a comprehensive review of membership rates.

Annual membership fees have not been adjusted in over a dozen years, and non-member registration fees have not increased in over 15 years.

In response to the evolving financial environment, the organization streamlined operations during the 2020 COVID-19 pandemic and significantly reduced corporate expenditures. The relocation of the office to San Jose, CA resulted in an annual savings of over \$35,000, and upgrades to software and CRM systems have netted a further savings of over \$100,000 annually. While membership numbers have rebounded post-pandemic, operational costs continue to rise.

SCA, Inc. Corporate is solely funded by membership fees, including the Non-Member Registration fee, and does not currently seek operational funds from its Kingdoms or subsidiary organizations, including those overseeing Pennsic and Gulf Wars.

At the January 2024 meeting of the Board of Directors, the Board approved the following changes, effective February 15, 2024:

Raise the Sustaining membership price from \$45 a year to \$55 a year (This represents an \$0.83 cents per-month increase over the previous monthly rate.)

Raise the Associate membership price from \$30 to \$40 a year. (This represents an \$0.83 cents per-month increase over the previous monthly rate.)

Raise the Family membership price from \$10 a year to \$15 a year, per person. (This represents an \$0.42 cents per-month increase over the previous monthly rate.)

No changes to Canadian or International memberships have been announced at this time.

Note: this change will take effect for all renewal transactions processed on or after February 15, 2024. Renewal transactions prior to that date will be processed at the previous rate, regardless of membership expiration date.

The Board also approved the following changes to Non-Member Registration fees, effective April 1, 2024:

Raise the Non-Member Registration Fee from \$5 to \$10 per event. As always, this only applies whenever there is an actual event fee charged.

Both Sustaining and International Membership allow subscriptions to printed publications, as well as the ability to add Family memberships.

It should be noted that these increases remain less than the cumulative U.S. inflation increase of 36.5% which has occurred since 2011. (Data calculated using the US Inflation Calculator).

SCA, Inc. emphasizes its commitment to transparency and sustaining a vibrant community. These fee adjustments aim to ensure the organization's fiscal health, support ambitious initiatives in 2024 and beyond, and keep the Knowne World thriving and dreaming for years to come.

Letters of Intent should be sent to Their Highnesses and copied to the Seneschal. Please see Their Highnesses letter for details.

When sending your letter I will need to see your proof of membership (and it needs to include your membership number and expiration date) as well as proof of address and date of birth. Please make sure that those documents are legible so that I can verify the necessary information. This includes being able to enlarge them. In the past some of the documents were too small to read and when enlarged were not legible. I ask for these documents to make sure that you meet the criteria in Calontir Law and Corpora/Society Policy, and are eligible to fight in Crown and, should you win, eligible to fill the position.

And speaking of filling a position - I am someone to step in and take the Seneschal position when my term is up in November. This job is important to the kingdom and can be very rewarding. If you are interested in learning more about how the kingdom's laws and Corpora/Society policy work together (and sometimes don't) this is a job that will help you do that. It's also a great opportunity to work with the Crown, other kingdom officers and groups in Calontir to help keep our community vital and thriving.

The successful candidate will serve as emergency deputy for a few months, to learn some of how the job is done and take the position in November 2024. Please consider taking this very important position. Letters of Intent are due March 23, 2024, and should be sent to Their Highnesses and the Kingdom Seneschal.

Calontir is in need of a **new Minister of Youth**. If you enjoy working with youth and want to help provide more opportunities for the youth to participate in the SCA this is a great way to do that.

I'm going to start this month's email with a fun link from one of my favorite Twitter/X feeds, the Cultural Tutor. Among their various posts on art, architecture, and the like, they had a great post involving heraldry. Specifically, how FC Barcelona got their crest. For the past year, I've had fun talking about heraldry in the SCA, but it's also great to see heraldry in the wide world.

Anyway, that's just a tidbit. Let's continue with some business. Johann Steinarsson wishes to step down from the Battleur position in April. It's hard to describe just how much he's made that position his own over the years. He's done a truly outstanding job as Battleur.

So that leaves some big shoes to fill. The Battleur is our tournament herald who's primary responsibility is to make sure there are heralds available for Crown Tournament. Also, the Battleur ensures these heralds have a good pronunciation guide and all the other skills needed to do the job. A secondary responsibility is to help all those interested in field heraldry have the opportunity to learn.

Also, it's time for Ava Alixandre de Bourges to step down from the Red Hawk position. Red Hawk is the herald responsible for commenting on other kingdom's submissions. Commentary is a requirement by the

Society Herald's Office for a kingdom to stay in good standing, so it's an important role.

While important, it doesn't require much experience. This makes the Red Hawk is a tremendous way to learn and hone book heraldry skills. Simply going through the process makes one much more capable of doing such jobs as the Eyas and Saker heralds. While Dyrfinna and Dorcas are both doing outstanding work in these roles, at some point we'll need to replace them too. Red Hawk is a great place to start.

Now for more fun stuff. This Mews comes out in February, so I can give you all a Valentine. Let's start with the name Valentine, which is easy enough to use in the SCA. It's been registered a number of times and it can be used in quite a few different European cultures.

This is because it comes from Latin "valens," which means strong, vigorous, or healthy. Given that His Grace Valens ruled often enough he and Susannah were named Protector and Defender of the Realm, it seems an apt definition. Since we're here, I'll just note it comes from a Proto-Indo-European root that means "to rule, to be strong."

Now let's turn to hearts. Guess what, you can also register them on your device. In fact, hundreds of people have done just that in the SCA.

The current heart symbol goes back to at least around 1320. You can clearly see them around the horse's neck in Francesco da Barberino's Documenti d'amore. Furthermore, the concept of using a physical item in art to represent love or handing over a heart goes back at least into the 13th century.

Not only is the heart symbol period, it's also really versatile. You can have hearts as the main charge. You can have things put on the heart. You can put hearts on other things. You can have them in a chief, on a pale, on a fess, on a border, on a canton, and on bends, both to sinister or to dexter.

You can have them as a semy in the field, meaning you have little hearts filling an entire area. This has been registered for the entire device or in divided areas. Then you can put other charges on top of this heart-covered field, so in effect you can have a heart-covered background for all the other things you want to do.

Hearts here, hearts there, hearts everywhere!

You can make them gules or any other color you want. You can counterchange them too.

Plus you can do things like having hearts carried by

beasts, or make a sun with a heart in the middle (the heraldic term is a heart irradiated), or make a bleeding heart with blood drops (these are called gouttes de sang in heraldry). You can make a winged heart or a flaming heart.

Simply put, one can never call heralds heartless.

And with that, I'd better go before you all say in your best Grimfells accent, "Bless your little heart."





Currently approximately 8000 people around the Knowne World actively participate in target archery, combat archery, siege weapons, thrown weapons and equestrian martial activities. While no ultimate decision has yet been made the Board believes that a proposal of a path to peerage for these individuals is worthy of deep consideration.

Having received advice from the Peerage Committee, Directors have discussed the matter and following some minor amendments to language which align the proposed draft of Corpora wording to the existing patent orders, the Board feels that the proposal has matured to the point where commentary on the proposed Corpora wording from members is requested. This commentary will assist the Board in forming further decisions relevant to its consideration of this matter.

The draft Corpora language approved for commentary is:

VIII.A.4:

- e. The Order of <Name>
- (i) Members of the Order of <Name> may choose to swear fealty but are not required to do so. The candidate must have attained the standard of excellence in skill and/or knowledge equal to that of their prospective peers in a pre-17th century martial pursuit as practiced in the SCA, including, and limited to, target archery, combat archery, thrown weapons, equestrian activities, and siege engineers. The candidate must have applied this skill and/or knowledge for the instruction of members and service to the kingdom to an extent above and beyond that normally expected of members of the Society.
- (ii) The duties of the members of the order are as follows:
- (a) To set an example of courtesy and chivalrous conduct on and off the field of honor.
- (b) To respect the Crown of the kingdom; to support and uphold the laws of the kingdom and Corpora.
- (c) If in fealty, to support and uphold the Crown of their kingdom.
- (d) To enrich the kingdom by sharing their knowledge and skills.
- (e) To enhance the renown and defend the honor of the peer's Lady or Lord.
- (f) To advise the Crown on the advancement of candidates for the Order of <Name>. (other sections re-numbered as needed)

Knowing exactly what the people who work, study, and play in the Society want a potential new peerage to achieve and do will be key to moving forward in this discussion. The Board welcomes any additional context that people feel may be of use to the discussion.

We are looking for your feedback – as you begin to type up your comments please feel free to include your thoughts on the following questions:

Does this language fill the gap I personally feel exists in the paths to peerage, why or why not?

What is my ideal vision of a new peerage and its members? What virtue will they embody?

The expertise of our community is invaluable, and these responses will contribute significantly to an outcome that positions our Society to meet its goals and future opportunities.

Flyers MUST contain these SIX ITEMS:

- Day month and year of the event
- Site open & close times for populace
- Name of the sponsoring group or groups
- Location of the event. The name of the event site, and full address.
- Name, both SCA and Modern, of the Event

- Steward, including contact phone and email. (Needed if there an emergency / or issues arise)
- Details of Registration : Do NOT use "FEE" as a describer for registration cost.

Event Copies: An Editable version of your flyer MUST be sent. PDFs ARE NOT ACCEPTED AND RETURNED FOR EDIT.

Deadline: The Chronicler must receive event copies no later than the **1**st **of the month TWO MONTHS PRIOR to your event**. (e.g. if the event is in November, the flyer must be received by September 1st.) If there is an issue with meeting the deadline, please contact the Chronicler ASAP. There is no grace period the deadline is final and non-negotiable. The earlier a flyer is received the better!
