

- Event Steward(s) name (SCA)
- Event Steward(s) e-mail
- Site Fee(s) including any applicable surcharges
- An attached copy of the SIGNED event form
- Consider including details such as directions to the site, merchant information, event activities, site restrictions, and ADA accessibility options.

Events which have not published all of the above information in the Kingdom newsletter are not eligible to have awards, law changes, or other Official Kingdom business conducted at them.

- All submissions must be received by midnight on the 1st of the PREVIOUS month (see the Calendar). The deadline does not change for Sundays or holidays. Late submissions may not make it into that month's issue.
- Articles may be reformatted for publication. Please use a single font; do not use tabs or create columns.
- Event Articles should be provided as an attached MS Word, .txt, or Open Office file.

From the Society Seneschal

Ranged Peerage Progress Update The Board of Directors is pleased to announce the anticipated timeline for the opening of the new Order.

This is an exciting time and we look forward to celebrating those who have achieved a standard of excellence in prowess for ranged martial pursuits.



Board Approved Timeline:

- At the April 2025 Quarterly Board Meeting: A vote by the Board, which is anticipated to be followed by announcement of the New Peerage Name, Arms, Regalia, and plan for opening the order.
- Beginning on 1 May 2025: Writs for the new order may be issued for 3 principals in each kingdom.
- Beginning on 7 June 2025: Elevations to the new Order may commence.

The Board approved the below addition to Corpora (June 5, 2024 meeting minutes) which states:

"Motion by Jennifer Krochmal to approve proposed changes to Corpora that will create a new peerage to include pre-17th century ranged martial pursuits, Order to be Named, and direct the Laurel Sovereign of Arms to submit such name and heraldry to the heraldic commentary process with the intention of opening the Order on a date to be determined. Second by Megan O'Shea. In favor: Pug Bainter, Krista Capps, Jennifer Krochmal, Megan O'Shea. Opposed: Gabrielle Fisher, K.T. Sheppard. Chair Mark Faulcon exercised his option to vote and did so in favor of the motion. Motion carried.

Proposed language as amended e. The Order of <Name>

- (i) Members of the Order of <Name> may choose to swear fealty but are not required to do so. The candidate must have attained the standard of excellence in skill and/or knowledge equal to that of their prospective peers in a pre-17th century ranged martial pursuits as practiced in the SCA. The candidate must have applied this skill and/or knowledge for the instruction of members and service to the kingdom to an extent above and beyond that normally expected of members of the Society.
- (ii) The duties of the members of the order are as follows:
 - (a) To set an example of courtesy and chivalrous conduct on and off the field of honor.
 - (b) To respect the Crown of the kingdom; to support and uphold the laws of the kingdom and Corpora.
 - (c) If in fealty, to support and uphold the Crown of their kingdom.
 - (d) To enrich the kingdom by sharing their knowledge and skills.
 - (e) To enhance the renown and defend the honor of the peer's Lady or Lord.
 - (f) To advise the Crown on the advancement of candidates for the Order of <Name>."

What this means:

Up to three writs for the Principals of the Order may be issued on 1 May 2025 and no more until those principals are elevated (starting on 7 June

The reason for this:

The three principal members of the new order will be the Order with whom the Crown must consult, per Corpora. In other words, once those three Principals are elevated, no other writs will be issued without proper consultation with the Order.


Those three Principals are the deliberative body that will, in consultation with the Crown and in compliance with Corpora, be the foundation by which all future inductees into the Order will be considered. They are the bedrock on which the Order will be built and should not be considered lightly.



Staying on Site

Early planning with on-site rv, room, and trailer accommodations is greatly encouraged. All on-site rv and room fees are paid directly to the Holy Trinity Monastery Center. The ability to camp on site, RV camp (free dry and paid hookups), or rent a room on site is available - but space and occupancy is limited! Staking is allowed. Discreetly wet. Above ground fire pits in designated areas are permitted (with fire extinguisher). Please be aware that this event occurs in the month of May, after minimal rain. There are fewer weeds, but there is more dust. There are also ants and gopher holes; these will try to be managed prior to the event, but they will still be a potential issue.

Camping on Site

- Camping is free, and only requires filling out the Pre-Registration form to indicate you are interested in camping so that we can make sure there is space to accommodate you.
- Camping will be an open land grab, with first come first served.--Please be aware that we MAY NOT be using the same camping area as we previously did.
- Staking is allowed and each tent and pavilion should have a fire extinguisher in a readily available area.

- Some trailers and cottages with multiple rooms are also available.
- Space is limited so contact them early for details and to make reservations.

RVs

- The site accommodates RVs with either full, partial, or dry hookups and accommodations.
- Space is limited.
- RV hookups are \$35 for full hookups and \$25 for partial hookups, payable to the site.
- Dry RV camping is free.
- ALL RVs are reserved with the Holy Trinity Monastery.

Rooms and Rental Trailers on Site: Most have single beds with AC and access to a restroom and shower.

Let all Princes, Lords, Barons, Knights, Squires, and all other members of the Great Kingdom of Atenveldt, who are not banished or enemies of the King our Lord or doers of evil deeds, know that on the 10th of May, the Incipient Shire of Vallis Aeris will hold our event the Tournament of the Copper Rose. Together with our fellow Baronies and Shires, we will enjoy time observing or participating in heavy fighting, rapier, cut and thrust, and Medieval Arts & Demonstrations on medieval pageantry. The principal focus of this event will be on pageantry, both on the field of honor and off the field. The participants in the contests will be judged on their heraldic display, pageantry, chivalry, and prowess.

Site Information:

We have a beautiful location at Thatcher Park, featuring trees, Ramadas, Stone Privies, a Water fountain, picnic tables with benches, and BBQ grills at each ramada. The site is dry. Pets are allowed on a hand-held leash, with owners responsible for picking up their waste. Above-ground fires are allowed in park-supplied fire pits. The nearest hospital is Mount Graham Regional Medical Center, 3.5 miles away from the park. There is a water fountain on site; however, we suggest bringing additional drinking water and chairs as well. Thatcher and Safford offer multiple accommodations, and there are several restaurants in the area. Additionally, there is a Walmart, Safeway, and Food City, all approximately 5 minutes away.



add: An additional number of events of Kingdom events as required to ensure that each barony host at least one Kingdom event, to include a Northern, Central and Southern Kingdom War practice, and any type of event is eligible- e.g. 12th night celebrations, Symposiums, prize tournaments, etc.

point 3: Strike paragraph A, as we cannot provide judging sheets 6 months in advance
