



From The Kingdom Carl Marshal

Hello from my estates of Hundehugel.

We will shortly be entering that Happiest of seasons - melees and war! I would like to discuss most common issues we face in melee and war – Engagement and Disengagement.

Here in Ealdormere, we tend to follow the conventions used at Pennsic, but we are not obliged to do so. For any melee event, if the conventions for engagement are different than Pennsic, I encourage them to be listed on the event website for everyone to read and be familiar with.

Here are the Pennsic Engagement Rules:

Rule: Before you may strike your opponent, you must make them aware of your presence and intent by gaining engagement.

KEM Note: This should be self evident.

Rule: Engagement happens when you have made eye contact with your opponent AND they have acknowledged you as a threat by reacting to you in some way (examples include, but are not limited to nodding at you, reacting defensively to you, going on guard against you, or blocking a light blow).

KEM Note: Notice the part that says <u>AND THEY HAVE ACKNOWLEDGED YOU AS A THREAT</u>. If you run up on someone yelling their name, and they look at you, they have NOT acknowledged you as a threat. For all they know, you are telling they have an armour failure, or they are about to walk into a bees nest. They might think a marshal is yelling at them. Generally, acknowledgement is them reacting defensively. Also note the part about 'a light blow'. Running up and clobbering someone in the head to gain engagement is not legal and the Marshallate with not be happy.

Rule: If an opponent seems to be ignoring your attempts to attract their attention you may NOT proceed to attack them. They may simply have felt they were bumped by their own team, not heard you, or already be engaged.

KEM Note: this does Not mean that you try for engagement by hitting them harder.

Rule: Deliberate refusal to engage an opponent is grounds for removal from the battle.

KEM Note: Refusing to engage is not an honourable tactic. Do not shame yourself, your Household, Barony, Knight or Kingdom by refusing engagement.

Rule: Deliberately striking from behind without gaining engagement is likewise grounds for removal.

KEM Note: Striking from behind is not an honourable tactic. Do not shame yourself, your Household, Barony, Knight or Kingdom by striking from behind without engagement.

Here is the Pennsic Disengagement Rule

Rule: A fighter is considered engaged until they have passed beyond the length of their opponent's weapons.

KEM Note: If you are standing next to a spear fighter and sword and shield fighter, you are engaged until you are outside the spear range.

If you have any questions on these rules, please let me know and I will be happy to talk some more about them.






