#### Event Scheduling and Announcements

Events must be scheduled on the Kingdom Calendar before the event announcement is sent. This can be done by filling in the calendar event date request form on the Kingdom web page: https://drachenwald.sca.org/events/calendar-add/ Announcements should then be written and can be updated directly to the web

Event announcements must include:

- Name of official SCA sponsoring group.
- The name (Society), and email address of the autocrat.
- Site street address (if no address, you must mention that in the announcement).
- Date of the event.
- Starting/stopping time of the event .
- Cost and Payment information (if there is a fee).

You are encouraged to include:

- Name and contact details of Marshal-in-Charge (if there is combat).
- · Reservation deadlines, if any.
- URL for the full announcement
- · Restrictions, if any (pets, open fires, alcohol) etc.
- · Information about what the event is about
- · Information about accommodation, meals etc.
- Other contacts (reservations, cook etc.)

#### Cudgel War 04 - 13 July 2025 Aarnimetsä - Finland

Cudgel War is the barony of Aarnimetsä's traditional summer camp with outdoor camping and some indoor spaces. Kavalahti scout camp site is near Inkoo in Southern Finland, only 60 km west of the capital Helsinki. Join us for 10 days (or fewer) of various activities like martial arts, arts and sciences, courts, and of course sauna, swimming, and the white northern nights. Some indoor accommodation and meals are available, but many visitors prefer camping on the meadow or the field.

#### Site

Björvikintie 109, 10230 Inkoo, Finland The event is mainly a tent camp, but there is also indoor accommodation in cabins and a dormitory. The site has drinkable running water and WCs in two outbuildings, but there are no facilities in the indoor accommodation buildings. The showers are in the sauna building by the beach. The medieval tents will be on the grassy area in the middle of the camp and on a nearby field. There are forest camping areas for mundane tents on the outskirts of the camping area.

The site is built on a hillside which can be challenging for people with reduced mobility. The disabled toilet is located behind the kitchen, about 200 meters from the indoor sleeping space, and the route includes a slope. The only way to get to the showers is to navigate the sauna stairs, and all the paths are gravel, not paved.

This year, anyone wishing to camp in the medieval camp in a group must choose a land agent among the group members. The land agent will be the contact person for your entire group in matters concerning camping, e.g. tent sizes, and the name of

your camp will be on the reservation form for you to choose. Those with one single tent that can be placed anywhere in the medieval area and those with mundane tents do not register as land agents. The site opens at 14:00 and closes at 12:00

#### Cost

Site and meal fees are based on the participant's age in the following manner:

Adults: 15 years and over Tweens and teens: 7-14-year-olds Kids: 3-6-year-olds Babies and toddlers under 3 attend for free

Everyone must pay a site fee. On top of that, you can choose to buy meals and indoor accommodation as long as available.

Site fee and other base fees Site fee, adult, per day: 13.00-9.00 EUR (the longer you stay, the lower the fee per day)

Site fee, tween and teen, per day: 11.00-7.00 EUR (the longer you stay, the lower the fee per day)

Site fee, kid, per day: 10.00-6.00 EUR (the longer you stay, the lower the fee per day)

Non-member surcharge, adults only, per event: 5.00 EUR

Indoor accommodation: 6.00 EUR/night (same price for everyone)

Day visit, no meals, no accommodations, members and non-members: 13.00 EUR pre-booked, 18.00 EUR without booking Late fee if Finnish resident and paying after June 15: 10.00 EUR

Transport fee Karjaa-Kavalahti or Kavalahti-Karjaa, only available for visitors from other countries with advance reservation: 10 EUR / one way / person

Those living in Finland must pay on June 15,2025 at the latest. After that, a late fee of 10 EUR will be added to the event payment.

Visitors from other euro countries and Sweden are strongly encouraged to pay their participation fees in advance, but all foreign visitors may pay at the door. A day visit without reservation (18.00 EUR) can be paid in cash at the event site, but an electronic transfer is preferable.

Cancellation policy

For a full refund, cancellation must be done on June 15, 2025 at the latest. Unfortunately, we cannot reimburse you for a later cancellation. If you have a reservation and neither cancel, pay nor come to the event, we will charge you all costs according to your reservation at regular prices, including a handling fee of 3 EUR.

# Curia decision

After consulting two Curias (on March 18th and April 5th 2025), Their Royal Majesties, King Æríkr II and Queen Jacquelyna II, have made the following changes to the Kingdom Law.

#### **Formatting**

In the law text below, changed or added text is marked with bold. Removed text is marked with strikethrough.

\*\* Changes made to sections 5.01, 5.02, and 5.06. Kingdom Chatelaine moved to Great Officers, according to Corpora \*\* 5.01 The Great Officers of the Kingdom of Drachenwald are as follows, in order of precedence:

Kingdom Seneschal

Kingdom Herald (Schwarzdrachen)

Kingdom Earl Marshal

Kingdom Minister of Arts and Sciences

Kingdom Chancellor of the Exchequer

Kingdom Chronicler

Kingdom Signet Clerk

Kingdom Web Minister

#### Kingdom Chatelaine

5.02 The Lesser Officers of the Kingdom of Drachenwald, and the Great Officers responsible for them, are as follows:

Kingdom Chatelaine - Seneschal

Kingdom Captain-General of Archers – Earl Marshal

Kingdom Marshal of Fence – Earl Marshal

Kingdom University Chancellor – Minister of Arts and Sciences

Kingdom Social Media Officer – Seneschal

#### 5.06.9 Chatelaine

5.06.9.1 Shall be a Lesser Officer, under the direction of the Seneschal.

5.06.9.2 5.06.9.1 Shall be the chief recruiting officer for the Kingdom, providing information to assist local groups in conducting effective recruiting, and mentoring regional and local chatelaines to manage and maintain growth. 5.06.9.3 5.06.9.2 Shall assist new members in learning the laws and customs of the Society and Drachenwald.

\*\* Changes made to section 6.01. Clarification of fealty presented by principalities \*\*

6.01.4 The Territorial Coronet hold their Principality in Fealty to the Crown. This fealty must be presented at Coronation. If unable to attend, the Territorial Coronet will provide fealty to the Crowns prior to the day scheduled for Coronation. They must present this fealty at Coronation in person. If they cannot attend the Coronation, they must send a letter or representative to Coronation to convey their intent to swear fealty at a future date.

\*\* Changes made to section 6.05. Responsibility for baronies within a principality is moved from Crown to Coronet \*\* 6.05.1.3 Request for the advancement to baronial status must be coordinated through the Crown and the Kingdom Seneschal (and Coronet, if the branch is within a Principality), as well as the Kingdom (and Principality) Seneschal.

6.05.2 The rulership of a Baronial fief shall be awarded by the Crown or Coronet upon petition by the members of the Barony in question.

6.05.3.1 The outgoing Baronial ruler(s) shall appoint a Vicar as a temporary replacement. If this does not occur within ten days of the Baronial ruler(s) departure, the Crown **or Coronet** will appoint a Vicar. The Vicar shall hold no baronial office.

6.05.3.2 Within ninety days of the naming of the Vicar, the membership shall be polled to determine the future of the branch; to remain as a Barony, to change to non-baronial branch status, or dissolve the branch. This polling will be conducted by the Vicar and the Baronial Officers under the supervision of the Kingdom or Principality Seneschal. The results of this polling are due to the Crown or Coronet within thirty days of the poll being taken.

6.05.3.2.1 If the Barony members wish to dissolve the branch or change to non-baronial status, the Baronial Seneschal will coordinate with the Kingdom or Principality Seneschal on the necessary communications with the Society Seneschal, or the Board of Directors through the Society Seneschal. The Vicar shall retire at the end of the transition period.

6.05.3.2.2 If the Barony members wish to remain a Barony, they must select Baronial ruler(s). The recommendation process must occur within one year from when the Vicar was named. At this time the group may send a petition to the Crown **or Coronet** naming its



candidates (either an individual or a couple). The Vicar retires once the proposed Baronial rulership is approved by the Crown **or Coronet**.

6.05.4 At any time the members of a Barony may petition the Crown **or Coronet** for the appointment of a Baronial ruler Baron/Baroness If a Barony has only a single Baronial ruler, the members of the Barony may petition the Crown **or Coronet** for the appointment of an additional Baronial ruler to rule with its current Baronial ruler.

6.05.5.1 If it is the finding of the arbitrators that the best solution to the difficulties is the removal or suspension of either or both Baronial rulers, the membership shall submit a petition to that effect, signed by at least two-thirds of the members, to the Crown or Coronet. The arbitrators will submit a report of their findings as specified in Drachenwald Law.

6.05.7 Baronial rulers hold their Baronies in Fealty to the Crown, or to the Coronet if the Barony is within a Principality. This fealty must be presented at Coronation. If unable to attend, one or both of the Baronial rulers will provide fealty to the Crowns prior to the day scheduled for Coronation. They must present this fealty at Coronation or Principality Investiture, as appropriate, in person. If they cannot attend the Coronation or Investiture, they must send a letter or representative to Coronation to convey their intent to swear fealty at a future date.

6.05.8 The length of a single term for a Baronial ruler is a maximum of two years. After consulting with the members of the Barony, the Crown **or Coronet** may, at their discretion, ask one or both of the Baronial rulers to serve another term. It is recommended that no Baronial ruler serve more than two consecutive terms.

6.05.10 Any person holding a Baronial fief in Drachenwald may participate in the Crown List and, if applicable, a Coronet List. They are required to submit the name of an acceptable candidate for Vicar with other documentation required for participation in the Crown or Coronet List. Should the Baronial rulers be victorious in the Crown or Coronet Tournament, the Vicar assumes responsibility for the Barony immediately. The Vicar must conduct a polling for the new Baronial rulers within 90 days.

\*\* Changes made to sections 2.02 and 5.06. New sections added in 5.06, 6.01, and 6.05. Clarification of the responsibility to get awards registered in the OP \*\*
2.02.6 It is the responsibility of the Crown to ensure that a list of all awards granted by them is received by the Schwarzdrachen Herald and the Kingdom Chronicler in a timely manner by the Kingdom Chronicler, the Schwarzdrachen Herald, and any relevant deputies appointed by Schwarzdrachen. The purpose is to ensure that the awards get published and registered in the Kingdom Order of Precedence in a timely manner, for the benefit of the populace and subsequent rulers.

5.06.2.3 Shall set up and maintain a Kingdom Order of Precedence and shall be responsible for having the Order of Precedence updated and presented to the Royal Heirs before their Coronation: with all awards given in all courts of Drachenwald, including the Kingdom's Principality and Baronial courts.

5.06.2.6 Shall appoint any assistants as deemed necessary.

6.01.5 It is the responsibility of the Coronet to ensure that a list of all awards granted by them is received in a timely manner by the Principality and Kingdom Chroniclers, the Schwarzdrachen Herald, and any relevant deputies appointed by Schwarzdrachen. The purpose is to ensure that the awards get published and registered in the Kingdom Order of Precedence in a timely manner, for the benefit of the populace and subsequent rulers.

6.05.6.1 It is the responsibility of the Baronial rulers to ensure that a list of all awards granted by them is received in a timely manner by the Baronial, Principality (if applicable), and Kingdom Chroniclers, the Schwarzdrachen Herald, and any relevant deputies appointed by Schwarzdrachen. The purpose is to ensure that the awards get published and registered in the Kingdom Order of Precedence in a timely manner, for the benefit of the populace and subsequent rulers.
