



PEOPLE ON THE MOVE - DEPUTY SOCIETY MARSHAL FOR RAPIER

The Society Marshal has appointed Caitrin McCullough (Magistra Lilias de Cheryngton, OD) as the new Deputy Society Marshal for Rapier, effective December 1, 2024. McCullough will oversee matters related to Rapier and Cut & Thrust, focusing on safety, advising Kingdom Marshals, and ensuring compliance with Society Handbooks. MEETING SUMMARY - SPECIAL CONFERENCE CALL DECEMBER 22, 2024

On December 22, 2024, the Society for Creative Anachronism Inc. (SCA) held a special Board of Directors conference call meeting. Key highlights included the approval of Kate Tingley's appeal against her suspension as Kingdom Seneschal of the Outlands, with the motion supported by several board members. Additionally, the Board directed the Society Seneschal to issue a letter of reprimand to Tingley and another reprimand to the Crown of the Outlands, Deric Kramer and Adrianne Sawyer. The Board emphasized the importance of collaboration among officers, Crowns, and Seneschals to ensure the populace's success and happiness. They encouraged all officers to reflect on a guiding principle stating that the primary duty of every officer, especially Crowns and Kingdom Seneschals, is to work together collaboratively for the well-being of the Society. FEEDBACK REQUEST - POLICY ON CONDUCT

The Board of Directors of SCA, Inc. is seeking feedback on a proposed "Policy on Conduct" aimed at enhancing transparency regarding sanctions within the organization. This initiative follows discussions with members who expressed a desire for clearer rules and guidelines surrounding conduct and sanctions. The policy aims to balance the need for privacy with the public's right to understand the reasons for sanctions while protecting individuals from retaliation. It consolidates existing rules concerning behavior at SCA events, emphasizing adherence to governing documents, respectful interactions, and the safety and well-being of all participants. The policy outlines expectations for behavior, reporting mechanisms for violations, and the responsibilities of participants, especially regarding minors and animals.
