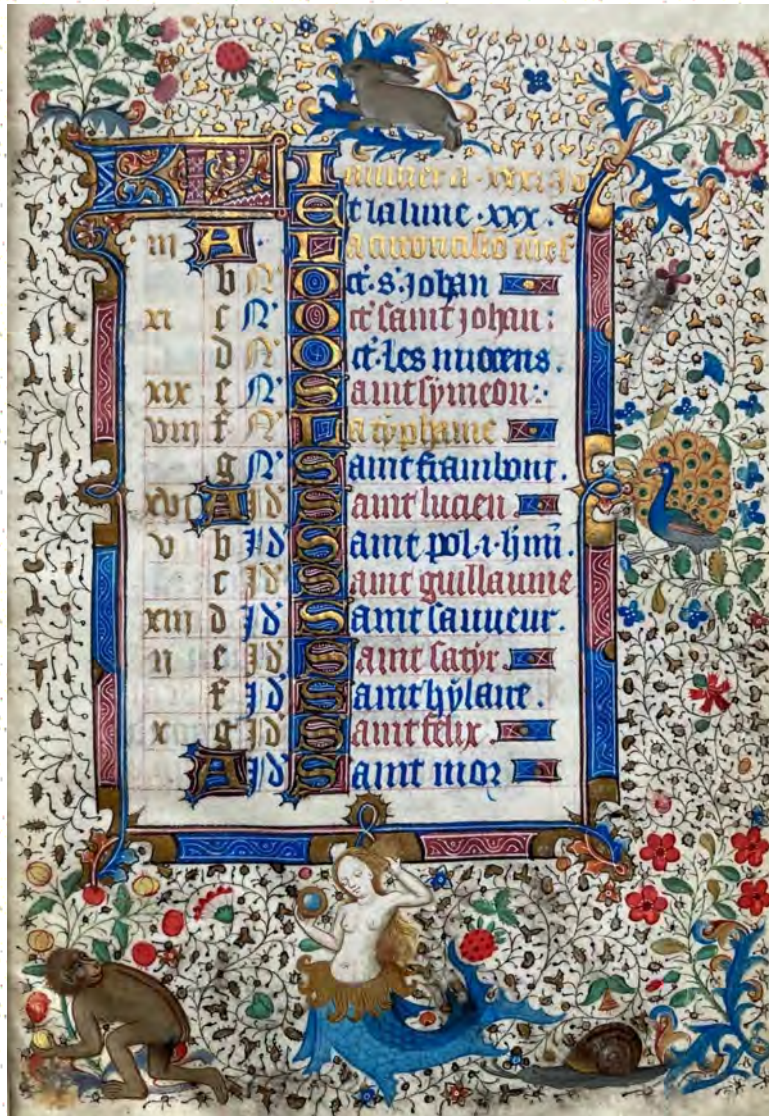

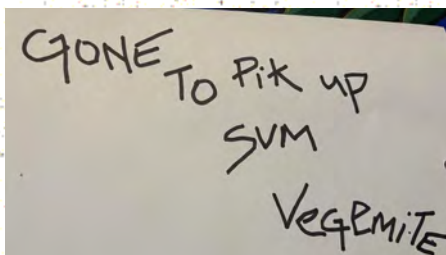

From Crux Australis

Greetings to all in Lochac,

Welcome to the December edition of the CAMEL

Unfortunately at the time of writing, there has not been a posting of the November Letter of Acceptances and Returns (LoAR), so I am unable to congratulate those who have had their names, devices and badges passed for registration. This will be addressed via the book of faces, once it has been received.



Thank you to all heralds who have been sending me their information to update the current Roster of Heraldry. It was last updated around 2020. According to the Lochac Heraldry policy (found on the home page of Crux Australis) **Rostered heralds who do not hold office** are requested to report biennially (the “biennial census”) on the 15th of May at the start of every odd year by completing the Roster Details Form. This had not been done for at least 3 years, so all need to report by the 15th May 2025. If you have already reported this year, that is accepted.

Ranking

All heralds are enjoined to remember that heraldic rank is an acknowledgment of knowledge gained and is not an Award. Those possessing them should always endeavour to ensure their skills are current – a ‘fossilised’ herald does neither themselves, nor their clients, any favours.

There are three personal heraldic ranks within the Lochac College of Heraldry, somewhat comparable to Apprentice, Journeyman, and Master:

1. **Macer:** This is the rank assigned a herald-in-training. A Macer has a demonstrated interest in SCA heraldry, and some level of activity within the College.
2. **Pursuivant:** A herald with general proficiency in at least two fields of endeavour.
3. **Herald:** A herald deemed highly capable in multiple fields of endeavour, with expertise in at least one.

Movement between these ranks is at the discretion of Crux Australis Principal Herald. An additional rank of **Herald Extraordinary** also exists. This rank is granted jointly by the Crown and Crux Australis for exceptional and/or lengthy heraldic service. It is recognised Society wide and conveys the right to register a personal heraldic title. Use of unregistered personal heraldic titles is strongly discouraged.

Heraldic rank (excepting Herald Extraordinary) is not necessarily transferable between Kingdoms of the Known World. Not all Kingdoms use personal heraldic ranks.

Promotion to Pursuivant is usually granted upon demonstrating satisfactory application of heraldic skills. A registered name and device, or active submission toward such, is also expected to be considered for promotion above Macer.

By courtesy, Crux Staff and Baronial heraldic officers are titled Herald for their tenure, regardless of personal rank. Shire, Canton, and College heralds are similarly titled Pursuivant.

I am slowly making my way through the list to ensure that those that should be recognized are.

This month there has been 3 promotions:

Gwen verch David and Rosalind Beaufort promoted to Herald and Rúnfríðr Keiliselgr gaining the rank of Pursuivant. Huzzah!

I hope all have had an enjoyable holiday season and look forward to continuing my service to Lochac until the end of my tenure in September 2025. (start thinking about whether you would like my job!)

Greetings Lochac!

As you may or may not have heard, the Hamlet of Radburne within the Shire of Dismal Fogs has been given the honour of hosting Autumn Crown (22 to 23 March 2025). The webpage is up and running and this is where information will be updated (https://radburne.lochac.sca.org/?page_id=399). Bookings will close on 1 March 2025 to allow our small team to prepare for this auspicious occasion.

Full pricing is available on the webpage along with the booking form (as well as the refund policy). There is a price rise on the 15 January 2025 so get in early! The feast will be capped at 100 and the event capped at 150 due to site limitation. A wait list will be started if we reach the cap.

There is lots of great information on the website including some suggestions on 'what to bring'. The site is approximately 15km west of Dubbo in Central West NSW, Australia. It is home of Radburne War and the Steward's family. We held November Crown Tourney here in 2011 and there have been a few changes since then.

The predicted weather for March 2025 in Dubbo is an average of 30 to 35 degrees celsius - yes, it can be hot. Invocation Court will comment at 9:30am on the Saturday, followed by Crown Tourney. The site will open on Friday to allow for set up, camping etc and an informal get together. A pizza run can be organised (additional cost) for those wishing to partake.

Saturday includes Crown Tourney, A&S Competition, games, Chivalry and Pelican meetings, Equestrian and Feast.

Sunday's activities include Market, Equestrian Tourney, Roses Tournament (Heavy and Rapier), MoD and Laurel meetings. There is the option to stay on site the extra night and travel home on the Monday. For those wanting to include something extra in their stay, there is also the world famous Taronga Western Plains Zoo in Dubbo.

The event is being held in a paddock (no, not the rolling green sort found in Europe), the one found in rural Australia. There are plenty of trees, dirt and Australian scrub. The menu is being finalised and may be varied closer to the date depending on bookings, food requirements and any variations in what ingredients are available (and cost effective) locally. It is super important that any allergies etc are noted at time of booking to ensure we provide appropriate food to attendees.

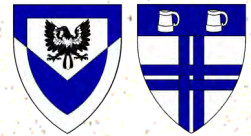
