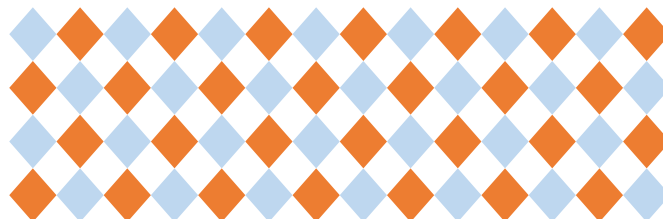

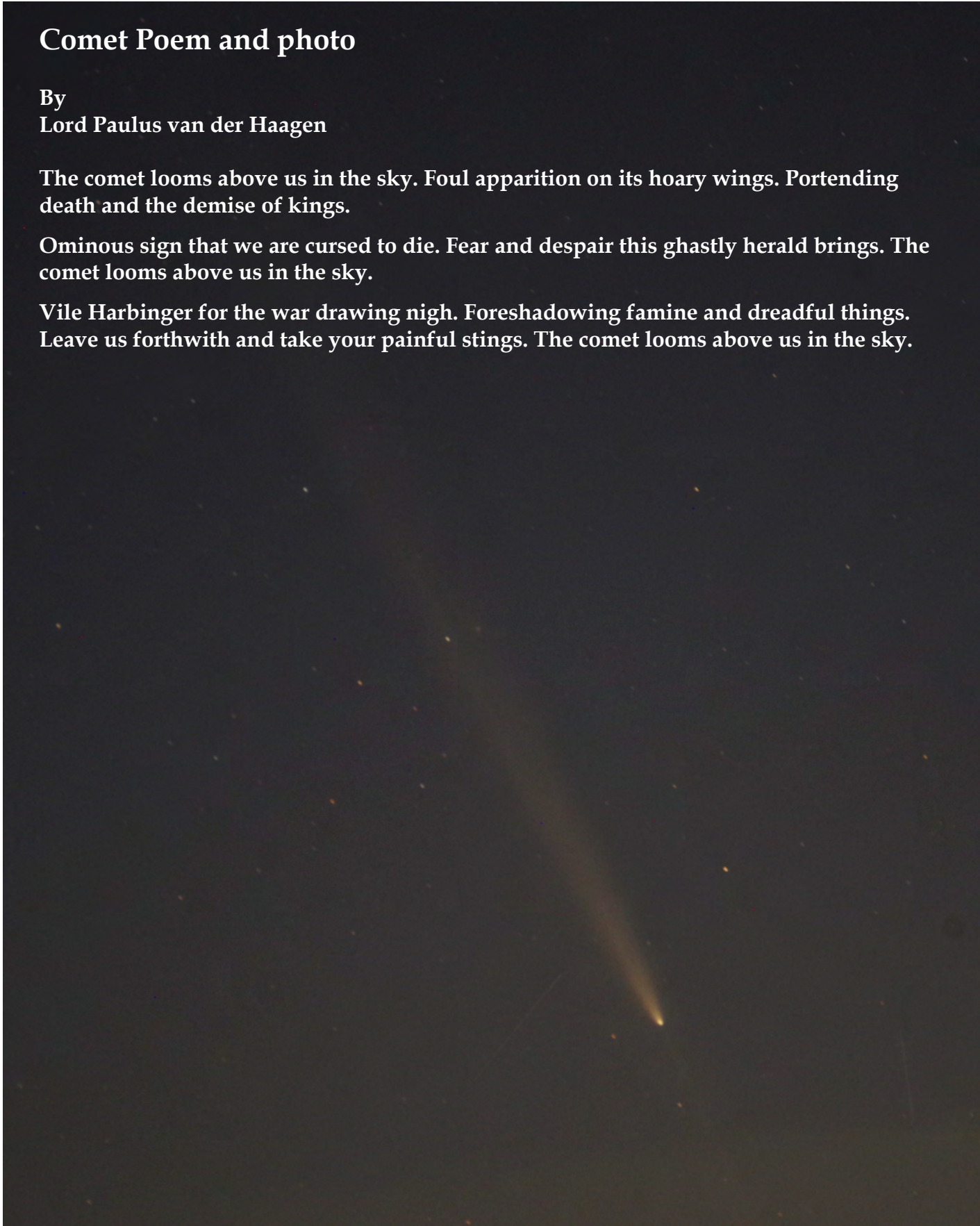
Comet Poem and photo

We are all familiar with the best selling books of our age. Some books have remained popular for years (blessed is shai-hulud). One of the most popular books of the mid-late 15th century was “The Tale of Two Lovers,” written in 1444 but published (yay printing press!) en masse beginning in 1467 in Cologne. It is an erotic novel written as a series of letters between two lovers: Euryalus and Lucretia. The story is so popular that there are a large variety of extant illuminations showing an exchange of letters between the two.

Why was there no sequel or follow up book? Because the author, Aeneas Sylvius Piccolomini, who grew up in Siena and went to university in the 1420s in Siena and Florence, had a more ambitious calling besides authoring love stories. He was selected as Pope of the Catholic church in September 1458, becoming Pius II. As pope, he wrote many other (more church appropriate) books, becoming one of the most prominent authors of the time. So you can seek out some of the fine writing of the 15th century, either by Pope Pius II, or something of a different ilk, by Aeneas Sylvius Piccolomini. And now you know more random carp.
