Greetings!

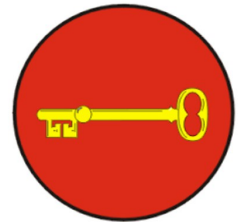

Kingdom Law Changes Announcement

Greetings!

The following changes to Kingdom Law are proposed by Their Majesties Sven and Iseabail, to take effect upon the Coronation of Their Heirs, Valentine and Brocc. As required in The Boke of Caidan Law (v.19), below are proposed changes to Kingdom Law for review and commentary from members of the populace.

Moving Dates for Crown Tournament

With the rescheduling of Great Western War to November, we are moving:

- Spring Crown Tournament from on or about the first weekend of March, to on or about the first weekend of April, and
- Fall Crown Tournament from on or about the first weekend of September, to on or about the first weekend of October.

Revised text (III.A):

“There shall be two Crown Tournaments and two Coronation Ceremonies per year. A Crown Tournament shall be held on or about the first weekend of April with Coronation on or about the second weekend in July, and on or about the first weekend in October with the Coronation on or about the second weekend in January. These four official events shall be held within the boundaries of Caid. The exact dates and locations of these events shall be made known to the populace in the official Kingdom newsletter and may not be changed without just cause.”

Net Impact: The term of serving as Royal Heirs changes from four months to three months. Changes to the Kingdom Calendar will be made for the events currently on those dates.

Bring Existing Ranged Martial Activities Related Awards into Alignment with Upcoming Peerage

In preparation of the new ranged martial activities peerage, the existing Armigerous and Grant-level awards are being restructured. The Order of the Chiron and The Order of the Argent Arrow are being expanded to include all current forms of ranged martial activities. In addition, the Order of the Arcus is being closed. Finally, it is the custom in Caid that only the terminal level order for an activity or skill be granted the right of consultation with the Crown. With the new peerage, the Order of the Chiron will no longer be a terminal order for ranged martial activities. As such, the right of consultation is being removed.

Revised text (VIII.E.2.d):

“The Order of Chiron shall be awarded for outstanding ability in SCA-style archery, combat archery, mounted archery, thrown weapons, or siege weaponry.”

Revised text (VIII.F.2.d):

“The Order of the Argent Arrow shall be awarded for superior skill and appearance in SCA-style archery, combat archery, mounted archery, thrown weapons, or siege weaponry.”

Added text (VIII.I.1.e.)

“The Order of the Arcus was an Armigerous Level award for superior skill in combat archery and siege Weaponry.”

Rescinded text (VIII.F.2.g)

“The Order of the Arcus shall be awarded for superior skill in combat archery and siege Weaponry.”

Rescinded text (IX.C.1.b)

“The Order of the Chiron of Caid:

1. Membership shall be granted by the Crown of Caid in accordance with the Statutes of the Order of the Chiron.
2. The Order shall create and maintain the Statutes of the Order of the Chiron which address the structure, conduct

of business, and are subject to Kingdom Law.”

Net Impact: These changes prepare the kingdom for the establishment of the new ranged martial activities peerage by redefining and expanding the scope of the existing Armigerous and Grant level awards. Although the Arcus is being closed and no new members will be added, current members of the Order will retain all associated honorifics.

Address Gap in Process for Naming a Regent

Upon the publication of the current version of Kingdom Law, it was noticed there was a gap in the process for naming a Regent in the instance of an abdication and the stepping down Crown does not nominate a candidate.

Revised text (III.E.2)

“If both the Sovereign and Consort abdicate, a Regent acceptable to the Great Officers of State shall be appointed by the abdicating Royals to perform those duties of the Crown, which cannot be delayed without prejudice to the Kingdom. If the Sovereign and Consort fail to present a Regent for review, the most recent and available Sovereign and Consort will be empowered to nominate a Regent that is acceptable to a majority of the Great Officers of State.”

Net Impact: Clarify existing process.

Clarify Language for Determining Baronial Successors

Rephrased run-on sentence

Revised text (V.B.1.a)

The Crown shall invest a member of the Baronage only after brief SCA resumes from all candidates have been provided and reviewed by the Crown, Kingdom Seneschal, and current Baronage. Additionally, a confidential electronic and/or mailing poll of the current SCA paid members of the populace must be conducted, with no serious or significant opposition revealed, and a notice must be placed in the baronial newsletter.

Net Impact: Clarify existing process

Codify Royal Peerages and Order of the Rose

In Caid, we have the custom of awarding Royal Peerages after the end of a successful reign, along with elevating the Royal Consort to the Order of the Rose. These additions and changes codify this custom.

New text (VIII.D.5.)

“A Royal Peerage, to those who have successfully completed a reign as Sovereign and Consort of the Kingdom of Caid.”

Revised text (VIII.H.1.a)

“The Order of the Rose, to any person receiving a Patent of Arms as a Royal Peer who shall have served a full reign as Consort of the Kingdom or Principality of Caid without removal by the Board of Directors. By custom, the privileges of membership in the Order are also extended, while they are in Caid, to those who served as Royal Consort in any other Kingdom or Principality.”

Net Impact: Codify existing customs.

These changes will be posted in the December Crown Prints, to be followed by a 30-day commentary period starting upon publication.

Group projects are welcomed for display but are not eligible for the Calafian Arts Champion. Some tokens of appreciation will be available for purchase, but everyone is encouraged to bring small tokens of appreciation for artisans and performers. There will be a Bardic competition, and performances are currently being organized.

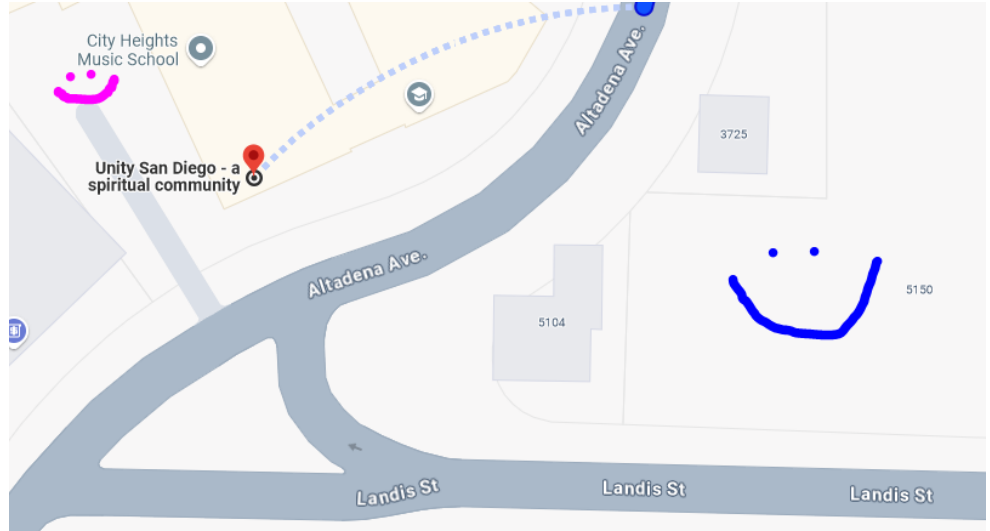
