1. The date for Crown Tournament 53 will be Sat October 25 in Ottawa. Deadline for submission is Tuesday October 14, 2025.

There are no additional requirements than Kingdom minimums.

*See III-400, III-500, III-601, III-604, III- 605, and III-700 of Kingdom Law

2. Tourney Format:

Round Robin if < 8 combatants, Double-Elimination Standard Tree >7 To decide Finals.

Finals = Best 2 out of 3 sets of 3 with matching first 2 sets and if a deciding set; bring your best form against your opponent's.

We hope we have a strong and honourable showing in the lists and are confident we will have heirs that will make us, and more importantly, our Kingdom very, VERY proud!

We hope everyone continues to have an exciting and safe summer and look forward to gathering again with our families, chosen families and dear friends!

From The Kingdom Seneschal

I am looking forward to the upcoming camping events happening in our Kingdom. Take a look in our calendar to see which ones are of interest to you. If you are looking for specific events that are not on the calendar, ask around, that event might not be running this year. Perhaps you are looking for the date of a Kingdom level event and don't see it in the calendar yet!! That is likely because we are in need of someone to autocrat it. Consider being an autocrat, the area that is assigned the Kingdom level event does not necessarily mean it needs to happen in that area. Privy Council are accepting bids for **Kingdom A&S**, **Fall Coronation and Fall Crown**.

Their Highnesses have published their requirements for entry into their Crown Tournament in this newsletter. Please review those requirements carefully, as well as the relevant laws included below. Crown Tournament documentation must be submitted electronically (pdf preferred) to both the Kingdom Seneschal as well as their Highnesses. You will need to include a copy of your authorization card, the membership cards of both the entrant and the consort, a completed Crown Declaration form (as found in the library on the kingdom website), proof of residency for both the combatant and the consort, as well as all requirements set out by their Highnesses. Those documents are required to be submitted complete and on time.

Crown Tournament submissions will be accepted until 11:59 PM EDT on Tuesday October 14, 2025. That deadline is firm, 12:01 AM is too late. Save yourself the stress and get your submissions in early.

Please review the current laws of Ealdormere as they apply to Crown Tournaments and ensure you follow them in your applications.

III-400 All prospective combatants and consorts must be paid members of the SCA and mustmaintain that membership through to the end of Their reign. Proof of membership must accompany the request to participate in the Crown Tournament.

III-500 All prospective combatants and consorts in the Crown Tournament must meet the following requirements:

III-501 They must be subjects of Ealdormere as

defined by Corpora and must remain subjects of the Kingdom through to the end of Their reign.

III-502 They must be at least 18 years old.

III-503 They must have been subjects of Ealdormere and have demonstrated a clear level of involvement in the Kingdom over the year prior to the Crown Tournament

III-504 They must be armigerous.

III-505 All prospective combatants must be authorized to fight as an armored combatant in the Kingdom of Ealdormere and must present proof of authorization when submitting their letter of intent.

III-600 Any person who does not meet the requirements of Section III-503 or 504 may make an application to the Heirs under the "Rule of 12" as outlined below:

The Prospective combatant and consort shall submit a request to participate in the Crown Tournament pursuant to Section III-200. Their request must be accompanied by a letter addressing why they seek dispensation from Section III-503 or III-504. This letter must bear the signatures of 12 subjects of Ealdormere, all of whom are armigerous. By signing the dispensation request, the signatories vouch for the worthiness of the candidates. Due weight will be given to this request.

Note: This dispensation request must accompany the request to participate in the Crown Tournament and is not a method of recourse after a combatant or consort has been disallowed from the Crown Tournament.

III-700 Neither the Sovereign or the Consort of Ealdormere, nor any person who has served as

Sovereign or Consort of Ealdormere within three months prior to the Crown Tournament, may participate as a combatant or consort in that Crown Tournament.

III-800 No prospective combatant may have more than one declared consort. No prospective consort may be fought for by more than one combatant.

"he injured his back"

"Walk it off"

"It's just a flesh wound"

"Rub some dirt in it"

We have all heard these things before. The SCA has a problem with people who keep fighting when injured. That has to stop.

There is a difference between hurting from a good blow and being injured. If you are 'just' hurting, no problem – have at it, fight to your hearts' content.

If you are injured, if you have damage, fighting is, at best, going to hurt, and at worst, make the damage worse.

So why do so many people keep fighting when they are injured, me included? Well, I did it because I was stupid. I didn't want to admit that I was injured because it felt in some way like I had failed.

Other people who are not stupid and are not Peers feel that they have to keep fighting or the Peers will forget about them, or they will 'lose their place in the peerage line'. Social pressure is a big reason some people keep fighting.

The final reason is some fighters look at fighting while injured as proof of how tough they are.

Lets talk about these reasons.

Please don't be stupid. During your very first authorization one of the things that the marshals looked for was that you were not a danger to yourself. Be as smart as authorization-you, and don't be a danger to now-you.

For people who are afraid the Peers will forget about you, or you'll lose you place in the peerage line, I can assure you that couple of weeks or a month, or longer off the field is not going to make us forget you. We have memories longer than a goldfish. While injured go to practice and teach and train others. There are never enough trainers at practice so you will be filling a necessary roll and showing your dedication to your craft.

Social pressure is intended to be encouragement. We have all had hard shot and have not been injured. 99.99% of the time we might hurt, but we are not injured. Only you can judge you body. Only you know when you are injured. So when someone says, "see you at practice tonight?", they are looking to encourage you, not force you to fight when injured.

Fighting when you are injured to prove you are tough seems to be self defeating. You are not going to be doing your best and no one but you can judge the pain so you are not proving anything.

Trust yourself, trust that you know what you need.


SCM 60th Memorial Display


