Submit the file in MS Word .doc format along with an SCA Creative Release form. Send the images used in the article as separate files using the format described below.

You must cite all references, quotations and sources in your article using the Chicago Manual of Style format. Sample citations are located here: www.chicagomanualofstyle.org/tools_citationguide. html. Citing sources is very important to avoid accusations of plagiarism and legal action for copyright violation.

IMAGES, such as line art, calligraphy, illumination and photographs are also welcome. Scan any artwork at 300 dpi and save it at the highest quality JPG setting. Photos should also be 300 dpi, high quality JPGs. All images will appear in print as black and white, but the online version of *The Pale* is in color. Images can also be submitted as high quality TIF or PDF files. Any artwork or photography submitted to *The Pale* must have a signed SCA Creative Release or SCA Photographer Release form from the artist sent in with the work. Any person identifiable in an image must submit a signed SCA Model Release form with the art work. This is a requirement of SCA Inc. for print publication. All release forms are available at www.midrealm.org/chronicler.

EVENT PREVIEWS: A free event preview of 50 words is available to all events. The listing **MUST include the name of the event**, **sponsoring group**, **site address**, **date**, **times and event steward contact information**.

EVENT NOTICES (ads) must be published in *The Pale* for events at which any of the following occur: Crown and Coronet tournaments, coronations and investitures, appointment of Kingdom or Principality officers, presentation of awards and titles, proclamation of law, establishment or advancement of branches. **These activities cannot take place unless a complete event notice appears in** *The Pale*, the Middle Kingdom newsletter, at least once before the date of the event. The publication requirement may only be waived in extraordinary circumstances, such as a natural disaster.

Events must **already** be listed on the Middle Kingdom Calendar prior to advertising in *The Pale*, but an event listing on the Middle Kingdom Calendar does **NOT** constitute "official publication". Incipient groups must submit a scan of the sponsorship form to the Editor. Event submissions to the Kingdom Calendar should be submitted through the **online form** available on the calendar page. Contact the Middle Kingdom Calendar Secretary at calendar@ midrealm.org with any issues. Middle Kingdom events receive free event ads that run in the next issue unless otherwise specified. Out-of-Kingdom events and merchants pay the listed rates.

Ad templates for the quarter and half page ads are available at **http://midrealm.org/chronicler/thepale**/. All ads must be submitted to *The Pale* via e-mail attachment in DOC, PDF, JPG, or TIF format.

WITHOUT EXCEPTION, EVENT NOTICES MUST INCLUDE event name, sponsoring group, dates, times, site address, site registration, website URL, name (SCA & modern) of the event steward, and a contact email address of the event steward. Simple driving directions to the event site are useful but not required. All clip art images in event notices must have a source listed and be used in accordance with the terms of use. All artwork MUST include an SCA Creative Release form from the author(s) or artist(s). SCA Model Releases are required for identifiable persons in any image. Submissions are edited for grammar, spelling, space constraints, inflammatory or explicit language and compliance with Middle Kingdom Law. Editorial decisions are final. "Letters to the Editor" are not permitted per SCA Inc. regulations.

Greetings,

Coming shortly, you will see a new layout for the activity report form in the event packet. There's going to be a new box for the Minister of the List to initial after checking a participant's/marshal's card. You read that correctly - even marshals wanting to help need to show their cards. We are having a lot of paperwork being incorrectly filled out lately and we're trying to remedy some of the confusion. The only thing the marshal should be signing off on is AFTER they have completed the inspection of the participant, whichever discipline that pertains to. Everything else should be filled out by the MoL- simply because the participant should be showing them their authorization card (which also has your marshal warrants documented) to provide proof they are authorized to participate in that respective activity. Should an issue arise that needs to be addressed, we need to know who to actually talk to. It is an unfortunate reality, but there has to be accountability.

Also a reminder: MiTs signing off on authorizations MUST still have a warranted marshal to sign with them in addition to the second authorizing marshal. (If an MiT is obtaining signatures, there would be a total of 3 signees - the MiT and the 2 authorizing marshals.) If we receive an authorization form with an MiT signature and only 1 other authorizing marshal, that authorization is invalid and WILL need to be redone correctly. We are checking; please don't make us do any more work than we have to.

Greetings to the Midrealm,

I wanted to take a moment of your time to talk about the Youth Rapier program and provide some education for marshals who work with the youth of our Kingdom. Youth programs don't run on their own power; it takes volunteers to provide the resources to hold youth combat at events and practices. If you have youth who participate in youth rapier, it is your responsibility to know the current rules that rule the program.

Marshals and list table volunteers: A few reminders to what is required from you.

MOL (management of List) person it is your responsibility to check the authorization cards of all of the adults working with youth - the Adult sparring auth and the Youth rapier marshal auth. Youth auths can be checked if they don't have their auth cards by texting me at (309-360-2233, Laura Crowell). The marshal sign-in page should be signed by the marshal but the MOL should check the auth card and then initial next to each marshal that their cards were checked. Marshals, your authorization card should be shown to the MOL and the photo/copy should be less than 1 year old, have a current background check expiration date on it, and list you as a youth rapier marshal.

Next, when conducting an authorization of either a youth or an adult for youth sparring, it requires 2 youth rapier marshal's signatures (you can add in MITs but 2 marshals must be included). An authorizing partner's name needs to be recorded (if youth, you may leave out their name but mark it as a youth participant). If your second background person is not a marshal, have them sign in with their name, contact phone number/email, and background expiration date. Lastly, paperwork from practices are to be emails to both the clerk of the roster and the DEMYR monthly. If an event has youth rapier, be it a stand alone activity or a part of the Adult program, paperwork still needs to be submitted within 2 weeks of the event. Local group youth rapier marshals should be reporting quarterly. Youth specific paperwork can be found on the youth rapier webpage as well. Continued on page 7.

Midrealm Groups may now use the SCA Online Registration and Event System (SCORES) as an alternative to Paypal for their event preregistration. Fee structure is comparable to Paypal. The event registration form is available from the Kingdom Exchequer. SCORES requests must be submitted far enough in advance that it may be processed. Form is sent to Kingdom, who approves and then submits to Society. It will be available online for 30 days.

Greetings, Midrealm!

Target archery marshals: as target archery has restarted around the Kingdom, there are some items that I need to bring your attention to.

The target archery marshallate has been asked to determine the number of unique participants that we have over the course of the year. The regional marshals and I have decided to attempt this by correlating names on the uber event reports from events and practices. This means that those reports need to be sent on in a timely fashion. Reports from events are expected within a week of the end of the event. Reports from practices can be grouped by month. Ask people to write their name legibly.

The Society Target Archery Marshal has made a couple rulings that are in effect now and will be incorporated into the Society Target Archery Handbook. The first is on overdraw devices. These are devices, such as the Majra, that allow you to shoot an arrow that is too short to reach from your draw point to the bow. They are typically used for distance shooting. The Society marshal's ruling is, "Overdraw devices are not called out as a banned item in Society Handbook. However, arrow length is something all marshals check in inspections and short arrows will fail by default. Which means their use (short arrows and overdraw) will need at least marshal-in-charge sign off on a per archer and per event basis. So, possible to use? Yes, but many hoops to jump through and it will come down to the personal choice of the MiC. Individual Kingdom rules may be in place that do ban these devices."

The Midrealm doesn't have any specific rules on these, so we would treat them as experimental weapons. That means that you need to contact a regional or the Kingdom marshal if someone shows up with one of these. If it is permitted, it needs to be thoroughly documented in the event report.

The other ruling is about break-cocking crossbows. Here is the Society marshal's ruling:

"The question was on the Society rule about break cocking crossbows (Section V - crossbows, Rule B): Break-cocking crossbow styles are not allowed. Does it only apply to the Barnett crossbow that used the term break cocking action, or does it apply to the Barnett crossbow that used the term break cocking action, or does it apply to any crossbow where a built-in mechanism on the crossbow brings string and trigger into position? The understanding I've had for years is that it's a ban on any crossbow with a built-in mechanism.

- Cranequin not built in, allowed
- Goats foot lever not built in, allowed
- Belt hook allowed
- Handheld hook allowed
- Barnett with built in lever action No
- Hooks built into hand-pulled sliders along stock -No
- Table slides to string, lever or ratchet back No

The term in the handbook may be specific to a certain brand, but the application is broader. I can work on an update to clear this up if needed.

There are a couple of reasons for this. The repeating crossbow falls under this ban. It grabs the string and brings it back to firing position and loads a bolt. But you can't see when a bolt loads, or runs out, or jams. Dry fires are possible. And do we want a rapid-fire crossbow in speed rounds? Fun for sure, but this rule is what prevents their use.

For ratcheting mechanism bows, how do you make it safe when a hold is called?

A Barnett or other hand-operated built-in lever can be let down, hopefully safely. But a ratchet that is halfway back can't be let down and period examples didn't engage trigger until all the way back. You are stuck in a half-loaded situation until it is safe to finish cocking the bow."

Kingdom Chronicler

The Kingdom Chronicler is a 2-year term. All kingdom positions are unpaid volunteer positions and require internet connectivity and technological knowhow (google forms, sheets, docs, email). The preferred deadline for application is May 11th, 2025, but the position will be open until filled. Please contact the Kingdom Chronicler by email or webform to express interest or ask any questions you may have about the position. Please include a brief description of your relevant experience.

Kingdom Chronicler: The Midrealm kingdom chronicler has several different roles within the SCA. They report to the Society Chronicler, serve as a Great Officer in the Curia, provide oversight and advocacy for the Midrealm *Pale* Editor, the Webteam, the Calendar Secretary and the Kingdom regional and local Chroniclers.

The full duties and responsibilities of the Kingdom Chronicler, as outlined by the Society for Creative Anachronism, can be found in the SCA Chronicler Policies. These policies have been published as a handbook that can be accessed at https://www.sca.org/chronicler/

As a member of Curia the Kingdom Chronicler advises the Kingdom Seneschal and The Crown. This advisement is done through attending regularly scheduled meetings. The Kingdom Chronicler informs the Crown regarding ongoing projects within the Chronicler's office, advocates for the volunteers within the staff of *The Pale*, the Web Team and the local and regional Chronicler's offices. The Kingdom Chronicler also helps the Crown and Great Officers of Curia with their work as it interfaces with the Web Team, *The Pale* and the Chroniclers of the Middle Kingdom. The Kingdom Chronicler will also serve on subcommittees as needed and review kingdom policy or event bids.

In Society Law, the Kingdom Chronicler is ultimately responsible for the Kingdom Newsletter. In the Middle Kingdom we have a deputy that publishes the newsletter known as *The Pale* Editor. The Kingdom Chronicler submits monthly officer letters to *The Pale* Editor for inclusion in the newsletter and helps review the issue each month. The letters have the purpose of informing the populace of the Middle Kingdom regarding important news from the Chronicler's office, *The Pale* or the Web Team. Additionally, the Kingdom Chronicler is responsible for oversight of *The Pale*, advocating for the editor, assisting with staffing of the kingdom newsletter including choosing the editor.

The Kingdom Chronicler functions as an intermediary, providing both advocacy and representation for the Web Team with The Crown and Curia. The Kingdom Chronicler also assists with division making for the web team, staffing the Webminister, and dissemination of information from the Web Team to the populace as needed.

The Kingdom Chronicler, with the assistance of the Deputy Kingdom Chronicler oversees the operations of the Office of the Chronicler by appointing and managing the Regional Chroniclers of the Middle Kingdom. The Kingdom Chronicler and Deputy are responsible for reviewing the quarterly reports of the Regional Chroniclers and following up with them regarding any listed concerns or in providing recognition to people that deserve accolades. The Kingdom Chronicler is also available throughout the year to assist the Deputy Chronicler in answering any questions that the Regional Chronicler or Local Chroniclers may have. The Kingdom Chronicler, with assistance from the Deputy, also makes nominations for the annual Master William Blackfox Awards. This award was created in memory of Master Blackfox to recognize excellence in the work of Chroniclers and newsletter contributors. The Calendar Secretary is the newest deputy of the Kingdom Chronicler It is the job of the Kingdom Chronicler to represent the Calendar Secretary to The Crown and in Curia. The Kingdom Chronicler also assists the Calendar Secretary with any needs they have in executing the duties of their office.
