Temporary Removal from Participation precludes the individual from attendance or participation in any manner at any SCA activity, event, practice, or official gathering for any reason, at any time.



Proposed Law Change – Fall 2025

The following change to Kingdom Law are proposed and commentary is sought. Please direct any comments to crown@artemisia.sca.org and seneschal@artemisia.sca.org

Entrance to Kingdom Champion tourneys must be residents of of the kingdom and must be acceptable to Their Majesties

Proposed Change (in red):

VII.2: The Champions of Artemisia shall be: King's Champion of Artemisia, Queen's Champion of Artemisia, Champion of the Arts and Sciences, Sable Rose (Rapier) Champion of Artemisia, Equestrian Champion of Artemisia, Archery Champion of Artemisia, Thrown Weapons Champion of Artemisia, Youth Champion of Artemisia, and the Bard of Artemisia. These Champions may be chosen either by tournament or by simple designation by the Crown.

All who enter into a tournament for Champion or serve by designation as Champion must be acceptable to the Crown and to have resided within the Kingdom of Artemisia for twelve (12) months, and to have been active in the SCA for the twelve (12) months preceding the tournament/designation. They must remain residents of the Kingdom of Artemisia throughout their tenure as Champion.
