otherwise the event is declared unofficial

(i.e., registrations may not be collected, awards cannot be given, etc.):

- Group Refund Policy• Spell out your group's refund policy
- •Date of event• Day, month, and Gregorian year that the event will take place.
- •Group name• Name of the group hosting the event. Must be an official group.
- •Location and directions• Name and directions to the legal address of the site.
- Event Steward Event Steward's Society name, a contact phone number with area code, and email address. **Mundane name and address are no longer required**.
- Registration Member & non-Member for event, with deadlines (for pre-registration) as necessary. If there is a Registration for the event, the following statement must be included beneath the \$ amounts: "Make checks payable to SCA, Inc./(group name)." If the event is free, say so!
- Activities Brief synopsis of event—fighting, arts & sciences, merchants, et cetera.
- Site Restrictions—wet or dry, no animals, no smoking, et cetera,
- Accessibility—handicap parking & entrance/exit ramps, uneven terrain, et cetera
- <u>Duration</u>• Start and stop time of the event.



Throughout the policy, any mention of "reserved for future use" has been removed.

3.11 Thrown Weapons

- 3.11.4 Plumbata Specifications
 - 3.11.4.1 Minimum distance to target is 30'.
 - 3.11.4.2 Overhand, underhand, or dart style throwing is allowed. Pivoting the underhand throw by the very end of the plumbata is not allowed, i.e.. Holding the plumbata with the fingertips and letting it swing freely.
 - 3.11.4.3 Hard or Soft, horizontal, or vertical targets are acceptable.
- 3.11.5 Sling Specifications
 - 3.11.5.1 Minimum distance to the target is 20'
 - 3.11.5.2 No horizontal rotation of the sling is allowed, i.e., helicopter style. Underhand or overhand rotation is allowed if it is close to vertical.
 - 3.11.5.3 Range changes are required for slings. Increase the distance behind the furthest throwing line to 20 feet. Increase the distance between the targets and the sideline to 15 feet.
- 3.11.6 Accessibility
 - 3.11.6.1 A Marshal may adjust the above rules individually to meet participants' physical and/or mental challenges. Safety cannot be compromised, and no other participant can be on the field.
- 3.12 Rapier Combat
- 3.12.1.1.6 Rapier Spear (a single authorization valid for Rapier and Cut & Thrust)
- 3.12.2 Rapier Combat Weapons and Armor Standards
 - 3.12.2.3 In addition to the Society requirements, all Rapier and Cut & Thrust blade tips must include adequate protection against punch-through of the blade. This may include:
 - A metal disc (such as a washer) placed between the end of the blade and the tip.
 - A nut or other blunt metal object welded to the end of the blade in compliance with the SCA "Fencing Marshals' Handbook".
 - A properly sized Darkwood Rapier tip installed following manufacturer's installation instructions meets this requirement.
 - Any approach specifically approved by the DEM for Rapier.
 - Manufacturer spatulated tips do not require additional punch-through protection
 - 3.12.2.4 Rapier spears shall be no shorter than 4 feet. In addition, spears should be constructed such that the maximum amount of haft is inserted into the head while leaving at least 4" of rubber unencumbered from the haft.
- 3.12.5 Rapier Combat Archery
 - 3.12.5.2.3 Minimum distance to fire is 10 feet from archer to combatant.
