Laurel is the principal heraldic officer of the Society and the head of the College of Arms, and is responsible for fostering the study and practice of heraldry, supervising the processing of submissions, and overseeing the heraldic activities of the Known World.

Laurel is an unpaid position, currently requiring approximately 20 hours a week. The position requires considerable tact and patience, armory and onomastic knowledge, supervisory ability, the ability to work within tight deadlines and coordinate closely with Wreath, Pelican, and other staff to produce a Laurel Letter of Acceptance and Return monthly, computer literacy and word processing skills, reliable e-mail and telephone access, and time and ability to travel.

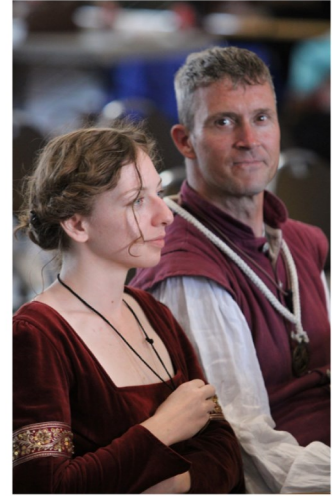

Random Carp

A look at modern practices and their medieval sources

Vaccinium membranaceum, or the mountain huckleberry is one of the more popular flavors in the Kingdom. Those who have not experienced the berries in their natural form, they are a lot like less sweet blueberries, but the flavor is on steroids. They are also impossible to cultivate, with attempts resulting in plants without fruit. As such, every huckleberry picked is a wild huckleberry. People would rather give up their first born instead of their huckleberry patch. Research into how to cultivate them (is it the soil? The environment? The fauna around them?) includes those researching ancient Roman agriculture.

This is because the all amazing *silphium*, from which the Romans used the resin as a cure-all and the seeds as a contraceptive, was also resistant to being cultivated. The small town of Cyrene (three hours northeast of Benghazi, Libya along the coast) greatly benefited from having the climate where *silphium* grew best. Alas, demand outstripped supply, and with no place it could be cultivated, the plant was extinct by the 1st century. With the loss of the plant, Cyrene quickly fell from status in the Empire. Many texts from the era talk about attempts to grow *silphium* elsewhere to no avail. So enjoy your huckleberries (I know I love going to our huckleberry patch... it's over that way somewhere), and understand the importance of wild plants through history. And now you know more random carp.

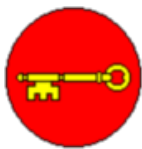
