I've also been a local group officer who spent years in the office without ever knowing if my report was received or read, except that one time I got a phone call that it hadn't been received. I apologize every time I failed to respond to a seneschal report or question.

To every local group officer that takes time from their busy life to send a report to their kingdom office - THANK YOU! Your work really is appreciated, even if your kingdom officers don't always remember to say so.

I saved the best for last, and am working on this right up to the last minute. This will be my final issue as Chronicler for the Kingdom of Calontir, by the time this issue goes to press, most likely, I will have stepped down at Toys for Tots and Lord Randal Logan of Knightbridge will be stepping into my position. Please, show him the same kindness and courtesy that you have shown me.

You will see some drastic changes to the layout for this last issue of 2024. These are a result of requests for more time for a flyer to run in the Mews, for event pages to be created on FaceBook, more time for Pre-Registration to take place, for people to plan better on what events they can attend, and when are they happening and where. Will those requests come changes. For more flyers / event information to run, the information submitted needs to be trimmed — drastically. Going forward all event "flyers" will be at maximum 1/4 page, text only.

The information required is: Event Name, Group hosting, Date, Time that Site opens and closes, Event Registration Fees, Name both SCA and Mundane of the Event Steward along with a contact email for them AND a phone number. All of this information is non-negotiable and is require both by Corpora and Calontir.

But what about the work that we put into the flyer? The art work, the extra "fluff" bits??? Where will that go? Do not worry, the event flyers that you send will be added to the Kingdom Calendar on the Kingdom website, or they might even be incorporated into the event information, it just depends on time and other things. Also, all of that


information can be added to the event page that our KSMO, Mielikkä will create for you once the Mews is published by Society, and not before! Also, websites, all of this information can also go on to the event website.

Another reason for the change is that I have had a number of flyers recently that had either incorrect dates, an address that was not correct, pricing information was not correct, or event staff was listed that we later find out are not staff. It takes time for me to request the new information from the event steward or group seneschal for them to edit the flyer, get it to me and for me to update the page. Now, with the required information and it being in an editable format, the Chronicler is not waiting for anyone to get back to them, they can change the information and also have the Mews to Publications on time.

I know not everyone will be pleased with these changed, but give it time, we are trying to make it so we can get as much information out to everyone in a timely manner. And who knows, maybe with this change we will see more events showing up in the Kingdom.







FLYER GUIDELINES

For Their Majesties to hold Court, & for official business to happen, a complete flyer must be published in *The Mews*. Failure to do so means that the Crown can not hold Court at that event. Prior to emailing a flyer confirm your event with the Reeve. *The Mews* **WILL NOT** publish an announcement if your event has not been approved or confirmed. Check the Kingdom Calendar at: <u>https://www.calontir.org/events/</u> For information on how to submit a flyer please visit: <u>https://www.calontir.org/chronicler/</u>

Flyers MUST contain these SIX ITEMS:

- Day month and year of the event
- Site open & close times for populace
- Name of the sponsoring group or groups
- Location of the event. The name of the event site, and full address.
- Name, both SCA and Modern, of the Event

Steward, including contact phone and email. (Needed for emergencies or issues arise)

 Details of Registration : Do NOT use "FEE" as a describer for registration cost.

Adult Event Registration: \$25 / Adult Member Discount Registration: \$20 / Youth (6-17) \$5 / Children 5 & Under: FREE

Event Copies: An Editable version of your flyer MUST be sent. PDFs ARE NOT ACCEPTED AND RETURNED FOR EDIT.

Deadline: The Chronicler must receive event copies no later than the 1st of the month THREE MONTHS PRIOR to your event. (e.g. if the event is in November, the flyer must be received by August 1st for the September Mews) If there is an issue with meeting the deadline, please contact the Chronicler ASAP. There is no grace period the deadline is final and non-negotiable. The earlier a flyer is received the better!
