Event Scheduling and Announcements

Events must be scheduled on the Kingdom Calendar before the event announcement is sent. This can be done by filling in the calendar event date request form on the Kingdom web page: <https://drachenwald.sca.org/events/calendar-add/>. Announcements should then be written and can be updated directly to the web form.

Event announcements must include:

- Name of official SCA sponsoring group.
- The name (Society), and email address of the autocrat.
- Site street address (if no address, you must mention that in the announcement).
- Date of the event.
- Starting/stopping time of the event.
- Cost and Payment information (if there is a fee).

You are encouraged to include:

- Name and contact details of Marshal-in-Charge (if there is combat).
- Reservation deadlines, if any.
- URL for the full announcement
- Restrictions, if any (pets, open fires, alcohol) etc.
- Information about what the event is about
- Information about accommodation, meals etc.
- Other contacts (reservations, cook etc.)

Greetings from the Seneschal

Greetings and salutations, good gentles of Drachenwald!

Topic for the month: thoughts on "regions"... When I became Tova's deputy, her primary task for me was to clarify what "Central region" really meant, which led to the general question of what is a "region".

In general, the SCA does not recognize "regions" as an official administrative entity, the closest analogue would be a principality or perhaps province. It is also completely normal for baronies and shires to report directly to kingdom officers, without an intermediary administrative level.

Nor is the concept of "regions" defined in Kingdom Law, the only 'official' reference to it (that I have found) is associated with the rotation scheme for Kingdom events. Beyond that, "regions" are simply a term of convenience to refer to subsets of the Kingdom.

It's also somewhat a misnomer to refer to someone as a "regional" officer, considering "regions" are not administrative entities and therefore would not have officers. Technically they are a deputy kingdom officer given responsibility by the kingdom officer for a specific geographical area.

Thus my conclusions:

- (1) "Regions" are not branches of the SCA nor an administrative entity in their own right.
- (2) There is no need for a "region" to have the roster of officers one would expect of a branch of the SCA.
- (3) The existence of an office with responsibility for a "region" is at the discretion of a kingdom officer who wants a deputy to help manage/coordinate things in a particular geographic area.

With respect to Central specifically: from what I've seen, there is insufficient interest or activity for Central to move in the direction of principality any time soon. Nor do I feel that I need a deputy to be an intermediary for the local branches in that area, so I am eliminating the "Deputy Kingdom Seneschal for Central Region" office.

To be clear: I'm not discouraging the use of such terms; I just wanted to clarify what they mean. If anyone has further thoughts on this, please feel free to reach out!

Ahtela is a typical youth camping centre in the sense that activities will take place in different buildings and therefore one will have to do some walking outdoors to get to places, regardless of the weather. We recommend that all guests bring good outdoor shoes that are suitable for walking in Finnish winter weather. The roads between the buildings are sand/gravel and very well lit even during the night time. Maintenance of the roads is taken care of by a hired care keeper. There's some trekking up/downhill, but the slopes are not very steep. We do try to limit on-site driving as much as possible during the event. But if one cannot walk the distance, it is possible to drive by car almost door-to-door between accommodation and feast hall. Most buildings are not handicapped accessible.

There is the main hall building that will have space for 120 for the feast. Courts will also be held in the main hall. There is a smaller hall for 40 persons that will be used for classes. In the additional hall there is a large industrial style kitchen that can be used for cooking classes. These two halls have no accommodation spaces.

University classes will be held in the main hall and the small hall but accommodation buildings also have spaces that will be used for University classes. There are at least 7 areas that can hold classes simultaneously. These areas are not uniform in size which will have to be taken into consideration when submitting classes for the University. Some areas are large enough to hold 2 classes simultaneously. As the class spaces are 5-10 minute walk apart from each other this will be taken into account when

planning the University schedule to allow convenient time for changing classrooms.

There are 8 accommodation buildings spread over the site. These have beds for 6-30 people each. All beds have pillows and blankets. All guests must bring bed linens and use them even if they are using a sleeping bag. There is also some crash space on the floor in some buildings. Crash space is a single mattress sized spot on the floor. If you have been assigned crash space you will need to bring your own mattress, pillow and blanket.

All buildings are modern and in good condition.

Corpora Amendment Commentary Request – Inclusion of DEIB and Chatelaine as Greater Officers AUGUST 6, 2025 | SCA COMMUNICATIONS

The Board of SCA Inc. is seeking feedback on the proposed amendment to Corpora regarding the inclusion of the Diversity, Equity, Inclusion and Belonging (DEIB) Officer and Chatelaine as Greater Officers.

Purpose: To bring Corpora VII.A.2 into alignment with Corpora VI (sections I and J), following the Board's April 2024 decision to create the Society Offices of Chatelaine and DEIB.

Background: At the April 2024 Quarterly Board Meeting, the Board approved the establishment of two new Society-level offices: Chatelaine and Diversity, Equity, Inclusion, and Belonging (DEIB). Kingdoms were subsequently instructed to begin amending their laws to incorporate DEIB as a Kingdom Great Officer (Reference: April 14, 2024 Quarterly Meeting Minutes). The relevant approved additions to **Corpora VI. Society Officers** are:

I. Chatelaine - The Chatelaine is responsible for promoting and supporting recruitment initiatives and guiding retention practices.

J. Diversity, Equity, Inclusion, and Belonging Officer (DEIB) - The Society DEIB Officer is responsible for overseeing the development, implementation, and maintenance of game-facing DEIB initiatives and education.

K. Reservations to the Board - The Board reserves the right to appoint and remove Society Officers. (*Renumbered following additions above. See April 14, 2024 Quarterly Meeting Minutes*).

Following this, kingdoms were directed to recognize the DEIB role as a kingdom Great office. However, as there was not a Society DEIB counterpart, a variance was granted by the Board during the December 16, 2024 Conference Call to allow kingdom DEIB reporting through kingdom Seneschals until a Society-level DEIB Officer was seated (Reference: Agenda Item II.F – Blanket Variance Request – KDEIB & Reporting – 12/16/2024).

As some kingdoms did establish DEIB as Great Offices, Chatelaine was not largely due to the absence of corresponding Society-level officers at the time. With the recent appointment of a Society Chatelaine, and the prior establishment of the reporting protocol for kingdom DEIB through the Seneschalate, the lack of consistency now highlights a gap in Corpora language.

Corpora (Corpora VII.A.2) currently states:

“Kingdom Great Officers are responsible directly to the Crown, but also report to a corresponding Society officer if such a Society officer exists. Each Kingdom's Great Officer corps must include the Seneschal, the Principal Herald, the Earl Marshal, the Minister of Arts and Sciences, the Chancellor of the Exchequer, and the Chronicler.” (emphasis added)

With the establishment of the Society Chatelaine and DEIB offices, Kingdom counterparts are now required to report to these Society officers, consistent with other Great Offices. To reflect this, Corpora VII.A.2 should be updated accordingly.

Suggested amendment to Corpora VII. A. 2 (additions in bold, deletions in parentheses):

“Kingdom Great Officers are responsible directly to the Crown, but also report to a corresponding Society officer if such a Society officer exists. Each Kingdom's Great Officer corps must include the Seneschal, the Principal Herald, the Earl Marshal, the Minister of Arts and Sciences, the Chancellor of the Exchequer, (and) the Chronicler, **the Chatelaine, and the DEIB Officer**. No person may hold more than one of these Great Offices at a time. The Crown may create additional Great Offices.”

This amendment aligns Corpora VII with recent updates to Corpora VI, ensures consistency across Kingdoms, and provides clear guidance on the reporting structure for all Great Officers—including the newly established Society offices of Chatelaine and DEIB.
