Letters of Intent for Spring Crown ASLX

Spring Crown Tournament approaches! On the 6th of September in the Barony of Stormhold, We will hold a tournament to decide Our heirs. We invite all who would take on the challenge of serving Lochac as Crown to submit Letters of Intent to crown@lochac.sca.org by midnight on **Friday the 29th of August**. Your letter of intent should include the full SCA name of the combatant and the consort. Please also provide email addresses for both entrants.

The format of the Spring Crown tournament will be Round Robin, or Single Kill Triple Elimination if the number of entrants on the field and the constraints of time make Round Robin impracticable.

We would enthusiastically encourage entrants of any level of experience and renown to consider entering the List. Serving Lochac as Crown is a great joy as well as a great responsibility, but it is not just the winner who serves Our Kingdom. Every single participant in a Crown Tournament does Lochac proud, not only by contributing to the valour of the victor, but also by showing that the joy of arms and the spirit of chivalry is alive and well in these lands.

Should you be considering entering, you will need to fulfil the basic requirements of office, which you can find on page 6 of the Lochac Laws for Eligibility for the Crown Tournament, here: <https://seneschal.lochac.sca.org/files/2024/09/LochacLaws-September-2024.pdf>

Additionally to these requirements, since generosity of spirit and the ability to communicate are great assets for a Crown, We also ask that all entrants – both members of each pair – have engaged in teaching in some fashion during Our reign. This could mean running a formal class, but it could equally mean showing someone how to sew a hem, cook a pie, or throw a snap. Facilitating the sharing of knowledge in a round table or another format would also qualify! We would ask you to simply make a note of when, where, and who was involved, and that you might include these details on your Letter of Intent.

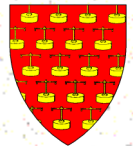

From Crux Australis

Greetings to all.

The May Letter of Acceptances and returns was published after the last Pegasus and the June has not yet come out. The registrations from May as follows:

* **Alyxandra Finch.** Name and device.

Vert, on a chevron argent two finches respectant gules and overall a sheaf of arrows Or.

Nice English name for 1577!

Nice cant!

* **Frosti af Ulfahol.** Device.

Azure, a rabbit salient and in chief three escarbuncles argent.

* **Gaspar de la Rou.** Name and device.

Per pale vert and gules, a bear sejant erect and on a chief argent three ermine spots sable.

Nice early 15th century French name!

* **Khulan Ghoea.** Name and device.

Or papellony purpure.

Submitted as Ghoea Khulan, the name was not correctly formed. Ursula Serpent, in her article "Middle Mongol Grammar for SCA Names"

(<https://heraldry.sca.org/names/mongolgrammar.html>) has documented that certain descriptive bynames follow the given name rather than precede it. The byname Ghoea, a variant spelling of Qo'a, is one such name. Thus we have changed this name to Khulan Ghoea for registration. Nice device!

* **Little of Saint Christina.** Name and device.

Azure, on a bezant a crow sable, a bordure Or.

Submitted as Little of Saint Christina, the name was changed at kingdom to Little of Saint Christina the Astonishing based on the Branch Name Allowance. Alys Ogress was able to construct Saint Christina as an English placename, therefore we have restored the name to the submitted form for registration.

* **Zoltán Kázmér.** Name

(see RETURNS for device and badge).

This is a Hungarian name, with Zoltán as the given name and Kázmér as the byname. Prior precedent [08/2013 CL] states that as it is unclear in many cases whether an Hungarian name has been Latinized or not, a Hungarian name may be

written either as byname first or given name first. Thus while this name is registerable as submitted, its orthography marks it clearly as a Hungarian name, so the name should have the byname first. If the submitter is interested in the authentic Hungarian form of Kázmér Zoltán, they may submit a request for reconsideration.

Returns:

* **Zoltán Kázmér.** Device.

Azure semy of keys wards to base argent, a sprig of rue Or issuant from a trimount argent. This device is returned for conflict with the device of Sifrid von Eichelborn,

* **Zoltán Kázmér.** Badge.

Azure, a sprig of rue Or.

This badge is returned for conflict with the badge of Geraint ap Llewelyn, Azure, an oak sprig bendwise fructed Or.

From Laurel: Orders of Precedence, Living People, and Dead Names

In many kingdoms the Order of Precedence traditionally lists all names by which a person has been known through their career in the Society. In most cases this is good, as it makes it easier to find information. However, there are instances:

- for example, where someone is undergoing gender transition or is the target of some types of violence.

- where one can feel it necessary to ask for their old names to be removed from the Order of Precedence altogether. In such cases, keeping this history publicly available can pose real risks to the person in question. We urge kingdoms to handle these name removal requests promptly and with sensitivity.

If you want to enter, but can't bring your item to the event, you have a couple of options:

- ~ You could send it on the day, with your trusted friend. This friend will need to deliver the entry and remember to collect it again after judging.
- ~ Or you can have your entry judged locally, before the event, so that we can take your results into account when the rest of the competition is judged.

If you do wish to enter remotely, please discuss this with your local A&S officer as soon as possible. Entries must be handed to them by **Sunday, 17th August**. They will need time to find judges and have the entry assessed, using the standard criteria, and then send on the results. That way, all the entries can be taken into account at the event, as equitably as possible.

Hail, songwriters of Lochac!

As a performer who generally only attends bardic circles at Rowany Festival, I have found that each year I hear wonderful pieces of music that I want to learn, but have no easy way to learn them. Alas, I thought to myself, if only the writers had created sheet music, but I know that many of them don't read and write sheet music as fluently as I do, and so don't find it useful. But lack of sheet music is a solvable problem!

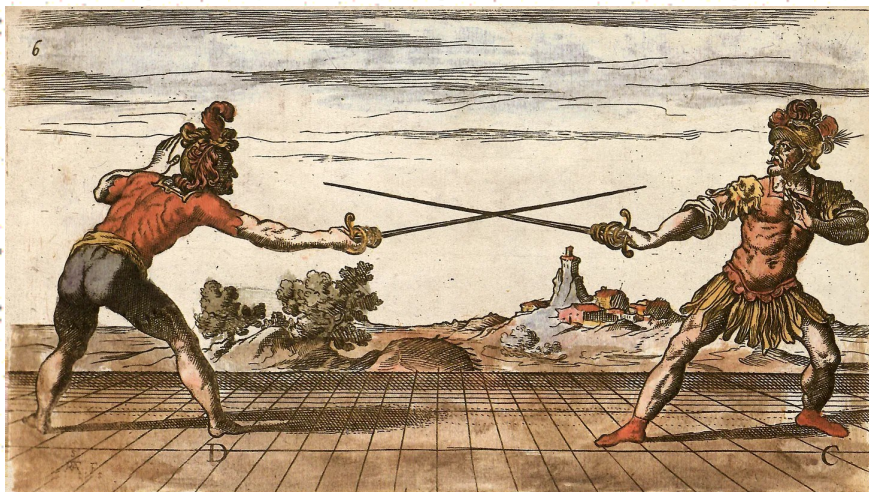
