

## Kingdom Chatelaine Announcement

The Kingdom of Calontir is seeking letters of intent to serve as the next Kingdom Chatelaine. This is a vital role for the growth of the kingdom as it is the person that organizes our recruitment and retention strategies and works with all other officers to promote Calontir and the SCA.

Those interested in filling this role should have strong communication skills, a willingness to work with others, a base knowledge of the SCA and the Kingdom of Calontir, and a passion for introducing newcomers to our shared dream. Experience with google suite is helpful, but not necessary. As long as you are willing to learn along the way, no formal training is necessary.

The job of the kingdom chatelaine includes, but is not limited to:

- \* Working with Society, Kingdom, and Local Group Officers to develop standards for recruiting and retention of newcomers within the kingdom.
- \* Teaching local group officers, and other interested parties, best practices for running successful demos.
- \* Helping newcomers to find their local groups within the kingdom and getting them into contact with the officers of that local group.
- \* Maintaining a roster of local group chatelaines and ensuring they are active. This can be done through interaction with each officer as well as through their quarterly reports.
- \* Ensuring community outreach with our participants and the local communities they are a part of.
- \* The training of new chatelaines and giving them assistance to ensure their success.

## Kingdom Webminister Announcement

We are seeking volunteers to fill the role of Kingdom Webminister. The Kingdom Webminister position includes several duties including maintaining the kingdom website, managing local webministers and kingdom deputies, and providing technical support for the various online tools and systems that the kingdom uses.

While computer programming skills may be beneficial, they are not required for this position. Individuals with technical aptitude and a willingness to learn can be successful in this role. We will provide training in the use and management of the systems used by Calontir.

The typical term of office for a kingdom officer is 2 years. The role of Webminister requires a commitment of roughly 10 hours on a typical week, though may require a greater time commitment when issues arise. The kingdom webminister is backed by a team of deputies who assist with handling the work of this role.

Greetings Calontir!

Today, I would like to talk to you about how to submit an award recommendation. Anyone can do it and yet many people are intimidated by the process. So, let's break it down and go through the steps together.

Let's start with the most important thing - you do not have to have a particular award in order to recommend someone for that award. If you see someone doing a Cool Thing, you can absolutely recommend them for any award that they may qualify for.

Calontir has an online form available for submitting award recommendations—<a href="https://www.calontir.org/award-recommendations">https://www.calontir.org/award-recommendations</a>—that also ties into our Online Order of Precedence. What that means is that you don't necessarily need to know how to spell someone's full persona name. When you start typing a name in the Recommendee field, a dropdown list will appear for you to choose from.

If a person hasn't registered a name yet, or received an award, they may not be listed. In that case, you would type out their name in full and click "OK". When the message pops up, it lets you know that the name is not contained within the OP. If you don't know someone's persona or local group, just leave it blank and that will be confirmed as needed.

The Recommended Award dropdown will provide a description of each award, which is especially helpful if you're not sure which one to pick. The Crown can also take your recommendation for the person, and award them anything that the recommendee may qualify for.

Under Reasons for Recommendation, simply tell the crown about the Cool Thing that your recommendee has done/is doing. You can be as detailed in their exploits as you wish with your recommendation. Did Duncan help you learn how to do something you've always wanted to try? Is Isabel's singing enough to bring tears to your eyes?

Tell the Crown! Rat out your friends for their Cool Things. More specific details can help when presenting the awards - and if you know your recommendee doesn't like being called into court, you can let the Crown know here as well, and they can arrange to meet with a recipient privately!

The "Submit" button is at the top of the form, so make sure you scroll back up and hit it. You should receive a confirmation email from the system that your recommendation has been received.

Recommendations are vital - submit many and often. They help the Crown make some of the magic moments that drive the SCA, and we can't do it without you.

Please do your part to keep the information up to date with this system.

Greetings from RUSH!

Here are the recognitions you can earn through RUSH and how you can earn credits towards them:

- War Certificate: Designed to be earned within the span of a week, at events such as War of the Lilies, Gulf Wars, or Pennsic. To earn this certificate, students must complete 15 classes.
- Auditor Artis: The base level degree. To earn this degree, students must take 30 classes which span at least 3 different subjects.

- Lector Artis: The advanced degree. To earn this degree, students must:
  - First complete the Auditor Artis degree
  - Complete an additional 20 classes
  - Complete an Arts & Sciences project and receive feedback.
- Praeceptor: An honorary recognition bestowed upon instructors who have taught 5 distinct classes.
- Professor: An honorary recognition bestowed upon instructors who have taught 10 distinct classes and complete the Auditor Artis degree.

Entering a public competition is not required. If you prefer a private project feedback session, please contact the RUSH Chancellor at RUSH-Chancellor@calontir. org. We will help find artisans knowledgeable in your subject to give you feedback on your project.

If you choose to enter Queen's Prize Tournament or Kingdom Arts & Sciences, your entry can count for your RUSH project. The feedback session at the event fulfills this requirement. 





Prior to emailing a flyer confirm your event with the Reeve. The Mews WILL NOT publish an announcement if your event has not been approved or confirmed. **Editable:** An Editable version of your flyer MUST be sent. Work with the Social Media Officer for flyers that may be posted on social media.

**Deadline:** The Chronicler must receive event copies no later than the 1st of the month THREE MONTHS PRIOR to your event. *For Example:* If the event is in November, the flyer must be received by August 1st for the September Mews. Refer to the Calendar at the front of the Mews.

If there is an issue with meeting the deadline, please contact the Chronicler ASAP. There is no grace period. The deadline is final and non-negotiable. The earlier a flyer is received the better!

#### Flyers MUST contain these SIX ITEMS:

- 1. Name of the sponsoring group or groups
- 2. Day, month, and year of the event
- 3. Site open & close times for populace
- 4. Location of the event—the name of the event site, and full address.
- 5. Name, both SCA and Modern, of the Event Steward, including contact phone and email (Needed for emergencies or issues arise)
- 6. Details of Registration—Do NOT use "FEE" as a describer for registration cost.

For Example:

Adult Event Registration: \$25 Adult Member Discount Registration: \$20 Youth (6-17) \$5 Children 5 & Under: FREE
