From The Kingdom Carl Marshal

Hello from my estates of Hundehugel.

We are shortly going to be entering the hottest parts of the summer months.

My official duties include: Being responsible for the safety of all martial activities in the kingdom.

To that end, I would like to introduce the following heat conventions:

HEAT CONVENTIONS

ALL martial activity on ALL fields will cease if the heat index on ANY field reaches 40c.

The heat index will be checked at least one hour prior to every melee at the melee location. If the heat index reaches 40c prior to the melee start time, then the fighting is cancelled.

If the heat index reaches 40c during the melee, then the melee is concluded early due to heat.

No discussion or notification to the Crowns is required by the marshals: the marshals will end the melee.

Activity will resume when the heat index drops below 40c. Only the Marshal-in-Charge can reopen the fields.

AccuWeather is a free app that can be downloaded onto your phone. It gives both the real temperature and the "Real Feel".

I am sure other apps can do the same thing; I happen to use AccuWeather.

When days are crazy hot, please remember rule 7 of the Rules of the List and the Application of rule 7:

Rule of the List:

7. No one may be required to participate in Combat-Related Activities.

Application of Rule 7:

No one is required to engage in SCA combat should he or she prefer not to do so

At any time it's ok to say you don't want to fight because it is too hot.
