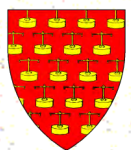

From Crux Australis

Greetings from your friendly Crux!

Well festival is now over and it was wonderful seeing all the elevations and awards given out.

Unfortunately the CHAF forms are a little late due to mundane issues, so they will appear in the next issue of Pegasus!



The things that come to mind is the elevations of Mistress Elizabet Hunter to the order of the Pelican, Master Ianto to the Chivalry, Mistress Thomasina Cook to the order of the Laurel and Zofia to the MoD. Also Bella Rose being made a Court Baroness and Master Gomez a Court Baron. So many other awards and presentations it is becoming a blur, but excellent to see the populace being recognised.

February Letter of acceptances and returns is as follows:

* **Adrian de Bourdon.** Name and device. Per bend sinister Or and azure, a G-clef and a fish within a double tressure counterchanged. Nice 16th century French name!

* **Aiden Jester.** Name. Nice late 16th century English name!

* **Aiden Jester.** Acceptance of transfer of device from Tobias Chester. Sable, an elephant's head cabossed argent, a bordure compony Or and gules. Tobias's badge is accepted as a device.

* **Amos Augustus Aurelius.** Name change from Amos Ironbeard. The submitter's prior name, *Amos Ironbeard*, is retained as an alternate.

* **Amos Augustus Aurelius.** Device change. Quarterly sable and argent, a phoenix Or rising from flames gules, a bordure counterchanged.

* **Angus de Sommerville.** Name. Concerns were raised about the spelling of the

byname. Fortunately heralds at the decision meeting were able to document the desired spelling to the early 1600s.

* **Bastian Dendelyoun.** Name and device. Per fess vert and argent, a dandelion affronty slipped and leaved counterchanged Or and vert, a bordure engrailed counterchanged. Nice cant!

* **David de Darlington.** Badge. Gules ermined argent, a natural leopard Or marked sable maintaining a sword and wearing a coronet argent. The submitter has been granted a court barony and is thus entitled to display a coronet.

* **Joanna of Braidwood.** Device. Argent, a fess vert fretty argent fimbriated gules between two sprigs of rowan in chevron inverted vert fructed and a pretzel gules.

* **Ragnhildr Freysteinsdóttir.** Name change from Morag Freyser. Nice 9th-11th century Old Norse name from Iceland! The submitter's prior name, *Morag Freyser*, is retained as an alternate.

* **Sibel Quartermaine.** Name. FamilySearch records the christening of Sibel Simmies in 1592 Gloucester, England. Nice name for 1590s England!

* **Síthech of Cluain.** Badge. (Fieldless) A double rose sable and argent barbed argent and seeded Or within and conjoined to an annulet of rope sable.

* **Sympkyn of the Moor.** Household name. Company of the Sable Rose and badge. (Fieldless) A double rose sable and argent barbed argent and seeded Or within and conjoined to an annulet of rope argent.

* **Sympkyn of the Moor.** Badge for Company of the Sable Rose. (Fieldless) A rose sable barbed argent and seeded Or within and conjoined to an annulet of rope argent.

* **Tobias Chester.** Transfer of badge to Aiden Jester. Sable, an elephant's head cabossed argent, a bordure compony Or and gules.

- * **Alice le Lacer.** Name and device.

Or, a loop of rope with ends crossed in base purpure. Nice circa 1300 English name!

Nice cant for a byname meaning a maker of cords or strings!

- * **Amalie von Prag.** Reblazon of device.

Argent, a pair of deer's attires conjoined and on a chief purpure a cloud argent.

Blazoned when registered in March 2007

as *Argent, a deer's attires and on a chief purpure a cloud argent*, we are clarifying that there are two attires.

- * **Elizabeth Severn.** Reblazon of device.

Argent, a brown urchin statant proper, on a chief vert three trefoils Or.

Blazoned when registered in June 1987 as *Argent, an urchin statant proper, on a chief vert, three trefoils Or*, we are clarifying the tincture of the urchin. It is not proper as it lacks an argent face and belly; it is brown.

- * **Evette de la Marre.** Name.

- * **Fiore de Neve.** Name.

If the submitter is interested in the wholly Italian name *Fiore del Neve*, they may make a request for reconsideration.

- * **Florius Sesenco.** Name.

- * **Hadrian Lions Bane.** Name and device.

Vert, a unicorn and on a bordure argent three french cut gemstones in profile vert.

- * **Hrafnhildr Jóhansdóttir.** Device.

Argent, a raven displayed sable, on a chief azure a comet fesswise Or.

- * **Jane Harcourt of Wallyngford.** Reblazon of device.

Per chevron argent and vert, a brown urchin statant proper within a bordure counterchanged.

- * **Lochac, Kingdom of.** Order name Order of the Lens (see PENDS for badge).

- * **Lochac, Kingdom of.** Order name Company of the Mouse Guard and badge association.

Gules, a mouse sejant erect to sinister tail nowed argent within an orle Or.

- * **Lokki lásabryótr.** Name and device.

Per fess purpure and sable, three keys in pall inverted wards to center Or, in chief an estoile argent.

- * **Rúnfríðr Keiliselgr.** Household name Haus zum Höffles.

- * **Septimus Septimius Finitus.** Name and device. Sable, seven bees four, two and one Or, a chief counter-compony sable and Or.

- * **Sverker the Berserker.** Name change from William Montrose. The submitter's prior name, *William Montrose*, is released.

It was wonderful meeting and getting to know so many from other Kingdoms within the SCA and we wish them safe travels home and hope to see them again some time.

The baton of Crux Australis Principal Herald,
a Great Officer of State, is to be passed on.

Key requirements:

- You will need to be a current SCA member, 18 years or older.
- Reliable and responsive access to email.
- Ability to keep on top of a variety of related administrative tasks.
- You will be in fealty to the Crown, and typically have a two-year term.
- Skills in the various aspects of heraldry are useful, but keep in mind that an officer's job is to see that the work is done, not to do all the work themselves and there are plenty of useful deputies.

You may not think that you are the right person for this job, but if your friends forward you a copy of this notice, pay attention to them! And if you know someone who you think would be good in the job, do them (and all of us) a favour - ask them to apply.

Key elements of the job:

- Responsibility for all of the operations of the Lochac College of Heraldry, including related reporting on its activities, maintaining the roster of heralds, and coordinating with the wider Society College of Arms.
- Coordinating, supporting and appointing a range of deputies covering a variety of herald-related activities.

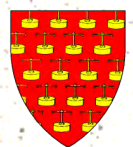

Greetings unto the Populace of Lochac from the Board of SCA Ltd and the Committee of SCANZ,

Sorry for the delay in this missive reaching you. Lochac Announce and Rowany Festival have delayed this being able to be sent on Announce sooner.

Summary

The Alternative Crown Working Group poll results from 2024 showed that many people are interested in alternative Crown tournament formats. Therefore, the Board of SCA Ltd and Committee of SCANZ Inc are proposing a trial of three alternative formats over three consecutive Crown tournaments. Members will be asked to vote yes or no about whether this trial should go ahead. Voting will open May 1st and run until June 1st, 2025 (one calendar month).

Why this Proposal?

In 2024, the Alternative Crown Working Group ran a poll, asking the populace of Lochac their opinions on a range of alternative methods of selecting the Crown of Lochac. The group's final report was released in October 2024 and is available to read at <https://lochac.sca.org/alternative-crown-selection-final-poll-results/>. The poll had a very good response rate, from about 60% of the total membership of the SCA in Australia and NZ.

The main takeaway from the poll result is that there is a high level of interest in Lochac for considering alternative Crown selection methods. Therefore, the Board of SCA Ltd and Committee of SCANZ intend to jointly present a plan for trialling the favoured alternative methods. This plan will be put to a vote by our combined membership, as was done for the poll last year.

Voting

This vote will be a simple Yes or No about whether this trial plan should go ahead. Think of it like a referendum vote. One question with only a Yes or No option. The voting will be open for at least one calendar month, and we want to get this happening in the very near future. Thus, voting will open May 1st and close June 1st, 2025.

The Proposal

In the 2024 poll results, there were four options which were fairly equally favoured as possible Crown selection methods:

- a heavy tournament (the current method),
- a rapier tournament,
- a tournament of champions,
- prowess over several events.

We have lots of experience in running heavy Crown tournaments, of course, but practically none in any of the other three methods of interest. Therefore, we are proposing to trial these other formats in three consecutive Crown tournaments in the near future - that is:

- a Crown rapier tournament,
- a Crown tournament of champions, and
- a Crown tournament combining prowess over several events.

Until all these formats have been trialled, we cannot really say how well they work, or whether some or all of them are worthy of development and refinement.

If this proposal is accepted, we will convene a working group of appropriate experts to advise on the details of how the trial formats should be run. If the proposal is rejected, we will have to review the feedback and consider how we might proceed from there.

When will the trial happen?

We assume that these alternative formats will appeal to a wider range of Crown candidates, who can't or won't contend under the current format. Such candidates will need sufficient advance notice to prepare themselves to enter for one or more of the alternative Crown tournaments. Because of this need for lead time, the first of the alternative Crown tournaments cannot take place any sooner than Autumn Crown in 2026. The actual dates will be part of the recommendations from the working group of experts, taking into account all the factors involved in running these alternative formats.



It's only a trial

Note that our plan is for a trial set of tournaments. The US Board of Directors of SCA Inc. has already set a precedent that Corpora allows for this, with their approval of a trial rapier Crown tournament in the East Kingdom. As this does not appear to be a power reserved to the Board of Directors of SCA Inc, SCA Ltd and SCANZ Inc appear to be able to exercise similar powers and authorise a trial of alternative Crown selection formats in Lochac.

After the trial

If this trial does go ahead in Lochac, and if the outcome is that Lochac is keen to include new Crown tournament options, there will be the time

for SCA Ltd and SCANZ Inc to go back to SCA Inc with a definite proposal for a change to Corpora.
