A 500- to 1000-word article will usually fit in one issue; longer articles will be split into multiple parts to appear in successive issues. Submit the file in MS Word .doc format along with an SCA Creative Release form. Send the images used in the article as separate files using the format described below.

You must cite all references, quotations and sources in your article using the Chicago Manual of Style format. Sample citations are located here: www.chicagomanualofstyle.org/tools_citationguide. html. Citing sources is very important to avoid accusations of plagiarism and legal action for copyright violation.

IMAGES, such as line art, calligraphy, illumination and photographs are also welcome. Scan any artwork at 300 dpi and save it at the highest quality JPG setting. Photos should also be 300 dpi, high quality JPGs. All images will appear in print as black and white, but the online version of *The Pale* is in color. Images can also be submitted as high quality TIF or PDF files. Any artwork or photography submitted to *The Pale* must have a signed SCA Creative Release or SCA Photographer Release form from the artist sent in with the work. Any person identifiable in an image must submit a signed SCA Model Release form with the art work. This is a requirement of SCA Inc. for print publication. All release forms are available at www.midrealm.org/chronicler.

EVENT PREVIEWS: A free event preview of 50 words is available to all events. The listing **MUST include the name of the event, sponsoring group, site address, date, times and event steward contact information.**

EVENT NOTICES (ads) must be published in *The Pale* for events at which any of the following occur: crown and coronet tournaments, coronations and investitures, appointment of kingdom or principality officers, presentation of awards and titles, proclamation of law, establishment or advancement of branches. These activities cannot take place unless a complete event notice appears in *The Pale*, the Middle Kingdom newsletter, at least once before the date of the event. The publication requirement may only be waived in extraordinary circumstances, such as a natural disaster.

Events must **already** be listed on the Middle Kingdom Calendar prior to advertising in *The Pale*, but an event listing on the Middle Kingdom Calendar does **NOT** constitute "official publication". Incipient groups must submit a scan of the sponsorship form to the Editor. Event submissions to the Kingdom Calendar should be submitted through the **online form** available on the calendar page. Contact the Middle Kingdom Calendar Secretary at calendar@ midrealm.org with any issues. Middle Kingdom events receive free event ads that run in the next issue unless otherwise specified. Out-of-Kingdom events and merchants pay the listed rates.

Ad templates for the quarter and half page ads are available at **http://midrealm.org/chronicler/thepale**/. All ads must be submitted to *The Pale* via e-mail attachment in DOC, PDF, JPG, or TIF format.

WITHOUT EXCEPTION, EVENT NOTICES MUST INCLUDE event name, sponsoring group, dates, times, site address, site registration, website URL, NAME (SCA & modern), email address and phone number of the event steward. Simple driving directions to the event site are useful but not required. All clip art images in event notices must have a source listed and be used in accordance with the terms of use. All artwork MUST include an SCA Creative Release form from the author(s) or artist(s). SCA Model Releases are required for identifiable persons in any image. Submissions are edited for grammar, spelling, space constraints, inflammatory or explicit language and compliance with Middle Kingdom Law. Editorial decisions are final. "Letters to the Editor" are not permitted per SCA Inc. regulations.

PLEASE NOTE THAT MIDDLE KINGDOM EVENTS NO LONGER NEED TO PAY FOR ANY EVENT ADS AS OF OCTOBER 2016.


classes, martial activities, and even shenanigans are all possible because of those who made them happen. For those good gentles, We are always grateful and always thankful.

In the not-so-distant future we have Coronation and Crown Tournament. These are events that have the opportunity to express the pageantry of what we do in the SCA. Assisting heralds are always welcome and needed to help the Crown make these events special. If you are interested in helping at Courts or in the combat lists, please contact the Herald-in-Charge at the event or let the Pale Herald (paleherald@midrealm.org) know and you will be added to a list of heralds to be notified of upcoming events that need assistants.

In the near future, the Crown and Heirs will need help at several events and the rapidly approaching Gulf Wars. Again, please contact the Pale Herald and let that office know you are available.

My office will be seeking a person to step into the office of Meadows Herald. This office helps recruit and organize voice heralds for combat lists. This is not limited to Crown Tournament. The person who assumes this office may be asked to help get the word out to the heraldic community to assist local events who wish to display pageantry and have combatant introductions for tournaments. This does not mean you need to travel to every event, but help spread the word that event stewards or marshals are seeking help. You should be present at Crown Tournament to oversee the management of heralds between the List table and the combat lists.

Crafting Medieval Portraits at SCA Events with a Simple Set-Up

In our Society, we often seek to immerse ourselves in the rich tapestry of medieval and Renaissance history. Many of us spent hours upon hours painstakingly researching our clothing, armor, and accessories, not to mention the money, love, and labor in recreating that perfect look. But when you go to capture those moments, the rewards of all that hard work, what you DON'T want to see is the 1970s Civic Center your event is being held at as the backdrop for the perfect portrait. And I don't even want to mention the fluorescent lighting. I know that is what first drove me to create a simple portrait studio for our main Baronial event, Christmas Tourney. I had no training in photography or lighting and just an idea of

what I'd like to see. I think I've gotten the hang of it now, so I thought I'd share my thoughts with you.

This article aims to guide individuals interested in photography at SCA events on how to set up a simple yet effective portrait studio. By combining a few essential elements and incorporating historical props, we can create compelling visual narratives of our fellow participants.

Equipment: To create a portable portrait studio at an SCA event, you will need the following equipment:

- Backdrop: A simple colored backdrop, preferably in earthy or muted tones, to eliminate distractions and evoke a historical ambiance. (I'd avoid a black backdrop as many people wear black and their garb will disappear, making them a floating head.)
- Lighting: Employ one large key light to illuminate the subject effectively. Ensure that the light is
 positioned strategically to achieve the desired effect. Affordably bought, this simple lighting setup,
 with the key light set forward and the side of your subject, can create that essential Rembrandt
 lighting we all love. Additionally, a small hair light mounted high and behind your subject will help
 separate them from the backdrop. I use a very cheap clip-on reading lamp with a white shade.
- Reflector: A simple reflector can be used to bounce light onto the subject's face, softening shadows and enhancing the overall quality of the image.
- Camera: Use a high-quality camera with adjustable settings to capture sharp, well-exposed images. Although, with the advances in mobile phone cameras, they can be a great starting point before you invest hundreds in a "real" camera.
- Props: Incorporate historical props such as medieval chairs, swords, food, and other props to add authenticity and context to your portraits. Look at medieval art for inspiration.

<u>Building Rapport</u>: It is essential to establish a connection with your subjects, many of whom may not be comfortable in front of the camera. Remember, not everyone is a professional model, and some may be as camera-shy as a troll under a bridge. Engage in friendly conversation, ask them to share what it is about the SCA or medieval history they love or would like to showcase, and try to make them feel at ease. Assure them that you'd never post images you take that they wouldn't approve of or that you wouldn't want to be posted of yourself.

<u>Photographic Style</u>: Let's talk style. Many people are uncomfortable in front of the camera and will look to you for direction on how to pose themselves. You can go classic with simple portrait poses, like the ones you see in prom photos or Glamor Shots. Or you can channel your inner artist and draw inspiration from medieval, Renaissance, or historical fiction and fantasy art. Emulate the styles and compositions that resonate with the era you wish to evoke. Pinterest is a great source for curating inspiration. Don't be afraid to have fun with it and take as many photos in as many poses as you'd like to get the right ones. The best images tell a story.

<u>Post-Production</u>: After capturing your portraits, the final step is postproduction. Utilize editing software like Adobe Lightroom to enhance and refine your images. Adjust exposure, contrast, color balance, and sharpness to achieve the desired visual effect. Eventually, you can create your own unique style.

If all of that seems too much, try starting out by setting up a "Selfie-Spot" at your event. Just the backdrop alone set up with a sign and

you'll see your fellow SCAdians flocking over with their cellphones to take pics of each other.

Creating a portable portrait studio at SCA events is a rewarding endeavor for those passionate about both history and photography. By employing basic essential equipment, building rapport with your subjects, and drawing inspiration from historical sources, you can capture captivating images that tell the stories of individuals in the SCA community.



Pentamere Regional MoAS and Midlands Regional MoAS

The position of Pentamere Regional MoAS will be open as of summer 2024 and the position of Midlands Regional MoAS office will be open as of late spring 2024. Those interested in the positions should send their SCA resume to kmoas@midrealm.org and to the email of the appropriate regional officer by March 15, 2024 (pentamere.moas@midrealm.org or midlands.moas@midrealm.org).

The Pentamere and Midlands Regional Ministers of Arts and Sciences shall have the responsibility for the encouragement and organization of the study and practice of all Arts and Sciences within the their respective Region of the Middle Kingdom. They will review reports from the local and baronial Ministers of Arts and Sciences in their region. They will provide training and be resources of information to the populace, local and baronial MoASs in their region. They will need to be able to travel and attend events in their region. They are encouraged to attend Kingdom A&S events as well and act as volunteers. They will need to attend video conference meetings with KMoAS and other regional officers up to once a month.

Ideal candidates should have the following:

- A strong knowledge base of the Kingdom and Society rules pertaining to the Arts and Sciences.
- Be active participants in Arts and Sciences.
- Be a paid member of the Society for Creative Anachronism.
- Be able to work well with others.
- Have strong written and spoken communication skills.
- Have reliable access to the internet and a computer.
- Have basic knowledge of using Google's suite of tools (Gmail, Docs, Sheets, etc)
- Be able to keep organized and accurate records.



Currently approximately 8000 people around the Knowne World actively participate in target archery, combat archery, siege weapons, thrown weapons and equestrian martial activities. While no ultimate decision has yet been made the Board believes that a proposal of a path to peerage for these individuals is worthy of deep consideration.

Having received advice from the Peerage Committee, Directors have discussed the matter and following some minor amendments to language which align the proposed draft of Corpora wording to the existing patent orders, the Board feels that the proposal has matured to the point where commentary on the proposed Corpora wording from members is requested. This commentary will assist the Board in forming further decisions relevant to its consideration of this matter.

The draft Corpora language approved for commentary is:

VIII.A.4:

e. The Order of <Name>

(i) Members of the Order of <Name> may choose to swear fealty but are not required to do so. The candidate must have attained the standard of excellence in skill and/or knowledge equal to that of their prospective peers in a pre-17th century martial pursuit as practiced in the SCA, including, and limited to, target archery, combat archery, thrown weapons, equestrian activities, and siege engineers. The candidate must have applied this skill and/or knowledge for the instruction of members and service to the kingdom to an extent above and beyond that normally expected of members of the Society.

(ii) The duties of the members of the order are as follows:

- (a) To set an example of courtesy and chivalrous conduct on and off the field of honor.
- (b) To respect the Crown of the kingdom; to support and uphold the laws of the kingdom and Corpora.
- (c) If in fealty, to support and uphold the Crown of their kingdom.
- (d) To enrich the kingdom by sharing their knowledge and skills.
- (e) To enhance the renown and defend the honor of the peer's Lady or Lord.
- (f) To advise the Crown on the advancement of candidates for the Order of <Name>.

(other sections re-numbered as needed)

Knowing exactly what the people who work, study, and play in the Society want a potential new peerage to achieve and do will be key to moving forward in this discussion. The Board welcomes any additional context that people feel may be of use to the discussion.

We are looking for your feedback – as you begin to type up your comments please feel free to include your thoughts on the following questions:

- Does this language fill the gap I personally feel exists in the paths to peerage, why or why not?
- What is my ideal vision of a new peerage and its members? What virtue will they embody?

EDIT: If you are a financial member of the SCA, please include the relevant information.

The expertise of our community is invaluable, and these responses will contribute significantly to an outcome that positions our Society to meet its goals and future opportunities.

The Society for Creative Anachronism, Inc. (SCA, Inc.) is announcing an increase in membership fees and non-member registration fees for events.

This decision comes after careful consideration and extensive discussion among the Board of Directors, office staff, and Corporate officers. The effects of inflation across all sectors of operation, as well as other factors impacting the organization's operational costs, including insurance premiums, legal expenses, and general business expenses, necessitated a comprehensive review of membership rates.

Annual membership fees have not been adjusted in over a dozen years, and non-member registration fees have not increased in over 15 years.

In response to the evolving financial environment, the organization streamlined operations during the 2020 COVID-19 pandemic and significantly reduced corporate expenditures. The relocation of the office to San Jose, CA resulted in an annual savings of over \$35,000, and upgrades to software and CRM systems have netted a further savings of over \$100,000 annually. While membership numbers have rebounded post-pandemic, operational costs continue to rise.

SCA, Inc. Corporate is solely funded by membership fees, including the Non-Member Registration fee, and does not currently seek operational funds from its Kingdoms or subsidiary organizations, including those overseeing Pennsic and Gulf Wars.

At the January 2024 meeting of the Board of Directors, the Board approved the following changes, effective Feb. 15, 2024:

Raise the Sustaining membership price from \$45 a year to \$55 a year (This represents an \$0.83 cents per-month increase over the previous monthly rate.)

Raise the Associate membership price from \$30 to \$40 a year. (This represents an \$0.83 cents per-month increase over the previous monthly rate.)

Raise the Family membership price from \$10 a year to \$15 a year, per person. (This represents an \$0.42 cents per-month increase over the previous monthly rate.)

No changes to Canadian or International memberships have been announced at this time.

Note: this change will take effect for all renewal transactions processed on or after February 15, 2024. Renewal transactions prior to that date will be processed at the previous rate, regardless of membership expiration date.

The Board also approved the following changes to Non-Member Registration fees, effective April 1, 2024:

• Raise the Non-Member Registration Fee from \$5 to \$10 per event. As always, this only applies whenever there is an actual event fee charged.

Both Sustaining and International Membership allow subscriptions to printed publications, as well as the ability to add Family memberships.

It should be noted that these increases remain less than the cumulative U.S. inflation increase of 36.5% which has occurred since 2011. (Data calculated using the US Inflation Calculator).

SCA, Inc. emphasizes its commitment to transparency and sustaining a vibrant community. These fee adjustments aim to ensure the organization's fiscal health, support ambitious initiatives in 2024 and beyond, and keep the Knowne World thriving and dreaming for years to come.
