From the Kingdom Clerk of Laws

Greetings to all who see these words,

At the Curia of Their Royal Majesties Matthias and Æsa Feilinn, conducted ethereally in accordance with SCA, Inc. guidelines on 1 February 2024, A.S. 58, the following became East Kingdom Law.

This list is a summary of major changes, by section. A full markup of all changes is available by link from the East Kingdom Seneschal's Curia page at <https://seneschal.eastkingdom.org/curia/>

The proposed changes to section V.C.3.g. (Crown's Youth Champions of Arms selection) were withdrawn from consideration at this Curia by the Crown.

The Curia Regis

- New III.A.3. (with renumbering) requiring at least one Curia per reign to be virtual or online;
- and
- Clarification of III.A.4.a. officer reports as from Greater Kingdom Officers, per custom.

Kingdom Officers

- Revisions to IV.B.1., new IV.B.12., and deletion of IV.C.4. (with renumbering) to raise the Kingdom DEIB Officer to a Greater Officer;
- and
- Revisions to IV.C.1. of the Kingdom Accessibility Porter's reporting and duties.

Crown's Youth Champions of Arms

Revisions to V.C.5., V.C.6.c., and VIII.A.9.a.iii. regarding the term and duties of the champions, and the scheduling of the tournaments.

Branch Pollings

Revisions to VII.C.2. (with renumbering) allowing and establishing basic standards for electronic branch pollings.

Order Pollings

- Removing the option of pollings by paper copies from IX.B.1.b.;
- and
- Clarification of IX.B.7.d. that the EK Webministry may use an archiving function to provide digests as appropriate.

Order of the Maunche

Revising IX.D.3.a. to clarify that service to the A&S community is not a standalone qualification.

Order of Apollo's Arrow

IX.E.6.a. typo correction.

Order of Gawain

IX.F.8.a. revision to clarify that youth may be considered for the Gawain for distinction in youth armored combat or rapier, or in all-ages archery, thrown weapons, equestrian, or other such activities.

Award of the Burdened Tyger

IX.G.2.a. revision to restore this recognition to only Royal Progress events.

Sovereign's Award of Esteem

IX.G.7.b. revision to specify that the tokens will be made by the Sovereign.

Award of Benzaiten (formerly Anansi's Web)

Revisions to IX.G.16. to establish the award name and token.

(Kingdom) Earl Marshal

Revisions in XI.A.1.h. and XI.A.3.c.iii. to change "Kingdom Earl Marshal" to "the Earl Marshal" for references consistency.
