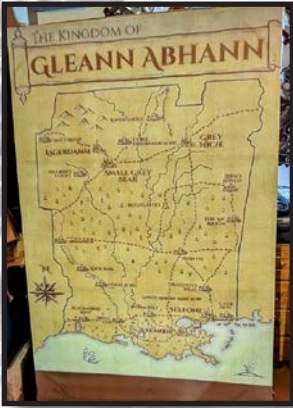
Making of the Cover Image

Tegid and Lord Daggabotti came together for construction of the frames. Two inch by two inch yellow pine boards formed a six foot three inch tall by 4 foot wide frame.

Canvas was stretched taut over the frames and sealed with a combination of flour, corn-starch and water. A small amount of Elmers' glue was added as a binder to hold ingredients together. The mixture was worked into the fibers of the canvas to ensure full saturation and so that it gave stability but did not leave a texture. Three layers were added front and back to give a starchy aged patina to the canvas.



A projector was used to project the design onto the canvas. A rough sketch of the design was drawn on the canvas with pencils and colors were blocked in with color pencils. This was done as a guide for the painting that would come later.

For an A&S day, the Shire of Ardanroe came together to make this a group project. Members of the shire painted and filled in where the colored pencil guides were, adding their own special touches.



Colors were added in layers to give a sense of depth to the design. Once finished with color, liquid gold was added for gleam. Oil-based gold paint was used for the brightness and shine

The next time you see this work or art hanging at an event, be sure to look for the hidden gems. Small little things added by the members of Ardanroe to represent them as a token of their work and effort.



A special thanks to Mistress Marcella, Master Giaus, Lady Adhi, Mistress Cecilia, Lord Kaz and Master Gilbert for encouragement and help through the process of creating all three canvases. Project began November 3rd 2023 and completed first week of January 2024.

Courtesy 101

What does the word courtesy mean?

Courtesy is a noun meaning the showing of politeness in one's attitude and behavior toward others. *Also, a polite speech or action, especially one required by convention.*

But, What does courtesy mean to YOU?

- As a fighter, does it mean calling your shots and being honorable about a win?
- Speaking kindly to a new comer and not being condescending about their attempt at making their first garb?
- Giving positive encouragement for a first time entry into the Arts and Sciences?

Courtesy means a lot of things to different people in different ways

Courtesy could mean helping a Lady carrying a chair to the field. It is escorting a Lady in court, when addressed by their Royal Majesties. (Note: NO Lady, young or old, should be unescorted into court.) Is it answering questions from anyone asking, to the best of your abilities, especially those questions asked by a child.

- We hear a lot about "bullying" today; both in the modern era world and within the SCA. NO ONE should be bullied, uncomfortable or threatened in any way. NO ONE has the right to make you feel that you don't have a choice; not a peer, not a royal, not a member of the populace. You have the right to say NO. No matter what is asked or implied of you. You ALWAYS have a choice!! Talk with someone you trust, if you are new to the SCA, ask to speak to the Seneschal, to help resolve the situation

Courtesy means reverencing the Crown

That does not mean the person wearing the crown. You are being courteous to what the crown represents. You may have an issue with someone wearing a crown, or sitting in state, but paying respect to the crown is paying respect to the kingdom and that is courtesy and honorable.

Small acts of courtesy will long be remembered after the event is over. I don't think that people realize just how important positive interaction can be to the success of an event. Snarky or snappy comments made may not be heard by the individual you are referring to, but I can assure you that someone will hear you. Not only does it reflect negatively on you, but also the kingdom and the SCA in general.

We will never agree with everyone! How we respond and comport ourselves, is something that we can control. Be the smile that is remembered, that someone who made a newcomer feel welcomed, that certain someone who made a difference. Remember the mantra of Gleann Abhann

Omnibus Peerage Proposal

Currently approximately 8000 people around the Knowne World actively participate in target archery, combat archery, siege weapons, thrown weapons and equestrian martial activities. While no ultimate decision has yet been made the Board believes that a proposal of a path to peerage for these individuals is worthy of deep consideration.

Having received advice from the Peerage Committee, Directors have discussed the matter and following some minor amendments to language which align the proposed draft of Corpora wording to the existing patent orders, the Board feels that the proposal has matured to the point where commentary on the proposed Corpora wording from members is requested. This commentary will assist the Board in forming further decisions relevant to its consideration of this matter.

The draft Corpora language approved for commentary is:

VIII.A.4:

e. The Order of <Name>

(i) Members of the Order of <Name> may choose to swear fealty but are not required to do so. The candidate must have attained the standard of excellence in skill and/or knowledge equal to that of their prospective peers in a pre-17th century martial pursuit as practiced in the SCA, including, and limited to, target archery, combat archery, thrown weapons, equestrian activities, and siege engineers. The candidate must have applied this skill and/or knowledge for the instruction of members and service to the kingdom to an extent above and beyond that normally expected of members of the Society.

(ii) The duties of the members of the order are as follows:

- (a) To set an example of courtesy and chivalrous conduct on and off the field of honor.
- (b) To respect the Crown of the kingdom; to support and uphold the laws of the kingdom and Corpora.
- (c) If in fealty, to support and uphold the Crown of their kingdom.
- (d) To enrich the kingdom by sharing their knowledge and skills.
- (e) To enhance the renown and defend the honor of the peer's Lady or Lord.
- (f) To advise the Crown on the advancement of candidates for the Order of <Name>.

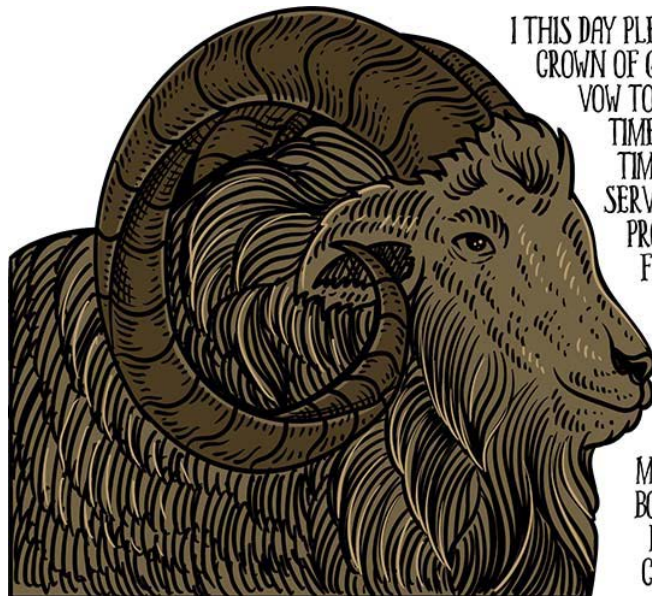
