

Currently approximately 8000 people around the Knowne World actively participate in target archery, combat archery, siege weapons, thrown weapons and equestrian martial activities. While no ultimate decision has yet been made the Board believes that a proposal of a path to peerage for these individuals is worthy of deep consideration.

Having received advice from the Peerage Committee, Directors have discussed the matter and following some minor amendments to language which align the proposed draft of Corpora wording to the existing patent orders, the Board feels that the proposal has matured to the point where commentary on the proposed Corpora wording from members is requested. This commentary will assist the Board in forming further decisions relevant to its consideration of this matter.

The draft Corpora language approved for commentary is:

VIII.A.4:

- e. The Order of <Name>
- (i) Members of the Order of <Name> may choose to swear fealty but are not required to do so. The candidate must have attained the standard of excellence in skill and/or knowledge equal to that of their prospective peers in a pre-17th century martial pursuit as practiced in the SCA, including, and limited to, target archery, combat archery, thrown weapons, equestrian activities, and siege engineers. The candidate must have applied this skill and/or knowledge for the instruction of members and service to the kingdom to an extent above and beyond that normally expected of members of the Society.
- (ii) The duties of the members of the order are as follows:
- (a) To set an example of courtesy and chivalrous conduct on and off the field of honor.
- (b) To respect the Crown of the kingdom; to support and uphold the laws of the kingdom and Corpora.
- (c) If in fealty, to support and uphold the Crown of their kingdom.
- (d) To enrich the kingdom by sharing their knowledge and skills.
- (e) To enhance the renown and defend the honor of the peer's Lady or Lord.
- (f) To advise the Crown on the advancement of candidates for the Order of <Name>.

(other sections re-numbered as needed)

Knowing exactly what the people who work, study, and play in the Society want a potential new peerage to achieve and do will be key to moving forward in this discussion. The Board welcomes any additional context that people feel may be of use to the discussion. We are looking for your feedback – as you begin to type up your comments please feel free to include your thoughts on the following questions:

Does this language fill the gap I personally feel exists in the paths to peerage, why or why not?

What is my ideal vision of a new peerage and its members? What virtue will they embody?

EDIT: If you are a financial member of the SCA, please include the relevant information.

The expertise of our community is invaluable, and these responses will contribute significantly to an outcome that positions our Society to meet its goals and future opportunities.

The Society for Creative Anachronism, Inc. (SCA, Inc.) is announcing an increase in membership fees and non-member registration fees for events.

This decision comes after careful consideration and extensive discussion among the Board of Directors, office staff, and Corporate officers. The effects of inflation across all sectors of operation, as well as other factors impacting the organization's operational costs, including insurance premiums, legal expenses, and general business expenses, necessitated a comprehensive review of membership rates. Annual membership fees have not been adjusted in over a dozen years, and non-member registration fees have not increased in over 15 years.

In response to the evolving financial environment, the organization streamlined operations during the 2020 COVID-19 pandemic and significantly reduced corporate expenditures. The relocation of the office to San Jose, CA resulted in an annual savings of over \$35,000, and upgrades to software and CRM systems have netted a further savings of over \$100,000 annually. While membership numbers have rebounded post-pandemic, operational costs continue to rise.

SCA, Inc. Corporate is solely funded by membership fees, including the Non-Member Registration fee, and does not currently seek operational funds from its Kingdoms or subsidiary organizations, including those overseeing Pennsic and Gulf Wars.

At the January 2024 meeting of the Board of Directors, the Board approved the following changes, effective February 15, 2024: Raise the Sustaining membership price from \$45 a year to \$55 a year (This represents an \$0.83 cents per-month increase over the previous monthly rate.)

Raise the Associate membership price from \$30 to \$40 a year. (This represents an \$0.83 cents per-month increase over the previous monthly rate.)

Raise the Family membership price from \$10 a year to \$15 a year, per person. (This represents an \$0.42 cents per-month increase over the previous monthly rate.)

No changes to Canadian or International memberships have been announced at this time.

Note: this change will take effect for all renewal transactions processed on or after February 15, 2024. Renewal transactions prior to that date will be processed at the previous rate, regardless of membership expiration date.

The Board also approved the following changes to Non-Member Registration fees, effective April 1, 2024:

Raise the Non-Member Registration Fee from \$5 to \$10 per event. As always, this only applies whenever there is an actual event fee charged.

Both Sustaining and International Membership allow subscriptions to printed publications, as well as the ability to add Family memberships.

It should be noted that these increases remain less than the cumulative U.S. inflation increase of 36.5% which has occurred since 2011. (Data calculated using the US Inflation Calculator).

SCA, Inc. emphasizes its commitment to transparency and sustaining a vibrant community. These fee adjustments aim to ensure the organization's fiscal health, support ambitious initiatives in 2024 and beyond, and keep the Knowne World thriving and dreaming for years to come.

REQUEST FOR COMMENTARY - CHATELAINE AND DEIB OFFICES

The Board of Directors is currently considering changes to Corpora. It invites commentary from the membership and participants.

These changes aim to enhance recruitment and member retention in the SCA. They also aim to further support these goals. They elevate the Society Chatelaine to a greater Society Officer. They align local and regional chatelaines to this same structure. It is a strategic move. It aims to support the implementation of comprehensive recruitment and retention strategies. It also aims to align the office to a clear vision.

The Board also approved proposed wording. It supports the creation of a Society Diversity, Equity, Inclusion, and Belonging (DEIB) Officer. They also approved aligning local and regional DEIB officers into one structure. Like the proposed Chatelaine changes, it aims to support an aligned Society vision. It also aims to support the implementation of strategy in this space. Finally, the Board approved changing the name and scope of the Corporate Diversity Equity Inclusion and Belonging Office. It is now the Office of Inclusive Programs. This office will handle the implementation of large scale, heavy-lift projects. This work will move inclusivity in the SCA forward. It will also transition leadership and management of game-facing DEIB work to the newly created Society DEIB Officer. This office will support all corporate and society officers. It will also serve as a primary DEIB advisor to the Board.

Note: Changes to corporate offices don't require changes in Corpora or public commentary. Understanding the changes to the Corporate DEIB Office will add context for the proposed changes to Corpora. It will also provide clarity for the realignment of responsibilities among these offices.

This restructuring aligns with better practice for organizations that aim to improve recruiting and retention by creating welcoming and inclusive environments.

The Kingdom Seneschal is looking for his successor!

This job demands 10-20 hours a week online, handling questions, responding to comments, attending Zooms, performing research, conducting negotiations, coaching direct reports, and handling correspondence. At kingdom events, 23 hour availability by radio and phone.

Applicants must be a Trimaris citizen acceptable to the Crown, a paid 'blue card' SCA member, and a Florida resident. Applicants should have a background in nonprofit management, gained from some combination of education and experience. 8-10 years is a good number. Experience in project management is also super helpful. Having been a local group seneschal and having held a kingdom office is more or less a requirement. Recognition as a SCA Peer is not a requirement. Leadership experience in mundane employment or other nonprofits would be very helpful, particularly if that experience is in the HR or Finance fields.



Complete six of the monthly challenges and at the end of the coming year you'll receive a silver medallion sporting the heraldry of your personal kingdom(you'll have to let me know what kingdom you're from).

Complete all twelve of the monthly challenges and at the end of the coming year you'll receive a gold medallion sporting your personal heraldry/heraldry of your choice(these will be checked in at the end of the year for clarification).

Now that I have your attention with the sparklies let's move on to how you can win these fabulous prizes!

Each month has a different theme for our challengers. They are as follows:

January- Jig

You must post a recording of your *ORIGINAL* piece in the Twelve Months of Bardic group(otherwise I won't be able to keep track of them). Feel free to post them all over the other bardic groups. If they don't have to be the next Hamlet. They just need to be vaguely recognizable as the type of work that we're going for that month. No length requirements unless it's part of the definition of each type of work.





EVENT FINANCIAL POLICIES

- All returned checks will be subject to a \$20 fee.

Event announcements need to be submitted as a standard text listing containing the required information. Announcements should be submitted as early as possible to allow for corrections and more advertising for your event. Announcements must be created following the checklist below. This checklist is intended as an aid in the proper submission of event announcements. All event announcements at which any official business will occur <u>must</u> contain the following information:

- Name event and the sponsoring group.
- Date of the event.
- Event site location including name and address.
- Time the event site opens and closes to the public.
- Registration open and closing times.
- Name (mundane and SCA) mailing address, e-mail address, and telephone number of the Reservation Steward.
- Name (mundane and SCA), e-mail address, and phone number for the Event Steward
- Names (mundane and SCA), e-mail address, and phone number
- for the Marshal in Charge and Ranger in Charge
- Site registration pricing and payment information.
- OPTIONAL: Description of the event activities.

In order to comply with Kingdom Laws and Policies, unless otherwise stated, the following standard event policies will automatically apply to all events submitted and held within the Kingdom of Trimaris.

- No family shall pay more than the equivalent of three (3) adult site fees. Family is defined as adults and their minor children. This applies to site fees only and does not include feast or cabin space.
- Unless otherwise noted, The site fees for children 12 and under are free.
- The SCA member discount for site registration shall not exceed \$10 per person.
