- An attached copy of the SIGNED event form
- Consider including details such as directions to the site, merchant information, event activities, site restrictions, and ADA accessibility options.

Events which have not published all of the above information in the Kingdom newsletter are not eligible to have awards, law changes, or other Official Kingdom business conducted at them.

- All submissions must be received by midnight on the 1st of the PREVIOUS month (see the Calendar).
 The deadline does not change for Sundays or holidays. Late submissions may not make it into that month's issue.
- Articles may be reformatted for publication. Please use a single font; do not use tabs or create columns.
- Event Articles should be provided as an attached MS Word, .txt, or Open Office file.

From the Society President

Words from the President, SCA Inc.

The world is at our fingertips, and we have access to a wealth of information. The absence of that information leads to speculation with varying degrees of accuracy. There is a demand and expectation for transparency in the SCA when things go wrong. As the newest person in a Corporate role, it might help the membership to give my perspective.

This is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization. The SCA does not reveal everything people want to know for legal and safety reasons. To understand the SCA's policy on transparency about sanctions, it helps to understand how things currently work. Sanctions are official actions that affect someone's SCA participation. We have our governing documents, core values, kingdom laws, and handbooks. They guide Corporate and define the structure of the game we play. The rules apply to everyone without exception. Sometimes, people break the rules for whatever reason, and we must take action.

An issue that the Board of Directors (BoD) acts on requires careful consideration. All the supporting documentation is collected. The office of the Society Seneschal puts it together into an extensive report. They present it to the BoD. The public has a blurry snapshot of an issue to base their assumptions on. The Board has an entire photo album of varying quality to make their decision with. The last report I looked at was 40 pages, and then there were all the supporting documents as well. It takes time to gather and put together information. Really, you should thank the Society Seneschal if you ever see Mistress Elasait in the wild. The Board makes the decisions with advice from the Corporate Officers. If someone is sanctioned, they are always told why they were sanctioned.

Now to the main point: transparency. There are some things to consider when it comes to that.

Please allow me to use a metaphor about the BoD and Corporate Officers. One person in a group of 7 is ordering a pizza. Someone may have a gluten allergy. Someone could be vegan. Someone else would rather have tacos. Three other folks are there telling them about the different options. It would take a lot of convincing to get everyone to agree on the same pizza. The group orders pizza often. But, every six months, a person is replaced with someone else with a different diet.

The SCA needs the information we've gathered to be accurate. This is because the decisions affect many people. We must protect the confidentiality of anyone who comes forward with information. We take precautions to protect revealing information. This is for the safety of those people.

The primary reason the SCA does not comment on sanctions is to protect the organization. The Sanctions Procedures and Policies Manual outlines the current policy. It says not to comment on sanctions.

There is a balance between transparency and risk. Given what you now know about the process, I want to hear from the membership about where the SCA can improve its transparency. You can email me at president@sca.org. I would like to note that it takes time to change policy. Although I do not make the decisions in this area, I can present to the BoD what the membership wants to see.





Calling for Letters of Intent

The Baron and Baroness of Atenveldt are preparing to conclude their tenure and enjoy a much deserved retirement. It is time to request Letters of Intent. On Saturday, September 21st, 2024 at the Baronial Masquerade Ball there will be a polling for the next pair to lead the barony who will step up at Baronial Anniversary, December 7th.

Below are the Guidelines for Participation as a Baronial Candidate:

- Baronial candidates must be current paid members and must receive their *Southwind* or have an SCA membership in a Zip Code belonging to the Barony of Atenveldt.
- Candidates must be at least 18 years old.
- Candidates must have Letters of Intent in the hands of the Crown, the Kingdom Seneschal, & the Baron & Baroness no later than Wednesday, July 31st, 2024. Letters should be written with the understanding that (if accepted by the Crown), the letters will be published in the Baronial Newsletter for the populace to review prior to the polling.
- Candidates must include the below information in their Letter of Intent:
 - Full contact information, including SCA & modern names, addresses, phone numbers, email, & membership numbers with expiration date.
 - Their reasons for seeking the position.
 - Their history of participation in the SCA & the Barony of Atenveldt.
 - Their plans for the future of the group.
 - Their understanding of the responsibilities of the position of Baron & Baroness.
 - Their statement that they are willing to be installed with a two or three year warrant in the position, & understand their Letter of Intent will be published in the Baronial Newsletter if their candidacy is accepted by the Crown.

In addition, please review the following information regarding your participation in the Barony of Atenveldt Polling. A polling of the current paid members of the Barony of Atenveldt will be conducted on Saturday, September 21st 2024 to determine their support of candidates for Baron & Baroness. The populace should be aware that if the first polling does not show a clear preference of the populace, a second polling may be held immediately following the closing & tabulation of ballots for the first poll. Members are encouraged to plan to remain onsite to participate should a second poll be necessary.

To participate in all pollings held that day, you must be a Sustaining, Associate, or Family member who is 18 years old or older, & must receive a *Southwind* or have an SCA membership in a zip code belonging to the Barony of Atenveldt.

- Current paid memberships will be verified on a membership list at the polling site, or you may present an online membership renewal dated after the date the membership list was generated by the Milpitas Registry. The Kingdom Seneschal recommends you bring proof of membership with you to ensure participation in the poll.
- · You must reside in zip codes belonging to the Barony of Atenveldt, & this will be verified on the membership list at the polling site.
- NOTE: Paid members who play in the Barony of Atenveldt, but do not reside in the zip codes belonging to the Barony, may not cast ballots. However, they are encouraged to make their views on candidates known to the Crown by sending personal letters to the Crown & Kingdom Seneschal expressing their candidate selections & preferences. The Crown will consider such letters when reviewing the polling results.
- · You must be 18 years old or older & present a picture ID at the polling site that shows your date of birth or age.

**** SPECIAL ZIP CODE EXCEPTION ****

If you DO NOT HAVE a membership address in a zip code assigned to the Barony of Atenveldt, but your membership is current and in a zip code in metropolitan Phoenix, you will be asked to sign a Pledge Form before you can receive a ballot. The Pledge Form shows your agreement with this statement.

"I consider myself a member of the populace of the Barony of Barony of Atenveldt, and promise the Crown of Atenveldt that I will not cast a ballot in any Pollings held in the Barony of Sun Dragon or the Barony of Twin Moons for 3 years following the date of this polling."

A list of the members who sign this Pledge Form will be kept by the Kingdom Seneschal's office, and by the Seneschals of the three Baronies in the Phoenix metropolitan area.
